#### **First Generation**

#### 1. John Warburton.

John married Margaret Hardy.

The child from this marriage was:

+ 2 M i. **John Warburton** was born about 1648 in Hale, Cheshire and died after 1729 in Mobberley, Cheshire.

#### **Second Generation (Children)**

2. John Warburton (John 1) was born about 1648 in Hale, Cheshire and died after 1729 in Mobberley, Cheshire.

General Notes: John's birth date is unclear as there are a couple of possible births, also infant deaths, and the probability that all births are not recorded. John is equated with John of Mobberley on the following circumstantial evidence:

- John is with his father for the 1667 Poll Tax. At that time there is no Warburton family in Mobberley. By 1671 John of Mobberley has appeared in Mobberley and started a family. After the death of his first wife he remarried to Elizabeth Trefis and had a second family. His two families are linked by his son John's will.
- His brother Enoch's will of 1692 lists Thomas of Hale, John of Mobberley, and Josiah of Hale as executors. These are the names of his brothers in the correct birth sequence with John in the middle, implying John is his brother.
- John of Mobberley's date of death is unknown but he would appear to be alive in 1722 when his son John is called John junior on his wifes burial record.
- His brother Josiah mentions John and his wife Elizabeth in his will, written in 1729, indicating they were alive at that time. This ties in with Elizabeth Trefis, John of Mobberley's second wife. Also despite a long life, Josiah's brother left no trace in the Bowdon parish record.

Noted events in his life were:

- Legacy: 14 Jan 1686, Hale, Cheshire. John is bequeathed 10 shillings in his father's will. The will was proved March 21st 1692.
- Legacy: 8 Apr 1729. He was bequeathed £5 in his brother Josiah's will, to go to his wife Elizabeth if he was dead. Josiah did in 1730.

John married **Mary** about 1669 in Bowdon St Mary, Cheshire. Mary was born about 1650, died in 1678 aged about 28, and was buried on 7 Jan 1678 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: This marriage is probably at either Mobberley or Bowdon. There is no record in the Mobberley records, and since there is a 9 year gap in the Bowdon records at this time the wedding is assumed to be there.

General Notes: Mary's burial is only recorded in the Mobberley Bishop's Transcripts. Also IGI gives the date as 7th Feb.

Children from this marriage were:

- + 3 M i. **Thomas Warburton** was born in 1672 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened on 11 Jan 1672 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, died in 1724 in Mobberley, Cheshire aged 52, and was buried on 15 Oct 1724 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.
  - 4 F ii. **Deborah Warburton** was born in 1673 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened on 25 Dec 1673 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, died in 1675 in Mobberley, Cheshire aged 2, and was buried on 19 Apr 1675 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.
    - General Notes: Deborah's burial is only recorded in the Bishop's Transcript with the comment 'killed under the stone in the Bark Mill'.
- + 5 M iii. **John Warburton** was born in 1676 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened on 8 Aug 1676 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, died in 1754 in Mobberley, Cheshire aged 78, and was buried on 26 Sep 1754 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.

John next married **Elizabeth Trefis** on 1 Sep 1701 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire. Elizabeth was born in 1673 in Mobberley, Cheshire, died on 16 Sep 1747 in Mobberley, Cheshire aged 74, and was buried on 17 Sep 1747 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.

General Notes: A grave at Mobberley St Wilfreds holds Elizabeth widow of John died Sept 1717, aged 71. This does not tie in with Josiah's will, or the IGI member's submission giving her death as 1747. Also there is a parish record of her burial in 1747.

No other John had a wife Elizabeth at this time. The third digit of the date on the grave is clearly a one, though the other digits are missing their lower halves. Could the date have been recarved incorrectly at a later date?

Her age at death would imply she was born in 1676, but an IGI member submission says 1673. There is no parish record of her baptism at Mobberley.

#### Children from this marriage were:

- 6 M i. **William Warburton** was born in 1701 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened on 5 Dec 1701 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, and died before 1756.
  - General Notes: He is not mentioned in half-brother John's will in 1756 so is assumed dead by then. However there is no further evidence of him in the Mobberley parish records so he either died young or moved away.
- + 7 M ii. **Josiah Warburton** was born on 24 Nov 1704 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened in 1704 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, died on 5 Mar 1785 in Nether Knutsford, Cheshire aged 80, and was buried on 8 Mar 1785 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.
  - 8 F iii. **Mary Warburton** was christened on 28 Mar 1707 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire and was buried on 26 Sep 1776 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.

