



#### **First Generation**

**1. George Warburton** was born about 1674 in Partington, Cheshire, died on 26 Jan 1735 aged about 61, and was buried in Warburton, St Werberg, Cheshire.

General Notes: This tree is based on that recorded on the Sullivan County Settlers site by Lyle Rockwell and Larry Pardoe at: http://www.rootsweb.ancestry.com/~pasulliv/settlers/settlers53/settlers53.htm (refered to as the Settlers Site). They in turn took their information from the John & Mary Sadler Warburton Family Bible, and it particular the Diary (refered to as the Family Diary), in possession of their GGGgrandson George Robert Warburton, born in 1930, together with information from George on the descendants of George T. Warburton, son of John & Mary Warburton. I have added details and opinions to the early English generations, including additional material from Cathy Warburton of California.

The Settlers Site gives George's birthplace as Liverpool. However known events such as George's place of burial, and events in the lives of his children are all in the Lymm, Warburton, Hollinsfare area until his grandson John moved to Liverpool around 1800. Therefore he was most likely born in that area, and it is possible that he is the 12 year old George who is mentioned in the 1686 Inventory of George of Partington.

George married **Mary Chantler** on 8 May 1707 in Lower Peover, Cheshire. Mary was born about 1686, died in 1766 aged about 80, and was buried on 5 Feb 1766 in Warburton, St Werberg, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: The marriage location is from FamilySearch and contrdicts the Settlers Site which places the marriage at Warburton.

- 2 F i. **Margaret Warburton** was born on 24 Nov 1708, died on 13 Jun 1729 aged 20, and was buried on 14 Jun 1729 in Warburton, St Werberg, Cheshire.
  - General Notes: Margaret is the daughter of George of Warburton on her burial record.
- 3 F ii. Elizabeth Warburton was born on 19 Feb 1710 and died on 28 Dec 1752 aged 42.
  - Elizabeth married Thomas Hornby.
- + 4 M iii. **George Warburton** was born on 14 Nov 1718, was christened on 27 Nov 1718 in Bowdon, St Mary, died in 1761 in Heatley Heath, Lymm, Cheshire aged 43, and was buried on 2 Jul 1761 in Lymm, St Mary The Virgin, Cheshire.
- + 5 M iv. **Peter Warburton** was born on 14 Apr 1725, died on 24 Jun 1794 aged 69, and was buried on 27 Jun 1794 in Hollinfare, St Helen, Lancashire.

**4. George Warburton** (*George* <sup>1</sup>) was born on 14 Nov 1718, was christened on 27 Nov 1718 in Bowdon, St Mary, died in 1761 in Heatley Heath, Lymm, Cheshire aged 43, and was buried on 2 Jul 1761 in Lymm, St Mary The Virgin, Cheshire.

General Notes: George's baptism is a possible match as the baptism record names his father as George of Partington, and it fits the birth date.

George lived near Warburton Mill and had 2 sons and 2 daughters, George, Thomas, Mary and Margaret. who were mentioned in his will. Also mentioned were brother Peter of Carryshut (Cadishead?), and witnesses Thomas Chandler, John Ridgeway, and wife Mary. Mary must be his second wife as the mother of his children was Sarah. Peter, Thomas, and Mary were executors.

George married **Sarah Okill** on 18 Nov 1746 in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire.

Marriage Notes: This is the best fit marriage, though it took place only 2 weeks before Thomas was born.

Children from this marriage were:

6 M i. **Thomas Warburton** was born on 3 Dec 1746 in Lymm, Cheshire, was christened on 19 Dec 1746 in Lymm, St Mary The Virgin, Cheshire, died on 26 Jan 1826 in Heatley Heath, Lymm, Cheshire aged 79, and was buried on 29 Jan 1826 in Lymm, St Mary The Virgin, Cheshire.

General Notes: Thomas's baptism record names his father George. He had no children. His will mentions several nephews, including Brazendales and Highams. He was aged 80 on his gravestone.

