Percy married **Ann Lydiate** on 26 Mar 1903. Ann was born on 13 Dec 1881, died in Feb 1962 aged 80, and was buried in St. Ann's Churchyard, Rainhill.

General Notes: Grew up in Bickerstaffe, near Rainford. Occupation: Barmaid and homemaker Religion: Church of England (Anglican)

Thomas married **Sarah Jane Tunstall** on 10 Sep 1936 in St Ann's Ce, Rainhill, England. Sarah was born on 11 Mar 1911 in Rainhill, England and died on 12 Jun 2003 in Rainhill, England aged 92.

General Notes: Met husband Tom while both worked as nurses at Rainhill Hospital. She gave up her Catholic religion to be married in a Protestant church and was rejected by her family except sister Monica.

General Notes: Information is provided by Jimmy Warburton of Narragansett, Rhode Island, a descendant. Jacob was from a Quaker farming family, though he was a hand loom weaver.

Jacob married **Sarah (Sally)** Ashton on 26 Oct 1806 in Middleton, St Leonard, Lancashire. Sarah was born on 9 Apr 1784 in Bury, Lancashire.

The child from this marriage was:

+ 2 M i. **Peter Warburton** was born on 8 Feb 1806 in Middleton, Lancashire and died on 22 Dec 1879 in Lawrence, Massachusetts aged 73.

Second Generation (Children)

2. Peter Warburton (*Jacob* (*James*)¹) was born on 8 Feb 1806 in Middleton, Lancashire and died on 22 Dec 1879 in Lawrence, Massachusetts aged 73.

General Notes: Peter's birthplace is from the 1851 census. A widower, he emigrated to Massachusetts, along with most if not all his family in 1852. He was aged 71 at the time of his death, and his death record names his parents as James and Sarah.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1841 in Hyde, Cheshire. Peter (35), is a cotton spinner living in George Street with Sarah (30), William (13), Jane (10), James (8), Henry (4), Sarah (1), and Peter (1). The name is written as Warbutton, and transcribed by Ancestry as Warbritton.
- He appeared on the census in 1851 in Hyde, Cheshire. Peter (45) is a widowed cotton overlooker of spinning living at 3 George Street with Jane (19) a weaver, James (17), a spinner, Henry (13) a cotton piecer, Peter (11), Sarah (11), Levi (8), Elizabeth (6), Samuel (3), and mother-in-law Mary Wardham (76) a widow. Mary presumably remarried as Sarah's name was Taylor.
- He appeared on the census in 1855 in Lawrence, Massachusetts. Peter (48) is an operative living with Martha (41), James (21) an operative, Henry (18) an operative, Peter (15), Sarah (15), Levi (14), Elizabeth (11), John E (3 months), and Mary Kerfoot (17).

Peter married **Sarah Taylor** on 28 Jul 1828 in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire. Sarah was born on 20 Jul 1808 in Barnsley, Yorkshire and died in 1851 in Hyde, Cheshire aged 43.

General Notes: Sarah's death was registered in 1q 1851 Stockport 19 215, age 43.

General Notes: William is not at home for the 1851 census and has not been found in that or subsequent censuses. Nor is there any death registration that fits. It isn't known if he went with the rest of the family to America.

Marriage Notes: Peter's age is given as 46, and his parents as James and Sarah.

General Notes: Martha was the daughter of William and Mary Mitchell, so had obviously been married before.

General Notes: Henry's birth was registered in 4q 1837 Stockport 19 186. He was a successful entrepreneur who owned the New England Thread Company.

Illustrated History of Pawtucket, Central Falls and Vicinity by Robert Grieve, 1897: In national and state affairs, Mr. Warburton is a Republican, but in local matters is guided entirely in his political actions by consideration of the city's best interests, regardless of party.

Henry married Jane E Critchley on 8 Sep 1862 in Lawrence, Massachusetts.

General Notes: Jane was the daughter of William and Mary Critchley of Portsmouth, New Hampshire.

Children from this marriage were:

14 M i. Franklin E Warburton was born on 19 Aug 1863 in Portsmouth, New Hampshire.

General Notes: Franklin was superintendent of mills.

General Notes: Frank was a shipper in Henry's business.

General Notes: Levi's birth was registered in 2q 1842 Stockport 19 263. Levi fought in the Civil War, and was a boot maker and engineer.

