

First Generation

1. Joseph Warburton.

General Notes: The identification of Ralph Warburton's parents and siblings is from the tree of Peter Wainwright at http://wainwrights.familytreeguide.com/tree_index.php. His source is the Akendefamilytree on Ancestry owned by Jessie Bennett. The source for this information (particularly the precise birth dates of the 2 Josephs) is unknown though limited corroboration has been found.

There is evidence that Thomas is Ralph's brother from the presence of Mary, Thomas's sister-in-law, living with Thomas in 1891. It is possible, but not certain that this Mary is Ralph's widow. Also Thomas's father is identified as Joseph on his marriage certificate in 1856. Joseph is not described as deceased so is presumably alive at this time despite his apparent absence from the 1841 and 1851 censuses.

The only evidence in parish records is the burial of Joseph, infant, on 10 Oct 1824 at Sandbach St. Mary. A Joseph aged 15 his living with Mary 40 at Ettily Heath, Sandbach in the 1841 census.

Joseph married Mary Annie. Mary was christened about 1801.

General Notes: Mary cannot be found after the 1841 census. Only one death of a Mary is recorded at Congleton in the ten years after 1841 and she is not called Mary Annie.

Noted events in her life were:

• She appeared on the census in 1841 in Sandbach, Cheshire. Mary (40) and Joseph (15) are at Ettiley Heath.

Children from this marriage were:

- + 2 M i. **Ralph Warburton** was born about 1817 in Elton, Sandbach, Cheshire, died on 6 Jan 1886 in Newhall, Cheshire aged about 69, and was buried on 9 Jan 1886 in Wrenbury, St Margaret, Cheshire.
 - 3 M ii. **Joseph Warburton** was born on 27 Sep 1824 in Elton, Sandbach, Cheshire, died in 1824, and was buried on 10 Oct 1824 in Sandbach, St Mary, Cheshire.
 - 4 M iii. **Joseph Warburton** was born on 7 Sep 1825 in Elton, Sandbach, Cheshire.

General Notes: Joseph cannot be found in censuses after 1841. The death of a Joseph was registered at Congleton in 2q 1846 ref. 19 67.

+ 5 M iv. **Thomas Warburton** was born about 1826 in Elton, Sandbach, Cheshire, died in 1897 in Newhall, Cheshire aged about 71, and was buried on 2 Feb 1897 in Wrenbury, St Margaret, Cheshire.

Second Generation (Children)

2. Ralph Warburton (*Joseph* ¹) was born about 1817 in Elton, Sandbach, Cheshire, died on 6 Jan 1886 in Newhall, Cheshire aged about 69, and was buried on 9 Jan 1886 in Wrenbury, St Margaret, Cheshire.

General Notes: Death reference C BMD Wrenbury WR/13/033 or 1q 1886 Nantwich 8a 273 aged 69. This gives a date of birth of 1817, though the Wainwright tree says 1821, probably based on his age in later censuses.

Ralph's place of birth is variously given on censuses as Sandbach, Elton, and Aston. The latter is probably an error. Elton is 2 miles west of Sandbach so could be considered part of Sandbach. In 1841 he was living in Warmingham, 2 miles further west, and his eldest 4 children were born there. By 1851 he is living in Newhall, 5 miles SW of Nantwich, although all his children born between the censuses, including 4 month old William are said to be born in Elton. Subsequent children usually give their place of birth as Wrenbury which is just by Newhall. Aston or Aston Heath, which is also referred to, and which is Ralph's actual address on later censuses, lies next to Newhall.

The burial of Mary Warburton of Elton, aged 2 on 3 Oct 1847 at St Leonards, Warmingham suggests Ralph may have had another daughter but her baptism, like Ralph's eldest daughter Jane's, is not at St Leonards.

Ralph's baptism is not recorded at either St Leonards, Warmingham, or St Mary, Sandbach. Also no Warburtons are members of the Sandbach United Reform Church. However it might be a Methodist baptism, but records for the Sandbach Methodist Chapel are not available. Several of Ralph's children's marriages are described on Cheshire BMD as being Nantwich civil marriages, including William's second marriage which is known to have taken place in a Methodist Chapel.