Mary married **James Cherry** on 13 Apr 1727 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire. James was christened on 12 Mar 1703 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.

#### Third Generation (Grandchildren)

**3.** Thomas Warburton (*John* <sup>2</sup>, *John* <sup>1</sup>) was born in 1672 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened on 11 Jan 1672 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, died in 1724 in Mobberley, Cheshire aged 52, and was buried on 15 Oct 1724 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.

General Notes: Thomas is described as Thomas senior, blacksmith on his burial record.

Thomas married **Mary**. Mary died in 1729 in Mobberley, Cheshire and was buried in Nov 1729 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: Thomas's wedding record has not been found. Even the name of his wife is conjecture based on the fact that the widow who died in 1729 doesn't fit any other Warburton family in Mobberley.

#### Children from this marriage were:

- + 9 M i. **Thomas Warburton** was born in 1691 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened on 9 Nov 1691 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, died in 1779 in Mobberley, Cheshire aged 88, and was buried on 2 Jan 1780 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.
- 10 F ii. Mary Warburton was born in 1693 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened on 25 Sep 1693 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, died in 1693 in Mobberley, Cheshire, and was buried on 8 Nov 1693 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.
- 11 F iii. **Mary Warburton** was born in 1695 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened on 18 Jan 1695, and died before 1756.
  - Mary married William Stubbs on 11 Jun 1716 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.
- 12 F iv. **Deborah Warburton** was born on 10 Dec 1696 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened on 12 Dec 1696 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, died in 1697 in Mobberley, Cheshire aged 1, and was buried on 1 Feb 1697 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.
- + 13 M v. **Enoch Warburton** was born on 27 Jan 1699 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened on 5 Feb 1699 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, died on 28 Oct 1771 in Mobberley, Cheshire aged 72, and was buried in 1771 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.
  - 14 F vi. **Elizabeth Warburton** was born in 1701 in Mobberley, Cheshire and was christened on 18 May 1701 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.

Elizabeth married Isaac Goodier on 2 Jun 1725.

Marriage Notes: Isaac is from Wilmslow on the parish register. They were married by Mr Dodd, curate of Wilmslow.

15 F vii. **Deborah Warburton** was born about 1705 in Mobberley, Cheshire.

General Notes: Deborah is only known from a mention in uncle John's will. Her positioning in the will suggests she was born between Elizabeth and Aaron.

- 16 M viii. George Warburton was born in 1703 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened on 28 Feb 1703 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, died in 1706 in Mobberley, Cheshire aged 3, and was buried on 18 Jun 1706 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.
- 17 M ix. **Peter Warburton** was born on 10 Feb 1705 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened in 1705 in Mobberley, St

Wilfred, Cheshire, died in 1706 in Mobberley, Cheshire aged 1, and was buried on 9 Mar 1706 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.

- + 18 M x. **Peter Warburton** was born in 1707 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened on 13 Jan 1707 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, died in 1761 in Mobberley, Cheshire aged 54, and was buried on 15 May 1761 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.
- + 19 M xi. **Aaron Warburton** was born about 1709 in Mobberley, Cheshire.
- + 20 M xii. **George Warburton** was born about 1711 in Mobberley, Cheshire, died in 1746 aged about 35, and was buried on 23 Dec 1746 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.
- **5. John Warburton** (*John* <sup>2</sup>, *John* <sup>1</sup>) was born in 1676 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened on 8 Aug 1676 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, died in 1754 in Mobberley, Cheshire aged 78, and was buried on 26 Sep 1754 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.

General Notes: John was a tanner. He left a will suggesting some wealth in which he named many family members. In some cases this is sole proof of family links. His estate included 3 leasehold properties, and one owned outright.

He is buried in grave 854 at Mobberley along with Ann Whitakker his grand daughter-in-law, and her son Thomas. The date and his age are unclear.

He seems to have had 3 sons called John, all dying in infancy. Only his daughters produced grandchildren. None of his daughters receive a bequest in his will so all are presumed dead, although only Mary is mentioned as deceased.

John married **Sarah Cragg** on 3 Dec 1696 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire. Sarah was born in 1670 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened on 25 Dec 1670 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, died on 23 Apr 1722 in Mobberley, Cheshire aged 52, and was buried in 1722 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: Sarah is the wife of John junior, tanner on her burial record. She is in grave 855 in Mobberley along with her grandson John Whittaker (spelt Witeakers on the grave).