Levi married Alice Tetler on 23 Dec 1878 in Lawrence, Massachusetts.

General Notes: This family is based on information provided by David Warburton.

The closest marriage in time and place is to Ann Walch on 30th March 1823 at Bolton, St Peters. This is 9 weeks before John was baptised. This is confirmed as correct as Ann's maiden name is given on the baptisms of her children which are in the Nonconformist Register RG4-8, and listed on Lancashire Parishes Online.

There is no obvious census record for Thomas, his wife Ann, or children John and Betty in 1841 or 1851. George and Ann are possibly those living with Thomas and Betty Simpson at Turton in 1841.

Thomas married Ann Walsh on 30 Mar 1823 in Bolton, St Peter, Lancashire.

Marriage Notes: Ann's name is spelt Walch in the register.

Children from this marriage were:

- 2 M i. **John Warburton** was born on 18 Apr 1823 in Holme's, Sharples, Lancashire and was christened on 8 Jun 1823 in Walmsley Presbyterian Chapel, Lancashire.
- + 3 M ii. **George Warburton** was born on 26 Jan 1826 in Holmes's, Sharples, Lancashire, was christened on 26 Mar 1826 in Walmsley Presbyterian Chapel, Lancashire, and died in 1910 in Bolton, Lancashire aged 84.
 - 4 F iii. **Betty Warburton** was born on 5 Jun 1830 in Ferneysides, Little Lever, Bolton, Lancashire and was christened on 5 Aug 1830 in Walmsley Presbyterian Chapel, Lancashire.

3. George Warburton (*Thomas*¹) was born on 26 Jan 1826 in Holmes's, Sharples, Lancashire, was christened on 26 Mar 1826 in Walmsley Presbyterian Chapel, Lancashire, and died in 1910 in Bolton, Lancashire aged 84.

General Notes: George's baptism is in the Nonconformist Register RG4-8. His death is probably that registered in 1q 1910 Bolton 8c 272, aged 83.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1841 in Turton, Lancashire. George (15) is possibly the George who is living with Thomas and Betty Simpson at (looks like) St Warburton's Houses together with Ann (8) who is the correct age for George's sister.
- He appeared on the census in 1851 in Hindley, Lancashire. George (25) is a butcher living in Chapel Green with Elizabeth (29), and Thomas B (4).
- He appeared on the census in 1861 in Hindley, Lancashire. George Warbutton (35) is a butcher and ginger beer manufacturuer living in Bridge Street with Elizabeth (38) a confectioner, Thomas (14), and Mary Redmeyne (10) a visitor.
- He appeared on the census in 1871 in Hindley, Lancashire. George (45) is a farmer of 6 acres living in Bridge Street with Elizabeth (48).
- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Bolton, Lancashire. George (55) is probably the widowed horse dealer living at 74 Kay Street.

General Notes: Thomas is just Thomas on his birth registration but is sometimes Thomas Bland in censuses. He was born at 34 Bridge Lane, Lancaster. His father's occupation was butcher.

Several of Thomas's children's births were registered as Warbutton, others as Warburton. Of their 12 children, eleven are found in censuses. The 12th is presumed to be Thomas Bland Warburton, who died aged 2 in 1887, on the basis of his name and his registration district on LancashireBMD. In total four had died by the 1911 census. In addition to Thomas Bland, these are assumed to include eldest sons George and Thomas, as both names were reused. George only appears in the 1871 census and there is a death registration with the correct age and place. Similarly Thomas only appears in the 1881 census and there is a probable death registration, although the age is given as 12 when it should be 11. The fourth death is assumed to be Mary Ann as she is only found in the 1891 census and there is a death registration that fits. Of the other eight, six have been found in the 1911 census, but Elizabeth and George have yet to be identified.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1871 in Hindley, Lancashire. Thomas Bland (24) is a butcher living in Larner Street with Lucy (23), and George (6 months)
- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Hindley, Lancashire. Thomas Bland (34) is a master butcher living at 43 Chapel Green (house and shop) with Lucy (33), Thomas (8), Elizabeth (6), Lucy (4), John Charnock (3), and Ellen Mary (1).
- He appeared on the census in 1891 in Hindley, Lancashire. Thomas (44) is a butcher living at 3 Close Street with Lucy (43), Elizabeth (16), Lucy (14), John Charnock (13), Ellen Mary (11), Anne (9), Emily Florence (7), George (4), and Mary Ann (2).
- He appeared on the census in 1901 in Hindley, Lancashire. Thomas Bland (54) is a butcher/slaughterman living at 3 Close Street with Lucy (53), George (14) a cardboard box maker, and Alpheus Fred'k (9).
- He appeared on the census in 1911 in Hindley, Lancashire. Thomas Bland (64) is a dattler/underground labourer at a colliery and living at 3 Close Street, Castle Hill, with Lucy (63), daughter Lucy Partington (34) a weaver who has been married 11 years and had 3 chilldren, Thomas Partington (11), and Fred Partington (5). Thomas and Lucy have been married 40 years and had 12 children, 8 still living.