Ralph's will is available from Cheshire Wills Online.

Descendants of Joseph Warburton

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1841 in Warmingham, Cheshire. Ralph (25) is an agricultural labourer living with Mary (20), Jane (5), Joseph (2), and Thomas (3 months).
- He appeared on the census in 1851 in Newhall, Cheshire. Ralph (36) is an agricultural labourer living in Newhall Lane with Mary (34), Thomas (11), John (9), Ralph (3), James (2), and William (4 months).
- He appeared on the census in 1861 in Newhall, Cheshire. Ralph (44) is a farmer of 10 acres living in Aston Heath with Mary (44), Jane (24), Samuel (8), George (5), Joseph (4), Alice (2), and Alfred (1).
- He appeared on the census in 1871 in Newhall, Cheshire. Ralph (50) is a farmer of 15 acres living in Aston Heath with Mary (49), Alice (13), Alfred (11), and Ralph (4 months). Ralph is described as son but is their grandson.
- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Newhall, Cheshire. Ralph (60) is a farmer of 27 acres living in Aston Heath with Mary (60), Alfred (21), and grandson Ralph (10).

Ralph married **Mary Foxley** on 5 Dec 1836 in Warmingham, Cheshire. Mary was born on 3 Mar 1809 in Brindley, Cheshire, was christened on 2 Apr 1809 in Acton, St Mary, Cheshire, and died after 1891.

Marriage Notes: The marriage witnesses were Samuel Foxley and Sarah Foxley. Samuel is possibly her father.

General Notes: Heather Jones has identified Mary as the daughter of Samuel Foxley and Elizabeth Platt born 3 March 1809 and baptised 2 April 1809. However this would mean she was 50 when her last child was born. Her census age is variable and implies a birth between 1816 and 1821. She is probably present in the 1891 census staying with her brother-in-law Thomas. She is missing from the 1901 census. The death of a Mary is registered at Nantwich in 3q 1897 (8a 242) aged 83, giving a birth date of 1813/4. She was buried at Wrenbury, St Margaret on 10 Sept 1897 and was said to be from Sound.

Children from this marriage were:

6 F i. **Jane Warburton** was born about 12 Mar 1837 in Warmingham, Cheshire.

General Notes: Jane's fate is uncertain after her appearance in the 1861 census. She does not appear again under her own name. Nantwich registrations include one death in 1861 but this is before age at death is included in the index so it cannot be checked. No obvious marriages can be found.

7 M ii. **Joseph Warburton** was born on 15 Dec 1839 in Warmingham, Cheshire, was christened on 2 May 1841 in Warmingham, St Leonard, Cheshire, and died in 1846 aged 7.

General Notes: Joseph must have died young as a second Joseph was born in 1856. He is absent from the 1851 census and the most likely death registration is in 2q 1846 at Congleton (19 67).

- + 8 M iii. **Thomas Warburton** was born in 1841 in Warmingham, Cheshire, was christened on 2 May 1841 in Warmingham, St Leonard, Cheshire, and died in 1895 in Bradwall, Cheshire aged 54.
- + 9 M iv. **John Warburton** was born in 1843 in Warmingham, Cheshire, was christened on 26 Mar 1843 in Warmingham, St Leonard, Cheshire, and died after 1901.
- + 10 M v. **Ralph Warburton** was born in 1847 in Elton, Sandbach, Cheshire, was christened on 30 May 1847 in Warmingham, St Leonard, Cheshire, and died in 1870 aged 23.
- + 11 M vi. **James Warburton** was born on 20 Nov 1848 in Elton, Sandbach, Cheshire, was christened on 7 Jan 1849 in Warmingham, St Leonard, Cheshire, and died after 1901.
- + 12 M vii. **William Warburton** was born on 22 Nov 1850 in Elton, Sandbach, Cheshire, was christened on 22 Dec 1850 in Warmingham, St Leonard, Cheshire, and died on 31 Dec 1916 in Chester, Cheshire aged 66.
- + 13 M viii. Samuel Warburton was born on 17 Feb 1853 in Aston By Newhall, Cheshire and died after 1901.
- + 14 M ix. George Warburton was born about 1855 in Aston By Newhall, Cheshire and died after 1901.
- + 15 M x. **Joseph Warburton** was born in 1856 in Aston By Newhall, Cheshire and died in 1927 in Nantwich, Cheshire aged 71.
 - 16 F xi. Alice Warburton was born in 1858 in Aston By Newhall, Cheshire and died after 1901.