Children from this marriage were:

- 21 M i. **John Warburton** was born in 1697 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened on 18 Aug 1697 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, died in 1697 in Mobberley, Cheshire, and was buried on 20 Nov 1697 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.
- 22 F ii. **Mary Warburton** was born in 1698 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened on 18 Sep 1698 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, and died before 1756.

General Notes: She is 'my late daughter Mary ' in her father's will.

Mary married **James Hanson** on 7 Feb 1719 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire. James was born in 1681 in Mobberley, Cheshire and was christened on 25 Dec 1681 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: There was also a James Hanson born in Mobberley in 1676. Mary and James's children who were living and mentioned in her father's will in 1756 were:

- Mary (bap. Nov 7th 1722 in Mobberley). Mary is probably the Mary wife of John Robinson mentioned in her grandfather's will. She received £20 plus £10 to each of her unnamed daughters.
- Sarah (bap. Dec 27th 1724 in Mobberley). She shared the residue of her Grandfather's personal estate with her sister Martha. She was unmarried in 1756.
- Martha (bap. Set 6th 1726 in Mobberley). She shared the residue of her Grandfather's personal estate with her sister Sarah. She was unmarried in 1756.
- William. William is only known from a bequest of £20 in his grandfather's will. His baptism is not on IGI. His sisters were baptised at Mobberley St. Wilfreds.

#### Mary next married Thomas Whittaker.

Marriage Notes: Mary's second marriage to Thomas Whittaker is presumed from the record of her son John's baptism on March 25th 1742 at Mobberley St. Wilfreds, which matches his burial on June 21st 1805 aged 63, also at Mobberley, and which names his mother as Mary. He was buried in grave 855 with his Grandmother Sarah Warburton. On the baptism record he is Whittakers, and on his grave Whiteakers.

John inherited his Grandfather's Mobberley messuage (purchased from Richard Toft, and where his Grandfather resided).

John's wife was Ann (d. May 12 1824 aged 83) and she and a son Thomas (d. June 26 1807, aged 32) are buried with John's grandfather John Warburton in grave 854.

- 23 M iii. **John Warburton** was born in 1699 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened on 18 Aug 1699 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, and died before 1716.
- 24 F iv. **Sarah Warburton** was born on 14 Jun 1701 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened on 22 Jun 1701 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, and died before 1756.

General Notes: Sarah is not mentioned in her father's will. Six daughters are. Esther received the leasehold estate at Tatton (leased from Samuel Egerton), but had to pay her sisters (Sarah, Mary, Hannah, Elizabeth and Fanny) £40 apiece. The 5 sisters also received £60 a piece on reaching 21 or marrying. The money was given to their father John Bradshaw to put out at interest for them.

Only the baptisms of Sarah (Nov 9 1731) and Mary (Dec 3 1732) are on IGI at Rostherne. Therefore if Esther was the eldest she must have been born before her parents marriage, so she might have inherited despite not bing the eldest.

Sarah married John Bradshaw on 26 Dec 1730 in Rostherne, Cheshire. John died after 1756.

v. **Esther Warburton** was born on 14 Apr 1706 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened in 1706 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, and died before 1756.

Esther married John Barlow on 13 Jun 1734 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: John Barlow's birth is not recorded at Mobberley. Ester and John's children were:

- Ann (bap. April 7th 1743 at St Wilfreds, Mobberley). She inherited £300 from her Grandfather.
- John (bap Dec. 12th 1745 at Ashley). John is known from an IGI member submission which indicates the family lived at Ashley. Ashley comes under Bowdon so a baptism at Ashley implies a non-conformist baptism at home (or maybe at Hale Chapel). He is not mentioned in his grandfather's will so is presumably dead by 1756.
- Warburton (bap. Feb 17th 1737 at Ashley). His baptism is only known from an IGI member submission. It was probably a non-conformist baptism at home (see brother John). In his Grandfather's will he inherits the lease to an estate in Butley, leased from Charles Legh (subject to an annual annuity of £10 to his step grandmother Sarah), plus £150.
- 26 F vi. Ann Warburton was born about 1707 in Mobberley, Cheshire and died before 1756.

General Notes: There is no parish record of the baptism, mereley an IGI member submission. There is no record of her marriage. She is not mentioned in her grandfather's will.