Thomas married **Catherine**. Catherine was born about 1751, died on 16 Mar 1826 in Heatley Heath, Lymm, Cheshire aged about 75, and was buried on 19 Mar 1826 in Lymm, St Mary The Virgin, Cheshire.

General Notes: Two Catherines married a Thomas Warburton at Manchester Cathedral, Catherine Chadwick on

February 10th 1784, and Catherine Goodier on 12th December 1786. She was aged 75 on her gravestone.

7 F ii. **Mary Warburton** was born on 5 Aug 1748 in Heatley Heath, Lymm, Cheshire and was christened on 14 Aug 1748 in Lymm, St Mary The Virgin, Cheshire.

General Notes: Mary was the daughter of George of Heatley Heath on her baptism record.

Mary married **George Brazendale** on 2 Mar 1764 in Lymm, St Mary The Virgin, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: George and Mary had 3 sons and a daughter.

8 M iii. **John Warburton** was born in 1750 in Heatley Heath, Lymm, Cheshire, was christened on 6 Apr 1750 in Lymm, St Mary The Virgin, Cheshire, died in 1751 aged 1, and was buried on 6 Apr 1751 in Lymm, St Mary The Virgin, Cheshire.

General Notes: John was the son of George of Heatley Heath on his baptism, and burial records.

9 F iv. **Margaret Warburton** was born in 1753 in Heatley Heath, Lymm, Cheshire and was christened on 21 Jul 1753 in Lymm, St Mary The Virgin, Cheshire.

General Notes: Margaret was the daughter of George of Heatley Heath on her baptism record.

Margaret married James Higham on 1 Feb 1792 in Lymm, St Mary The Virgin, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: Margaret and James had 2 sons.

10 M v. **George Warburton** was born in 1756 in Heatley Heath, Lymm, Cheshire and was christened on 2 Apr 1856 in Lymm, St Mary The Virgin, Cheshire.

General Notes: George's parents are George and Sarah on his baptism record. His most likely marriage was to Ann Baguley at Lymm on April 30 1778 but he hasn't been explored further. The Richmond family tree names his children as Margaret, Sarah, and Martha.

11 M vi. **John Warburton** was born on 10 Nov 1758 in Lymm, Cheshire and was buried on 23 Nov 1758 in Lymm, St Mary The Virgin, Cheshire.

General Notes: John's parents are George and Sarah on his burial record.

#### George next married Mary.

General Notes: Mary is only known from George's will. There is no record of Sarah's death or the marriage to Mary yet found.

**5. Peter Warburton** (*George* <sup>1</sup>) was born on 14 Apr 1725, died on 24 Jun 1794 aged 69, and was buried on 27 Jun 1794 in Hollinfare, St Helen, Lancashire.

General Notes: From the Family Diary: 'Father Peter Warburton died, aged 66 years.... My father & mother P & M Warburton was laid in Hollinsgreen Chapel Yard, north east side.' According to FamilySearch they were in fact buried at Hollinfare a chapelry in Warrington parish which includes Hollins Green. The church of St Helen, Hollinfare was founded before 1500.

Peter married **Mary Molyneux** on 5 Nov 1767. Mary was born in 1735 in Manchester, Lancashire, was christened on 12 Oct 1735 in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire, died in 1809 aged 74, and was buried on 14 Nov 1809 in Hollinfare, St Helen, Lancashire.

Marriage Notes: This date is from a member submission to IGI and there is no on-line record of it in parish records on FamilySearch, or on Lancashire Parishes Online.

General Notes: Mary was the daughter of Edward and Martha Molyneux. The Family Bible gives her age as 74 when she died.

Children from this marriage were:

Thomas lived in Lymm, Cheshire and had no issue.

14 F iii. Mary Warburton was born in 1775 in Rixton-With-Glazebrook, Lancashire and was christened on 13 Feb

1775 in Hollinfare, St Helen, Lancashire.