General Notes: Alice's birth was registered in 2q 1858 Nantwich 8a 318 (C BMD Wrenbury WR/10/050).

Alice married **William Mottram** in 1877 in Acton, St Mary, Cheshire. William was born about 1857 in Aston By Newhall, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 2q 1877 Nantwich 8a 426. William and Alice's children were Beatrice (b. circa 1876), Edith Alice (b. circa 1878), Ernest William (b. circa 1881), Evelyn A (b. circa 1890), and Clement (b. circa 1891).

17 M xii. **Alfred Warburton** was born on 26 Sep 1859 in Aston By Newhall, Cheshire.

General Notes: Alfred's birth was registered in 4q 1959 Nantwich 8a 302 (C BMD Wrenbury WR/11/005). Alfred cannot be found in a likely marriage, death or census entry after 1881. He was possibly abroad, or was using a different name.

5. Thomas Warburton (*Joseph* ¹) was born about 1826 in Elton, Sandbach, Cheshire, died in 1897 in Newhall, Cheshire aged about 71, and was buried on 2 Feb 1897 in Wrenbury, St Margaret, Cheshire.

General Notes: Thomas's death was registered in 1q 1897 Nantwich 8a 267. His burial records him as from Hollin Green. He was living in Hollin Lane in the 1891 census. His reported age of 71 ties in with his census ages, except for that in 1891 where he is said to be 69, which may account for the date of birth of 1822 given in the Wainwright family tree.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1851 in Moston, Cheshire. Thomas (25) is an agricultural labourer on Moston Green Farm run by John Sutton.
- He appeared on the census in 1861 in Hale, Cheshire. Thomas (35) is an agricultural labourer living with his father-in-law David Hodson at Davenport Green together with Ann (23), Mary (2) and Joseph (1).
- He appeared on the census in 1871 in Hale, Cheshire. Thomas (44) is a widowed labourer living with his father-in-law David Hodson, and children Mary A (13), Joseph (11), John (9), Martha (8) and Elizabeth A (5).
- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Hale, Cheshire. Thomas (55) is a farm labourer living at Davenport Green with John (19) a farm labourer, Martha (17), Thomas Grounds (3) his grandson, and Mary Slack (23) a visitor from Staffordshire.
- He appeared on the census in 1891 in Newhall, Cheshire. Thomas (69) is a widowed farmer living in Hollin Lane with John (30) a farmers son, Emma (34) his daughter-in-law, Mary (69), his widowed sister-in-law, Amy (6), Earnest (2) and Earnest Grounds (10) his grandchildren.

Mary's presence here is the only corroboration of the Wainwright Family Tree's identification of Thomas as Ralph's brother. Mary is about the correct age but her place of birth is incorrect, being given as Audlem, which is close to Newhall. However no Mary from Audlem appears in any other census. Also Ernest Grounds is also said to be born in Audlem which is known to be incorrect, and Thomas does have a son-in-law who was born in Audlem. It is therefore probable the enumerator was given incorrect information.

It may also be significant that Thomas moved from Hale to Newhall in the decade in which his brother died at Newhall. Apart from Ralph and Thomas only one other Warburton who was born in Sandbach in the 1815-30 period appears in the censuses. He was James (b.circa 1822) who was unmarried and described as a pauper in 1891.

Thomas married **Ann Hodson** on 27 May 1856 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. Ann was born about 1837 in Astley, Lancashire and died in 1867 in Hale, Cheshire aged about 30.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 2q 1856 Altrincham 8a 208. The parish record names Thomas's father as James.

General Notes: Ann's death was registered in 3q 1867 Altrincham 8a 105, aged 30.