27 M vii. John Warburton was born in 1716 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened on 13 Feb 1716 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, died in 1716 in Mobberley, Cheshire, and was buried on 24 May 1716 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.

John next married **Sarah Barrow** on 7 Feb 1725 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire. Sarah was born in 1692 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened on 22 Nov 1692 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, died on 2 Apr 1764 in Mobberley, Cheshire aged 72, and was buried on 29 Apr 1764 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: Sarah received a half share of her husband's lease in Bexton, shared with half-brother-in-law Josiah, and a £10 pa annuity off the leasehold at Butely. She was buried in grave 340.

**7. Josiah Warburton** (*John* <sup>2</sup>, *John* <sup>1</sup>) was born on 24 Nov 1704 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened in 1704 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, died on 5 Mar 1785 in Nether Knutsford, Cheshire aged 80, and was buried on 8 Mar 1785 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.

General Notes: Josiah is in grave 928 with his wife Ann, however his age is given as 'in his 68th year', when he was in fact 80. He is described as of Marthall, late of Duckenfields in Mobberley on his burial record.

His will mentions all his children (except the first Ann), although Elizabeth is already dead. No children are mentioned for John so he maybe never married. Bequests include 2 pews at the parish church of Nether Knutsford, which go to John and Thomas, suggesting Josiah had no need of one.

Noted events in his life were:

- Legacy: 1756. IJosiah received £10 and each of his five children received 40s from his half brother John's will. He also received a half share in a lease in Broxton with John's wife Sarah, and was an executor.
- He signed a will in 1784. Josiah left a will in which he is described as of Nether Knutsford. Marthall and Nether Knutsford are essentially the same place.

Josiah married **Ann Bracegirdle** on 1 Sep 1726 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire. Ann was born on 10 Dec 1703 in Mobberley, Cheshire, died on 7 Nov 1764 in Mobberley, Cheshire aged 60, and was buried on 9 Nov 1764 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.

General Notes: Ann is buried in grave 928 with her husband in "her 61st" year.

General Notes: Elizabeth is only known from her father's will, by which time she is deceased.

Elizabeth married **Samuel Burgess** on 12 Nov 1771 in Rostherne, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: Elizabeth and Samuel had 2 daughters, Ann and Elizabeth, who received £40 between them from grandfather John's will. Neither baptism is in IGI.

General Notes: Enoch was a blacksmith in Mobberley until around 1730 when he becomes a farmer at the Old Hall, Mobberley. On Octber 28th 1771 a new black or coffin cloth was bought for the use of the parishoners of Mobberley and was first laid over Enoch. He is buried in grave 422 which gives his age at death as 72.

Enoch's will was proved on November 11th. Enoch's estate consisted of a leasehold estate called The Black Greyhound in Over Alderley, from the heirs of Sir Peter Leysester. This was left to his wife Sarah for her natural life, but if any lives on the lease then remain it goes to his son Thomas.

He alos left bequests to his grandshildren:

James Hagarth - £100 (to go to his mother sarah if he dies before the age of 21).

All bequests to be paid only on sarah's death. sarah, Joseph Harrison and Josiah Varden were executors.

Noted events in his life were:

• He signed a will on 29 Aug 1771 in Mobberley, Cheshire. See notes.

Enoch married Sarah Higginbottom on 15 Nov 1724 in Alderley, Cheshire. Sarah died in 1773 in Mobberley, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: Administration of Srah's affairs was granted to her daughter Sarah Haygarth, son-in-law John Barrow, and John Poole. Reference is made to Thomas, Innkeeper, John of Radnor, farmer, Elizabeth and John barrow (farmr), and the children of Enoch (late of Nether Knutsford), and Hannah Higginson (Innkeeper).

General Notes: She is buried in grave 422, age at death 70. However the date of her death is May 12th 1839 which must be an error. Her burial is not in the parish record.

- 74 F iv. **Mary Warburton** was born in 1788 in Rostherne, Cheshire and was christened on 9 Jan 1788 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.
- 75 F v. **Martha Warburton** was born in 1796 in Rostherne, Cheshire and was christened on 29 May 1796 in Rostherne, Cheshire.
- **43. John Warburton** (*Enoch* <sup>4</sup>, *Thomas* <sup>3</sup>, *John* <sup>2</sup>, *John* <sup>1</sup>) was born in 1732 in Mobberley, Cheshire, was christened on 1 Jan 1733 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, died in 1817 in Radnor, Cheshire aged 85, and was buried on 31 Oct 1817 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.