+ 15 M iv. **Peter Warburton** was born in 1778 in Rixton-With-Glazebrook, Lancashire, was christened on 17 Apr 1778 in Hollinfare, St Helen, Lancashire, died in 1838 aged 60, and was buried on 29 Dec 1838 in Hollinfare, St Helen, Lancashire.

**12. John Warburton** (*Peter*<sup>2</sup>, *George* <sup>1</sup>) was born in 1770 in Rixton-With-Glazebrook, Lancashire, was christened on 13 Apr 1770 in Hollinfare, St Helen, Lancashire, and died on 7 Sep 1836 in Elkland, Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania aged 66.

General Notes: It was John who took the The Warburton Family Bible, published in 1639, and its associated Diary, to the USA in 1816. It was thought to be in the Warburton family for hundreds of years. It was handed down from John to his son George Thomas, to George's daughter Cora Belle, to Belle's nephew George Harry Warburton, and to George Harry's son George Robert Warburton, who has them in his possession.

The Family Diary states: John Warburton, son of Peter & Mary Warburton, departed this life Sept 7th, 1836, aged 66 at Elkland, Sullivan Co., PA.

About 1800 John went to Liverpool to be warehouse man (to receive & deliver goods) for H. Hunny & C.H. Jones, 4 years and more. Office on Angile St.

Other quotes from the Diary include:

I was married to Mary Sadler, daughter of Samuel Sadler, Molton, Cheshire.

Went to be warehouseman for Hamilton & Graham 2 years, office on Angile St.

Went to be warehouseman for Samuel Hope for more than 4 years, office in Water St. at top.

Son James died, aged 4 years. Jesse born.

My mother Mary Warburton departed this life, aged 74 years.

1810 - The spire at St. Nicholas Church fell and killed 21 persons. Mary Ann, my daughter was born April 14.

1812 - Sister Martha Warburton departed this life, aged 26 years. Wife to brother Peter.

1814 - William, my son born Sept. 7th.

1816 - Sailed from Liverpool June 11, 1816 to America in ship Robert Burns, Captain Parsons of New York. On June 18th we were on the banks of New Foundland, where we caught some fish. Landed at New York August 3rd, 54 days. All in good health. We came through Newark and Easton in New Jersey to the Forks of the Loyalsock Creek, Forks Township, Lycoming County, PA.

1817 - Son Peter born Dec 7th

1817 - Oct 14th, agreed with Mr. Eldred for 100 acres of land more or less in Elk Creek bottom, to take 2/3 of mountain for 1/3 of bottom land at \$3.50 an acre with 5 years credit.

Agreed for 79 acres of land at Elkland Township, Lycoming County.

Joseph Sadler arrived in America from Liverpool.

1820 - Daughter Elizabeth born April 17th. (Joseph Sadler died)

1822 - June 5th bought a cow of William King for \$4.00 with 12 months credit.

1823 - Son Samuel born March 19th at 9 o'clock morning.

I, John Warburton was at Williamsport, May court, and filed my interchange to become a Citizen of the United States of America, to appear at the Williamsport Court in May 1825 to get naturalized. On May 1826, got certificate from Williamsport.

Edw. J. Eldred Esq. gave me first refusal of the lot of land No. 40 Southeast corner & 39 corner below my land, April 14, 1824.

May 12th 1836 William Eldred to J. Warburton Sen. - Two cats for horse and dinner, 25 cents.

The Census of 1820 Elkland Twp., Sullivan Co., PA shows John's household included a male and female aged 26 to 45, 2 boys and 2 girls under 10, and 2 boys and one girl aged 10 to 16.

The first successful organized effort to permanently establish means for the education of the youth, was made at Forksville. The school was opened December 1, 1816, John Warburton being the first teacher employed.

#### History of Elkland Township:

John Warburton is first mentioned as a teacher of the Forksville School in 1816. He settled on lands near Joseph Reeves. The first elections of the township were held in his house. He was prominent among those entrusted with the township business.