Children from this marriage were:

18 F i. Mary Alice Warburton was born in 1857 in Hale, Cheshire and died in 1892 aged 35.

General Notes: Mary's birth was registered in 4q 1857 Altrincham 8a 142. Her death was registered in 4q 1892 Warrington 8c 136, age 34.

Mary married **Joseph Grounds** in 1875 in Bowdon, St Mary, Cheshire. Joseph was born about 1856 in Orford, Lancashire.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 4q 1875 Altrincham 8a 271. Joseph and Mary's children were Ann (b. circa 1876), Thomas (b. 1878), Ernest (b. 1880), William (b. circa 1884) and Elizabeth Warburton Grounds (b. cir 1887). The family lived at walton, near Warrington, so Earnest was not born at Audlem as stated in the 1891 census.

General Notes: By the 1901 census Joseph had remarried to Fanny from Stafford.

19 M ii. **Joseph Warburton** was born in 1859 in Hale, Cheshire and died after 1901.

General Notes: Joseph's birth was registered in 2q 1859 Altrincham 8a 175.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Hale Barns, Cheshire. Joseph (21) is a farm servant on the farm of Lucy Hudson (which is next to Buck Hall farm run by George Goodier Warburton).
- He appeared on the census in 1891 in Pendleton, Lancashire. Joseph (30) is a farmer living at The Farm, The Avenue, with Georgina A (28).
- He appeared on the census in 1901 in Stockport, Cheshire. Joseph (40) is a farm bailiff living at 38 Park Road.

Mary Andrew (60) a widow is a visitor from Kendall, Westmoreland. Georgina (39) is staying with her sister-in-law Elizabeth Claydon in Langford, Shropshire (though she is described as Aunt)

Joseph married **Georgina Ann Rogers** in 1884 in Altrincham, St John, Cheshire. Georgina was born about 1862 in Old Trafford, Manchester, Lancashire.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 1q 1884 Altrincham 8a 194.

- + 20 M iii. **John Warburton** was born about 1860 in Hale, Cheshire.
 - 21 F iv. Martha Warburton was born in 1863 in Bowdon, Cheshire and died after 1901.

General Notes: Martha's birth was registered in 3q 1863 Altrincham 8a 148.

Martha married **Tom Malam Whiston** in 1887 in Nantwich (Civil Marriage). Tom was born about 1862 in Audlem, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 2q 1887 Nantwich 8a 511. Their children were Edith A (b. circa 1888), Thomas W (b. circa 1890), and Frank A (b. circa 1895).

22 F v. **Elizabeth Ann Warburton** was born in 1865 in Hale, Cheshire and died after 1901.

General Notes: Elizabeth's birth was registered in 3q 1865 Altrincham 8a 150.

Noted events in her life were:

Elizabeth married **George Claydon** in 1888 in Nantwich (Civil Marriage). George was born about 1861 in Emscote, Warwickshire.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 2q 1888 Nantwich 8a 533. Their children were Lily (b. circa 1889), Thomas (b. circa 1891 and Gertrude A (b. circa 1897).

8. Thomas Warburton (*Ralph*², *Joseph*¹) was born in 1841 in Warmingham, Cheshire, was christened on 2 May 1841 in Warmingham, St Leonard, Cheshire, and died in 1895 in Bradwall, Cheshire aged 54.

General Notes: Thomas's wife Hannah was born very close to where he was working in 1861. The birth places of their children suggest they moved several times before settling in Bradwall. The family is missing from the 1871 census.

His death was registered in 4q 1895 Congleton 8a 235 age 54. His birth registration is not on FreeBMD or Cheshire BMD.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1861 in Didcott Cum Wilkesley, Cheshire. Thomas (18), born in Walsingham (probably a mis-spelling of Warmingham), is a carter on Walkmill Farm, owned by George Boffey.
- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Bradwall, Cheshire. Thomas (37) is a railwy porter born in Elton and living in Station Street with Hannah (34), John (17) a railway porter, Martha (14), Ada (10), Alice (8), Rose Ann (4), Lizzie (2), and Emma (6 months). There is also a boarder, Frederick Fortune (29) an engine fitter from Bristol.
- He appeared on the census in 1891 in Bradwall, Cheshire. Thomas (50) is a [cemical] labourer living in Station Street with Hannah (45), Martha (24) a charwoman, Elizabeth (12) and Thomas (8). All are said to be born in Warmington.