Thomas married **Lucy Charnock** on 22 May 1870 in Hindley, Lancashire. Lucy was born on 26 Jun 1847 in Wigan, Lancashire, was christened on 25 Jul 1847 in Wigan, Lancashire, and died in 1917 in Rochdale, Lancashire aged 70.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 2q 1870 Wigan 8c 30.

General Notes: Lucy's death is probably that registered as Lucy Warbutton in 1q 1917 Rochdale 8e 5, aged 69.

Children from this marriage were:

7 M i. George Warburton was born in 1870 in Hindley, Lancashire and died in 1877 in Hindley, Lancashire aged 7.

General Notes: George's birth was registered in 3q 1870 Wigan 8c 87. His death was registered in 3q 1877 Wigan 8c 53, aged 6.

8 M ii. **Thomas Warburton** was born in 1872 in Hindley, Lancashire, died in 1883 in Hindley, Lancashire aged 11, and was buried on 27 Sep 1883.

Elizabeth married Robert William Clarke. Robert died on 31 Jan 1945.

General Notes: Robert was a coal dealer.

10 F iv. Lucy Warburton was born in 1876 in Hindley, Lancashire and died on 13 Mar 1946 aged 70.

General Notes: Lucy's birth was registered in 2q 1876 Wigan 8c 100. She had a fourth child circa 1914-15, father unknown, presumably after Arthur went to America.

Noted events in her life were:

• She appeared on the census in 1911 in Hindley, Lancashire. Lucy (34) is a weaver, She and 2 sons are staying with her parents. She had been married for 11 years and had 3 children, all living.

Lucy married Arthur Partington in 1899 in Hindley, All Saints, Lancashire. Arthur died on 18 Feb 1921 in New Bedford, Massachusetts.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was regisered in 3q 1899 Wigan 8c 46. Lucy and Arthur had three children, Thomas, Frederick and Edna.

General Notes: Arthur went to America with the intention his family would follow, but Lucy refused to go.

 - 12 F vi. Ellen Mary Warburton was born in 1879 in Hindley, Lancashire and was buried in Haigh, St David, Lancashire.

General Notes: Ellen's birth was registered in 3q 1879 Wigan 8c 93. She and her husband lived in Mawdsley for many years. She lived with brother George for a short time after her husband's death.

Noted events in her life were:

- She appeared on the census in 1901 in Lowton, Lancashire. Ellen M (21), and Ann (19) are servants to Ann Green, a widow, at Oaklands, 184 Newton Road.
- She appeared on the census in 1911 in Haigh, Wigan, Lancashire. John Peter Sharrock (26) a dairy farmer, and Ellen Mary Sharrock (30) are living at 35 Haigh Road. Also present is Ellen's brother Alpheaus (19) a horseman (or houseman) on the farm. John and Ellen have been married 2 years and had no children.

Ellen married John Peter Sharrock in 1908 in Haigh, St David, Lancashire. John was born about 1884 and was buried in Haigh, St David, Lancashire.

General Notes: Mary's birth was registered in 4q 1888 Wigan 8c 102. Her death was registered in 1q 1894 Wigan 8c 55, aged 5.

18 M xii. Alpheaus Frederick Warburton was born in 1891 in Hindley, Lancashire and died on 7 Feb 1960 in Standish, Lancashire aged 69.

General Notes: Alpheaus's birth was registered in 3q 1891 Wigan 8c 90 under the name Warbutton. He was living at Brooklands, Wigan Road, Standish at the time of his death. His grandson David is my contact.