General Notes: John appeared in the Styal parish census in 1801 living with John senior, and his wife Elizabeth, and in 1811 living in his own home. He is absent in 1821, but there is no burial.

79 M iv. **Enoch Warburton** was born in 1767 in Wilmslow, Cheshire, was christened on 30 Jun 1767 in Wilmslow, Cheshire, died on 30 Jul 1782 in Radnor, Cheshire aged 15, and was buried in 1782 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.

General Notes: Enoch was buried in grave 427 "aged 15 years", along with his infant brother Charles.

80 M v. **Thomas Warburton** was born in 1771 in Radnor, Cheshire and was christened on 5 May 1771 in Astbury, St Mary, Cheshire.

General Notes: Thomas is the son of John and Mary and the only Warburton baptism at Astbury, St Mary, which covers Radnor, in the period, suggesting it is unlikely to be another family.

Enoch married **Ann Dicken** on 13 Apr 1757 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: Ann is from Knutsford. John and Thomas (presumably Enoch's brothers) are witnessses. There are no children of Enoch and Ann on IGI.

John married **Ellen Dooley** on 17 Oct 1797 in Rostherne, Cheshire. Ellen was born in 1778 in Macclesfield, Cheshire, was christened on 12 Apr 1778 in Macclesfield St Michael, Cheshire, died in 1852 in Gatley, Cheshire aged 74, and was buried on 31 Dec 1852 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire.

General Notes: Ellen's baptism on IGI would make her 74 at death, not 73 as stated on her grave. However there is no other near match on IGI. She is buried in grave 380 with her parents-in-law John and Mary, two brothers-in-law Peter and James, who died in infancy, and her husband John.

He was a tailor on his children's baptisms. He is not in the 1851 census so probably died beforehand. The death registered in 3q 1850 Macclesfield 19 69 is the most likely, but there is no age at death.

- He appeared on the census in 1871 in Hale, Cheshire. James (aged 36) is an agriculturl labourer. With him is Ann Reed (31), a boarder, and her sons Edward Motterhead (12), and Ethelbert Reed (4), and daughter Mary Reed (3 months).
- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Hale, Cheshire. James, aged 46, is an aricultural labourer living with his wife Anne (39), sons Ethelbert Read (14), John W Warburton (7), and Thomas (1), and daughter Mary Read (10) in Davenport Green.

When Edwin died the local newspaper carried an obituary that described him as having had an adventurous career at sea that read like a page from the works of Joseph Conrad.

His career on the sea began in 1884 when he joined the Royal Navy. A few years later whilst cruising in South American seas, he and the British Naval men where celebrating the Queens Jubilee in Monte Video, when he and three other men where shanghaied and enrolled into the Argentinean Navy where he served on the gunboat Los Andros.

It was about this time that he and the other men found themselves stranded on a small island and the party suffered intense hardships being reduced to eating parts of their own boots. In 1889 making off, they deserted from the Argentinean Navy and joined a Merchant ship bound for Barbados. The ship was wrecked and he was brought back to England.

He served in various ships in the Merchant Service. Later he left the sea and returned to Tunstall where on account of his expert knowledge of sailor knots he became well known as a scaffolding erector. He had also worked in various collieries and ironworks in the Tunstall district.

In August of 1914 he joined the North Staffordshire Regiment and was later transferred to the East York's, and then to the Lincolnshire's. With the last he served in India until invalided home with sunstroke. Although discharged as unfit he joined the Army again on two other occasions during the War.

In Tunstall Mr Warburton was known as "the man who could climb like a cat". Given a piece of rope he could climb almost any home without the aid of a ladder.

One of his exploits as a climber is often spoken of by the local people. When the Prince of Wales visited Tunstall a few years ago, Mr Warburton climbed to the top of the Town Hall and scaled the masonry that supports the weather vane. The market square, in which schoolchildren where assembled was crowded at the time. Mr Warburton, from his perch waved to the Prince. It is on record that His Royal Highness smilingly waved back to him.

At one time Mr Warburton had a habit of climbing to the top of St Mary's Church, Tunstall "to keep his hand in" as he used to explain, and on one occasion climbed to the top of Christ Church for a bet, "the stakes where a quart of beer". All his climbing was done in sailor fashion, in his stocking feet. Going to the other extreme he went down a disused pit-shaft some years ago and rescued a dog;

He is survived by a widow, three sons, and four daughters.
