Hello,

First I explain who I am:

Gernot Mueller, 61 years old, retired, German living in Brittany (official address Friedrichsdorf near Frankfurt). My wife is French, born in Brittany. We have 2 sons. One is married with an Italian, he is architect and working for the US Army in Germany. The other son is married with an American from Utah and working in Colorado Springs as controller.

I have an uncle who lived in Friedrichsdorf and was married with a Huguenot woman, Emma Roux, and she was connected to all the Huguenot families, also Bodemon (another German version of Beaudemont. Friedrichsdorf was founded in 1687 by Huguenots families, most of them came from the area of the Thierache which is south of Belgium and west of Luxembourg. The main place they came from is Rue-des-Bohains, today part of Leme. As the protestant religion was forbidden they went for many years to Chateau Gercy for their baptisms and weddings. On the way to Germany 2 weeks ago I took some photos of this famous Rue-des-Bohains.