From the "Lycoming Gazette", 21 Sept. 1836:

"John Warburton died at his residence in Elkland Twp., on the 8th inst., at an advanced age. He was among the earliest settlers in the county and has left a wife and large family."

John married Mary Sadler on 10 Apr 1803 in Liverpool, St Peter, Lancashire. Mary was born on 28 Mar 1783 in Davenham,

Cheshire, was christened on 20 Apr 1783 in Davenham, St Wilfred, Cheshire, and died on 20 Sep 1865 in Plymouth, Sheboygan Co., Wisconsin aged 82.

Marriage Notes: John and Mary were both living in Liverpool at the time of their marriage. Mary's father Samuel is described as from near Winsford.

General Notes: Fron the Family Diary:

1811 - Saturday April 6th my wife Mary Warburton went to Wales by Chester Packata (sic) conveyance to the Veal of Cluid (Vale of Clwyd) to see our little boy Tesse (Jesse) that is in school at Rithen, and returned 8 days after.

After the death of John in 1836, Mary moved out to the State of Ohio with five of the youngest children, landing in Medina County the beginning of December 1836, "being 13 days (on the road?)". She started for Wisconsin on the 24th of July, 1848 and landed at Sheboygan on the 29th about one o'clock P.M. (One account says 27th).

She was taken sick Sept 11th 1865 and died on the 20th of said month. Taken sick 2 days after moving in with George which she hoped to enjoy a few months of comfort with his old mother after he returned from the war but only spent 2 days of enjoyment before Mother was taken ill.

#### Children from this marriage were:

16 M i. **James Warburton** was born on 2 Feb 1804 in Liverpool, Lancashire and died on 27 May 1808 in Liverpool, Lancashire aged 4.

General Notes: The Family Diary: James died aged 4 years & 2 months at Liverpool, Parkland, Old England.

- + 17 M ii. **John Molyneux Warburton** was born on 15 Nov 1805 in Liverpool, Lancashire, died on 9 Sep 1874 in Hillsgrove, Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania aged 68, and was buried in Hillsgrove Cemetery, Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania.
- + 18 M iii. **Jesse Warburton** was born on 21 Mar 1808 in Liverpool, Lancashire, was christened on 27 Jul 1808 in Liverpool, St Nicholas, Lancashire, and died on 27 Mar 1872 in Leroy, Bradford Co., Pennsylvania aged 64.
  - 19 F iv. **Mary Ann Warburton** was born on 14 Apr 1810 in Liverpool, Lancashire and died on 27 Jun 1842 in Johnsons Corners, Medina Co., Ohio aged 32.

General Notes: On 21 May 1835 Mary and her husband moved to Medina County, Ohio.

She died from a very long sickness supposed to be consumption, leaving five small children, and was buried near Johnsons Corners in Medina County, Ohio.

I have been contacted by her great grandson John Richmond who compiled the Richmond family tree.

Mary married James Hile on 9 Jun 1834 in Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania.

General Notes: James was from Montoursville.

- 20 M v. **George Warburton** was born on 7 Apr 1812 in Liverpool, Lancashire and died in 1813 in Liverpool, Lancashire aged 1.
- + 21 M vi. **William Warburton** was born on 7 Sep 1814 in Liverpool, Lancashire, died on 22 Apr 1888 in Agenda, Republic Co., Kansas aged 73, and was buried in Hollis Cemetery, Cloud Co., Kansas.
- + 22 M vii. **Peter Warburton** was born on 7 Dec 1817 in Lycoming Co. (Now Sullivan Co.), Pennsylvania and died on 30 Aug 1856 in Plymouth, Sheboygan Co., Wisconsin aged 38.
  - 23 F viii. **Elizabeth Warburton** was born on 1 Apr 1820 in Lycoming Co. (Now Sullivan Co.), Pennsylvania and died in 1849 aged 29.

