Appendix A

John Walden Meyers' wife's name has been listed as Mary/Polly Kruger/Cruger/Kroeger/vanHalenback/ and Gruber. I believe her parents were Johan Tobias Gruber and his wife, Catherine, who were sponsors at the bapt. of their dau., Catherine. Following the naming custom of the time, the 1st dau. would be named after the mother's mother, and the 2nd son after the mother's father. John and Polly named their 1st dau. Catherine, and their 2nd son Tobias.

I am proposing the following family for Johan Tobias Gruber and his wife, Catherine. If anyone has proof that I am or am not correct in my assumptions, I would be happy to hear from them.

Johan Tobias Gruber b. ; d. after February 1768 when he was a sponsor at the bapt. of the son of Mattheus Progue, Jr., and his wife, Anna.

m. perhaps by 1730 Catherine . . . b.

d. after 18 March 1767 when she was a sponsor at the bapt. of Catharina Walden Meyers, dau. of John & Mary/Polly.
Is it possible he was the John "Groubell" on a Dutchess Co. Tax list for the Middle Ward as early as 1736/7? This is someone's interpretation of the handwriting. Could it possibly be "Gruber"?

(If she were the dau. of Gysbert Westfall, she would have been an aunt of the George Westfall who m. Ella Walden Meyers, John's gr. dau.. If so, that might explain why George was in that area of Canada to become acquainted with Ella. Or perhaps George's mother remarried and went to Canada.)

Paulus & Catharina were sponsors for Catharina, dau. of Simon Westphal & Johanna Steenburg, at St. Paul's Luth. Ch. of Red Hook, prob. bet. 1775-1780. Paulus was also a sponsor at a bapt. in Red Hook in 1773. I believe it was this Paul Gruber, and not a John Gruber, who accompanied his bro.-in-law to Canada. Jane Goddard's book, Hans Waltimeyer, on p. 214, mentions that Paul Gruber was with John Walden Meyers at

Lachine in 1784. They rented a farm from a French family until September

1784.

I believe he is the Paul "Grubis" who was on a Crum Elbow Tax list in Dutchess Co., NY, in 1779. I believe someone misread the handwriting. (Nine-Partners, Crum Elbow, Charlotte)
Paul Gruber was elected Town Warden, along with Joseph Rosebush, in Sidney Twp., Hastings Co., Ont., Can., in May 1798. He owned 200 acres in Lot 6, Conc. 1, Sidney Twp., and in Lot 6, Broken Front A, in Sidney Twp. . This joined John Walden Meyers land. John Gruber was granted a patent from the Crown for this land on 20 November 1835. As early as 19 March 1825 he had been involved in transactions concerning this land as "son and heir-at-law of Paul Gruber". Several of the transactions were with children & gr.children of John & Polly Walden Meyers.

Christina Margaretha was b. in 1712 and d. in 1771.)

(There are no Krugers or Grubers in NY for the 1790 census.)