Noted events in his life were:

• He appeared on the census in 1911 in Haigh, Wigan, Lancashire. Alpheaus (19) is a horseman (or houseman) on the farm, living at 35 Haigh Road with brother-in-law John Peter Sharrock (26) a dairy farmer, and Ellen Mary Sharrock (30). John and Ellen have been married 2 years and had no children. Alpheaus is transcribed as Alpheans Frederick Warbrick on FindMyPast.

Alpheaus married **Margaret Preston** in 1912 in Wigan, All Saints, Lancashire. Margaret was born about 1891 and died in Nov 1958 in Standish, Lancashire aged about 67.

Marriage Notes: The mariage was registered in 4q 1912 Wigan 8c 111.

General Notes: Margaret was living at Brooklands, Wigan Road, Standish at the time of her death.

General Notes: William's birth was registered in 4q 1911, Wigan 8c 188, mother's maiden name Hammond.

- He appeared on the census in 1871 in Pilkington, Lancashire. John (53) is a coalminer living at 20 Edward Street with daughter Sarah (25) and her husband Squire Boaden (25), William R (24), Thomas (21), Joseph (17), James (15), and grandson Joseph (4).

General Notes: John's birth was registered in 4q 1842 Bury 21 281. He is not present in the 1881 census and is probably the John Edward whose death was registered in 1q 1872 Bury 8c 379, aged 29.

• He appeared on the census in 1871 in Pilkington, Lancashire. John E (25) is a coal miner living 'down cellar' at 7 Peel Street, Stand Lane with Mary (22), and lodger Emma Wilkinson (20) a cotton weaver from Cheshire.

John married **Mary Watson** in 1867 in Salford, St George, Lancashire. Mary was born about 1848 in Manchester, Lancashire.

Marriage Notes: The marriage registered in 1q 1867 Salford 8d 6 between John Edward Warburton and Mary Watson is probably the correct John, as his wife Mary is from Manchester.

- He appeared on the census in 1891 in Pilkington, Lancashire. Thomas (37) a coal miner is living with brotherin-law Squire Bowden (45), at 35 King Street. Also present are father John (69), sister Sarah Bowden (45), six of her children, and James D Fitton (1), a nephew of Squire and Sarah.
- He appeared on the census in 1901 in Pilkington, Lancashire. Thomas is probably incorrectly recorded as Robert (52) a gardener living at 145 Stand Lane with sister Sarah Boden (54) a widow, and 4 of her children.

- He appeared on the census in 1901 in Radcliffe, Lancashire. Joseph (46) is a coal miner (hewer) living at 9 Bowling Green Street with Emma (46), Sarah Ann (21) a cotton weaver, Emma (19) a cotton weaver, Mary Ellen (16) a polished cotton winder, John William (14) a dryer (cotton) in finishing works, Mary Elizabeth (10), and James (4).

Joseph married **Emma Hamnett** in 1879 in Radcliffe, St Thomas, Lancashire. Emma was born in 1854 in Radcliffe, Lancashire and died in 1924 aged 70.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 3q 1879 Bury 8c 546.

General Notes: Emma's birth was registered in 2q 1854 Bury 8c 391 under Hamnet. Her mother's maiden name was Chadwick. Her death was probably that registered in 4q 1924 Bury 8c 594, aged 70.

Noted events in her life were:

• She appeared on the census in 1911 in Radcliffe, Lancashire. Emma (58) is a widow living at 51 Spring Lane with Sarah Ann (31) a coloured weaver, Mary Ellen (26) a polish winder, Mary Elizabeth (20) a grey bath tenter, and Joseph (14) an assistant grocer. Emma was married 31 years and had 6 children, all living.

Marriage Notes: Sarah and Ralph had a son.

12 F ii. Emma Warburton was born in 1882 in Radcliffe, Lancashire.

General Notes: Emma's birth was registered in 1q 1882 Bury 8c 508 or 598 (Radcliffe sub-district, mother's maiden name Hamnett - Lancashire BMD).

Emma married Jim Coyne.

Marriage Notes: Emma and Jim had a son and 2 daughters.

13 F iii. Mary Ellen Warburton was born in 1884 in Radcliffe, Lancashire.

General Notes: Mary Ellen's birth was registered in 2q 1884 Bury 8c 604 (Radcliffe sub-district, mother's maiden name Hamnett - Lancashire BMD).