Thomas married **Hannah Williams** in 1863 in Wrenbury, St Margaret, Cheshire. Hannah was born about 1846 in Burleydam, Cheshire and died after 1901.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 3q 1863 Nantwich 8a 368.

Noted events in her life were:

• She appeared on the census in 1901 in Bradwall, Cheshire. Martha H (54), a widow, is living in with Martha (34) a charwoman, Thomas (18) a general labourer, and 5 granchildren, Emma, John, Mabel, and Charles Fortune, and John Barratt.

Children from this marriage were:

- 23 M i. **John Warburton** was born in 1863 in Aston By Newhall, Cheshire and died in 1890 aged 27.
 - General Notes: The births of 2 Johns were registered in Nantwich in 1863 (8a 296 in 3q1863, and 8a 313 in 4q1863). His death was registered 2q 1890 Congleton 8a 196 aged 26.
- 24 F ii. **Martha Warburton** was born in 1866 in Nantwich, Cheshire and died after 1901.

General Notes: Martha's birth was registered 4q1866 Nantwich 8a 281.

25 F iii. Ada Warburton was born in 1870 in Sandbach, Cheshire and died in 1895 in Bradwall, Cheshire aged 25.

General Notes: Ada's birth was registered 2q 1870 Congleton 8a 290, and her death 3q1895 Congleton 8a 221, aged 25.

Ada married Frederick Fortune in 1887. Frederick was born about 1852 in Bristol, Gloucestershire.

Marriage Notes: Ada and Frederick's marriage was registered in 1q 1883 Nantwich 8a 470. They had four children who were living with their grandmother in 1901.

General Notes: Frederick was also described as born in Plymouth, Devon on the 1901 census. He was boarding in Sandbach in 1901.

26 F iv. Mary Alice Warburton was born in 1872 in Elton, Sandbach, Cheshire.

General Notes: Mary Alice 's birth registered in 3q 1872 Congleton 8a 293.

Mary married John Barratt in 1893.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 1q 1893 Congleton 8a 399. John and Mary cannot be found in the 1901 census and their son John is living with his grandparents.

v. Rose Ann Warburton was born in 1876 in Bradwall, Cheshire and died in 1885 in Bradwall, Cheshire aged 9.
 General Notes: Rose Ann's birth was registered in 4q 1876 Congleton 8a 307. Her death was registered in 2q 1885 Congleton 8a 214, aged 8.

28 F vi. **Elizabeth Warburton** was born in 1878 in Bradwall, Cheshire.

General Notes: Elizabeth's birth was registered in 4q 1878 Congleton 8a 307. She cannot be found in the 1901 census. Though there are several Elizabeths of her age from Sandbach there is no matching marriage registration, nor is there a death registration at Congleton.

29 F vii. Emma Warburton was born in 1880 in Bradwall, Cheshire and died in 1885 in Bradwall, Cheshire aged 5.

General Notes: Emma's birth was registered in 4q 1880 Congleton 8a 289. Her death was registered in 1q 1885 Congleton 8a 226, aged 4.

30 M viii. Thomas Frederick Warburton was born in 1883 in Bradwall, Cheshire.

General Notes: Thomas's birth was registered in 1q 1883 Congleton 8a 323.

9. John Warburton (*Ralph* ², *Joseph* ¹) was born in 1843 in Warmingham, Cheshire, was christened on 26 Mar 1843 in Warmingham, St Leonard, Cheshire, and died after 1901.