General Notes: The Family Diary: Elizabeth, daughter of John & Mary Warburton departed this life 1849.

24 M ix. **Samuel Joseph Warburton** was born on 19 Mar 1823 in Lycoming Co. (Now Sullivan Co.), Pennsylvania and died on 27 Aug 1846 in Lycoming Co. (Now Sullivan Co.), Pennsylvania aged 23.

General Notes: Samuel J. departed this life August 27, 1846, aged 23 years 5 months 8 days.

25 M x. **Joseph Warburton** was born about 1824 in Lycoming Co. (Now Sullivan Co.), Pennsylvania.

General Notes: The Family Diary: Joseph Warburton came in Ohio in the year 18?? September the 27th. (Probably to join his mother who arrived there in December 1836 following John's death).

Nothing more has been found on Joseph.

+ 26 M xi. **George Thomas Warburton** was born on 26 Jan 1826 in Lycoming Co. (Now Sullivan Co.), Pennsylvania and died on 28 Mar 1897 in Clyde, Cloud Co., Kansas aged 71.

- + 27 M xii. **Jabez Warburton** was born about 1830 in Lycoming Co. (Now Sullivan Co.), Pennsylvania and died about 1888 in Plymouth, Sheboygan Co., Wisconsin aged about 58.
  - 28 F xiii. Belle Warburton.
- **15. Peter Warburton** (*Peter*<sup>2</sup>, *George*<sup>1</sup>) was born in 1778 in Rixton-With-Glazebrook, Lancashire, was christened on 17 Apr 1778 in Hollinfare, St Helen, Lancashire, died in 1838 aged 60, and was buried on 29 Dec 1838 in Hollinfare, St Helen, Lancashire.

Peter married **Martha Hatch** on 21 May 1809 in Manchester Cathedral, Lancashire. Martha was born about 1786, died on 1 Feb 1812 in Rixton-With-Glazebrook, Lancashire aged about 26, and was buried on 3 Feb 1812 in Hollinfare, St Helen, Lancashire.

Marriage Notes: Matha is named Hatton on the Settlers site and Hiles on the Richmond family tree. Both are presumed readings of a faint entry in the Family Diary, and Martha Hatch is the closest fit in the parish registers.

General Notes: According to the Family Diary Martha was 26 when she died.

Children from this marriage were:

General Notes: John M. Warburton resided in "Warburton Hollow" which is up Elk Creek from Route 87 near Hillsgrove. Warburton Hollow is near where Elk Creek and Hoagland Branch creek intersect.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1850 in Fox Township, Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania. John (44) is a farmer living with Hannah (40), Charles (19), Angiline (17), James (12), Elizabeth Ann (10), Alfred (8), Cyrus (5), and Walter (3).
- He appeared on the census in 1860 in Fox Township, Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania. John (54) is a farmer living with Hannah (50), Charles's wife Cordelia M (28), Alfred P (18), Martha P (18), Walter E (11), and Austin W (8).
- He appeared on the census in 1870 in Fox Township, Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania. John (65) is a farmer living with Hannah (60), Cyrus (25), Walter (21), Austin (18), and 3 others called Warburton (probably incorrectly as they appear nowhere else).

John married **Hannah Clara Mullan** on 17 Jun 1830 in Elkland, Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania. Hannah was born on 21 Jul 1809 in Elkland, Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania, died on 21 Mar 1897 in Hillsgrove, Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania aged 87, and was buried in Hillsgrove Cemetery, Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania.

Marriage Notes: Sullivan County was called Lycoming County at the time.

General Notes: Hannah was the daughter of Charles Mullan and Elizabeth Hoagland. She died aged 87 years 8 months and 9 days.

Marriage Notes: Angeline and Reuben had a son and a daughter.

General Notes: Rueben was the son of Joseph and Nancy Wilbur.

  - 34 F iv. Elizabeth Ann Warburton was born in Nov 1837 in Shunk, Fox Township, Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania.