- + 14 M iv. John William Warburton was born in 1887 in Radcliffe, Lancashire and died in Aug 1935 aged 48.
 - 15 F v. Mary Elizabeth Warburton was born in 1891 in Radcliffe, Lancashire.

General Notes: Mary Elizabeth's birth was registered in 2q 1891 Bury 8c 671.

16 M vi. James Warburton was born in 1896 in Radcliffe, Lancashire.

General Notes: James's birth was registered in 2q 1896 Bury 8c 623.

Third Generation (Grandchildren)

14. John William Warburton (Joseph², John¹) was born in 1887 in Radcliffe, Lancashire and died in Aug 1935 aged 48.

General Notes: John is said to have emmigrated to Canada in 1901, and served in the Canadian forces in WWI. However the births of his children suggest he moved back and forth as he married in Lancashire and was present in the 1911 census, and for the birth of his first 2 children. Doris was born in Canada, then there were 2 further births in Lancashire before the last child was born in Canada. His WWI service may account for the return to Lancashire.

Noted events in his life were:

• He appeared on the census in 1911 in Bolton, Lancashire. John William (24) is a petrol motor waggon driver living at 29 Settle Street, Little Lever with Sarah Ann (23), and Hilda (1). John and Sarah had been married 1 year and had one child.

John married **Sarah Ann Marsh** on 1 May 1909 in Radcliffe, St Andrews, Lancashire. Sarah was born on 30 Sep 1888 in Radcliffe, Lancashire and died on 14 Oct 1973 in Burnaby, British Colombia aged 85.

Marriage Notes: John was a bachelor, aged 22, occupation warehouseman, residence 45 Knowles Street, father Joseph, coal miner, deceased. Sarah was a spinster, aged 21, occupation box marker-up, residence 8 Newchurch Street.

Children from this marriage were:

17 F i. Hilda Warburton was born in 1909 in Radcliffe, Lancashire and died in 1918 in Radcliffe, Lancashire aged 9.

General Notes: Hilda's birth is probably that registered in 4q 1909 Bolton 8c 491, and her death that registered in 1q 1919 Bury 8c 1030, aged 9.

18 M ii. Joseph Warburton was born in 1911 in Bolton, Lancashire and died in 1912 in Bolton, Lancashire aged 1.

General Notes: Joseph's birth was registered in 3q 1911 Bolton 8c 646. He is said to have died aged 18 months, but the only death registration that fits his date and place of birth was in 2q 1912 Bolton 8c 362, aged under 1.

19 F iii. Doris Warburton was born on 9 Nov 1914 in Calgary, Alberta.

Doris married **Norman Peace** in 1939 in Radcliffe, Full Gospel Tabernacle, Lancashire. Norman was born about 1907 in Birmingham, Warwickshire and died on 4 Dec 1971 in Vancouver, British Colombia aged about 64.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 4q 1939 Heywood 8c 1557.

Doris next married **Frederick Thomas Jarvie** on 21 Feb 1976 in Burnaby, British Colombia. Frederick was born on 31 Mar 1926 in Regina, Saskatchewan and died on 3 Mar 2006 in Surrey Memorial Hospital, Surrey, British Colombia aged 79.

20 F iv. Elsie Warburton was born in 1917 in Radcliffe, Lancashire and died in 1919 in Radcliffe, Lancashire aged 2.

General Notes: Elsie's birth was registered in 1q 1917 Bury 8c 854, and her death in 1q 1919 Bury 8c 1062, aged 2.

21 M v. John W Warburton was born in 1920 in Radcliffe, Lancashire and died in 1920 in Radcliffe, Lancashire.

General Notes: John is said to have been born and died in 1918 but the only registrations that fit are for a John W whose birth and death were registered in 2q 1920 (birth Bury 8d 1136, mother's maiden name Marsh, death Bury 8c 659).

22 F vi. Gladys Warburton was born on 22 Apr 1922 in Calgary, Alberta.

Gladys married **Herbert Dearden** in 1940 in Radcliffe, Full Gospel Tabernacle, Lancashire. Herbert was born in 1917 in Bury, Lancashire.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 3q 1940 Heywood 8c 1802. Gladys and Herbert had 2 daughters, but the marriage ended in divorce.