General Notes: John's birth registration is not on FreeBMD or Cheshire BMD.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1861 in Sound, Nantwich, Cheshire. John (17) is a cowman at Sound Hall farm, run by John Lea. Brother Ralph is also there.
- He appeared on the census in 1871 in Bradwall, Cheshire. John (30) is a plate layer living in New Street with Sarah (35), and Elizabeth (4). plus a boarder, John Twine (15) a railway clerk.
- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Bradwall, Cheshire. John (38) is a labourer in an iron works, living in Foundry Street with Sarah (46) and Mary Eliza (14).
- He appeared on the census in 1891 in Bradwall, Cheshire. John (47) is a general labourer living in Foundary |Street with Sarah (56), and Mary E (24), plus a boarder Lawrence High (23) an elementary schoolmaster from Abbots Langley, Hertfordshire.
- He appeared on the census in 1901 in Elton, Sandbach, Cheshire. John (56) is a farmer living in Booth Lane with Sarah (67) and Mary (34).

John married **Sarah Walker** on 25 Jan 1864 in Elworth, St Peter, Cheshire. Sarah was born about 1833 in Elton, Sandbach, Cheshire and died after 1901.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 1q 1864 Congleton 8a 311 (C BMD Cheshire East 1039/1/113). The witnesses were Clement Bebington and mary Walker.

The child from this marriage was:

31 F i. Mary Elizabeth Warburton was born in 1867 in Bradwall, Cheshire.

General Notes: Mary's birth was registered in 2q1867 Congleton 8a 287. She was still unmarried in 1901.

10. Ralph Warburton (*Ralph* ², *Joseph* ¹) was born in 1847 in Elton, Sandbach, Cheshire, was christened on 30 May 1847 in Warmingham, St Leonard, Cheshire, and died in 1870 aged 23.

General Notes: Ralph's birth was registered in 3q 1847 Congleton 19 74 (C BMD SA/5/52).

Neither Ralph nor Martha can be found in the 1871 or subsequent censuses. The death of a Ralph was registered at Congleton 4q 1870 but the age of 26 is a little high.

Noted events in his life were:

• He appeared on the census in 1861 in Sound, Nantwich, Cheshire. Ralph (13) is a carter's boy at Sound Hall farm, run by John Lea. Brother John is also there.

Ralph married **Martha Goulding** on 29 Dec 1869 in Warmingham, Cheshire. Martha was born on 1 May 1852 in Elton, Sandbach, Cheshire and died on 1 Aug 1877 aged 25.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered is 4q1869 at Nantwich 8a 428. The marriage took place in the School Room. Witnesses were James Warburton and Ann Foster.

General Notes: Martha's death was registered in 3q 1877 at Natwich (8a 193) aged 25.

The child from this marriage was:

- + 32 M i. **Ralph Warburton** was born on 26 Nov 1870 in Aston By Newhall, Cheshire.
- **11. James Warburton** (*Ralph* ², *Joseph* ¹) was born on 20 Nov 1848 in Elton, Sandbach, Cheshire, was christened on 7 Jan 1849 in Warmingham, St Leonard, Cheshire, and died after 1901.

General Notes: James's birth was registered in 4q 1848 Congleton 1972.

James, owned an agricultural threshing machine powered by steam ("one of the first", and son Arthur "put the roof on it"). James used to hire himself and the machine out and farmers used to call the binder twine "Warbystring". James was at one time in partnership with the Mr. Foden of the famous firm. They "fell out over money" at "The Paris Exhibition" (Daphne Warburton).

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Bradwall, Cheshire. James (32) is an engine driver living in Station Street with Ann (30), Joseph (7), James (6), Alfred (4), and George (1).
- He appeared on the census in 1891 in Elton, Sandbach, Cheshire. Jas (43) is a steam (something unreadable) living in (unreadable) Heath with Ann (40), Jos (17), Jas (16), Alf (14), Geo (11), Mary (9), Arthur (6), Florence (5), and Ger (trude) A(nnie) (5 months).
- He appeared on the census in 1901 in Congleton, Cheshire. James (52) is a threshing machine proprietor living at Hackney's Lake with Annie (50), Joseph (16), Florence (15), and Gertrude (10). Note Joseph should be Arthur, as a good candidate for Joseph can be found elsewhere, and the age is correct for Arthur.

James married **Anne Bromfield** on 1 Jul 1873 in Nantwich, Cheshire, daughter of **Joseph Bromfield** and **Sarah Barnett**. Anne was born in 1850 in Weston, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 3q 1873 Nantwich 8a 505. It took place in the Registry Office.