Elizabeth married **William W Boyles** on 30 Dec 1858 in Fox Township, Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania. William was born in 1835 in Elkland, Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania, died on 25 May 1898 aged 63, and was buried on 28 May 1898 in Pleasant Slope Cemetery, Estella, Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania.

General Notes: William was the son of John Boyles and Avis King.

  - 36 F vi. **Martha Jane Warburton** was born in Jun 1845 in Shunk, Fox Township, Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania and died on 16 Jul 1910 in San Diego, California aged 65.

Martha married **John P Porter** on 2 Sep 1867 in Bradford Co., Pennsylvania. John was born on 14 Jun 1845 in Fox Township, Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania, died on 26 Oct 1917 in San Diego, California aged 72, and was buried in Los Angeles National Cemetery, California.

General Notes: John was the son of Latney Porter and Sophronia Brown. John served in the Civil War, and in 1869 he and Martha moved to Idaho where John was a prominent early pioneer. They had 7 chidren.

- + 37 M vii. **Cyrus Sadler Warburton** was born in 1845 in Shunk, Fox Township, Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania, died in 1912 aged 67, and was buried in Hillcrest Cemetery, Sonestown, Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania.
- + 38 M viii. **Walter E Warburton** was born on 30 Mar 1849 in Shunk, Fox Township, Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania, died on 27 Aug 1898 in Estella, Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania aged 49, and was buried on 30 Aug 1898 in Hillsgrove Cemetery, Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania.

A Cranmer genealogy says the family moved to LeRoy about 1853.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1850 in Elkland, Sullivan Co., Pennsylvania. Jesse (42) is a farmer living with Elizabeth (42), John (16), Lavinia Ann (10), Samantha Ann (8), and George W S (7 months).
- He appeared on the census in 1860 in Leroy, Bradford Co., Pennsylvania. Jesse Waberton (52) is living with Elizabeth (52), John B (28), Samantha (19), and George W (10).
- He appeared on the census in 1870 in Leroy, Bradford Co., Pennsylvania. Jesse (62) is a farmer living with Elizabeth (62), George W S (20), and a servant. His real estate is valued at \$2,000, and his personal estate at \$825.

Jesse married **Elizabeth Brown**. Elizabeth was born on 2 Feb 1808 in Wilton, Lancashire and died on 9 May 1884 in Leroy, Bradford Co., Pennsylvania aged 76.

Marriage Notes: Lovina and Oscar had a son and two daughters.

George & wife (George Bosworth) visited me in October. Both wanted Father's old Bible, It must be about 500 years old & it is in bad condition, about 1/3 is gone. The leaves are so brittle it can't be handled. It was buried in the earth when the Bibles were being burned in England, and has been in the Warburton Family for hundreds of years, and my father's great-grandfather, also my father's grandfather, & my grandfather of my father said it must stay in the Warburton Family.

Well, Lill has tried many ways to get it. Well, I told them it was to be kept in the Warburton Family & I intended to send it to you. There is another book which gives some of the history of the Warburton Family, written by grandfather (the fine writing) and my own father. Grandfather's name was John, his father's name was Peter, and my father's name George.

I will send these books to you. I believe father prized these books above everything he had & they are only keepsakes. When Harry visited here, I spoke to him about taking the old Bible. He said he thought he had better not take it, and for me to keep it. Pa kinda felt that good luck stayed with the old Bible, and hope it proves so to you. I think God has been very good to me, and caring for me. Of course I am living on a pension, but I still own my own home, but it is getting run down. People are good to me. Tell Dora I got a small ball of rug yarn, but it is not enough, but I am hoping to finish her long delayed rug if I can find another skein of yarn. How are Dora & Edna? The trees have lost most of their leaves. We had a continued dry spell, but now we have had a nice rain & frosts.

Hope to send the books about the first. Write soon to your loving Aunt Belle."
