

The Right Honourable Thomas Lord Fairfax
 Baron of Cameron in that part of Great Britain called Scotland Proprietor of the Northern Neck
 of Virginia: To all to whom this present writing shall come sends Greeting. Know Ye that for good
 causes & in consideration of the composition to me now and for the annual rent hereinafter named I
 have given granted & confirmed by these presents for me my Heirs and Assigns Do give grant &
 confirm unto William Saunders Junior heir at law to Daniel Saunders deceased of Loudoun
 County certain tract of waste ungranted Land on some of the branches of Difficult run joining
 Col^r Henry Ashton's Patent and the Hon^rble Thomas Lee Esq^r in the said County & bounded as by a Survey
 thereof made by Mr Daniel Jennings Begun 11/11/117 at two scrubby red oaks standing on the N.
 side of a Glade and branch being a corner to the R^d Thomas Lee Esq^r in the time of the said Ashton's land
 thence extending by the said Ashton's land N 42 W. one hundred & fifty eight poles crossing the said
 Glade and branch to a small red oak corner on the left. Then S 70 W. ninety poles to a small white
 oak & small red oak. Then S 65 W. eighty eight poles to three black oak saplings. Then from the land
 of Ashton Patent N 32 W. eighty five poles to three scrubby black oaks. Then N 76 30 E. thence
 hundred & seventy eight poles to four small red oaks in a bottom near a cluster of pines corner to
 the said Tho^r Lee Esq^r. Then by the lines of the said Lee's land S 25 W. one hundred & twenty eight
 poles to a small hawthorn black oak on a knoll. Then South thirty four poles to the BEGINNING
 containing one hundred & eighty acres. Together with all Rights Members and Appurtenances
 thereto belonging Rousail, Hilt & Excepted and a full third part of all Lead, Copper, Iron
 Coal & Iron Ore that shall be found thereon: To have and to hold the said one hundred & eighty
 acres of land together with all Rights, Profits, Benefits to the same belonging or in any wise appur-
 tenancing Except before Excepted. To him the said William Saunders and his Heirs & Assigns
 forever. At the R^d William Saunders his Heirs & Assigns therefore Yielding & Paying to me my Heirs
 or Assigns or to my certain Attorney or Attorneys Agent or Agents or to the certain Attorney or
 Attorneys of my Heirs or Assigns Proprietors of the said Northern Neck Yearly & every Year on the
 feast day of St Michael the Archangel the sum of one shilling Sterling money for every fifty
 Acres of land hereby granted & so proportionably for a greater or lesser quantity. Provided
 that if the said William Saunders his Heirs or Assigns shall not pay the said reserved annual
 rent as aforesaid so that the same or any part thereof shall be behind or unpaid by the space of
 two whole Years after the same shall become due if Legally Demanded that then it shall &
 may be lawfull for me my Heirs or Assigns Proprietors as aforesaid my or their certain Attorney
 or Attorneys Agent or Agents into the above granted Premises to enter & hold the same so as if
 this Grant had never passed. Given at my Office in the County of Frederick under my hand &
 Seal. Dated the sixth day of October A^r D^m 1761.