General Notes: Ann was the daughter of Joseph Bromfield and Sarah Barnett.

Children from this marriage were:

33 M i. **Joseph Oswald Warburton** was born in 1873 in Weston, Cheshire and died after 1923.

General Notes: Joseph's birth was registered in 4q 1873 Nantwich 8a323. Joseph was a non-conformist Minister, and known to the family as "Preacher Joe". His maternal grandfather was a lay Preacher in Weston, Cheshire. He was the informant on brother Arthur's death registration.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1901 in Norton, Durham. A Joseph Oswald (27) of Weston is a visiting Wesleyan minister staying with the Porth family.
- + 34 M ii. **James Warburton** was born in 1875 in Shavington, Cheshire and died after 1901.
 - 35 M iii. **Alfred Warburton** was born in 1877 in Elworth, Cheshire and died after 1901.

General Notes: Alfred's birth was registered in 1q 1877 Congleton 8a 334.

Noted events in his life were:

• He appeared on the census in 1901 in Congleton, Cheshire. Alfred (24) is a threshing machine builder living at 13 West Road with Ada (24).

Alfred married Ada Pass in 1898. Ada was born about 1877 in Elworth, Cheshire and died after 1901.

Marriage Notes: Ada's birth place is matched by that of Ada Pass in the 1881 and 1891 censuses. However the only marriage to an Ada Pass is registered in 4q 1898 in Nuneaton 6d 949.

36 M iv. **George Warburton** was born in 1879 in Elworth, Cheshire and died after 1901.

General Notes: George's birth was registered in 4q 1879 Congleton 8a 311.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1901 in Congleton, Cheshire. George (21) is a school teacher visiting the Porter family in Padgbury Lane.
- 37 F v. **Mary Warburton** was born in 1881 in Elworth, Cheshire and died after 1901.

General Notes: Marys's birth was probably registered in 3q 1881 Congleton 8a 314 (there is another in 1880 which matches her age on the 1901 census).

Noted events in her life were:

- She appeared on the census in 1901 in St Pancras, Middlesex. Mary (20) is an assistant milliner at Rees Pugh's drapers shop at 127 High Street.
- + 38 M vi. **Arthur Warburton** was born on 18 May 1884 in Marsh Green, Bradwall, Cheshire and died on 16 Jul 1923 in Penmenmawr, North Wales aged 39.
 - 39 F vii. **Florence Warburton** was born in 1886 in Bradwall, Cheshire.

General Notes: Florence's birth was registered in 2q 1886 Congleton 8a 319.

40 F viii. **Gertrude Annie Warburton** was born on 30 Oct 1890 in Bradwall, Cheshire and died in 1975 in Cheshire aged 85.

General Notes: Gertrude's birth was registered in 4q 1890 Congleton 8a 289.

12. William Warburton (*Ralph* ², *Joseph* ¹) was born on 22 Nov 1850 in Elton, Sandbach, Cheshire, was christened on 22 Dec 1850 in Warmingham, St Leonard, Cheshire, and died on 31 Dec 1916 in Chester, Cheshire aged 66.

General Notes: William's birth was registered in 4q 1850 Congleton 19 88 (C BMD Sandbach SA/7/75).

Information from Heather Jones, William's great granddaughter via Wraybourne Wilby:

His grave stone reads: William Warburton Sgt Cheshire Constabulary. Husband of Emily Warburton died Dec 31st 1916 age 66. Also Clifton Wallace son of the above died Feb 22 1929 age 17. Also Esther Hilda beloved wife of Wraybourne Willby Warburton died 28 Sept 1931 age 25. Also Kathleen Mary daughter of the above Nov 21 1931 age 5 months. Also Emily wife of William died 21 April 1949 aged 79. Wraybourne Willby Warburton died Feb 16 1937 age 30. Esther loved by mam, Dad and Sisters (May & Emma).

William was a sergeant of police. Before becoming a policeman he was a tailor, and he returned to it after his discharge.

In the Police Records of 4th September 1875: Born Warmington Cheshire Height 5' 8" Age 26 Eyes Hazel, brown hair, complex: Fresh No finger nail on left hand 3rd finger.

His postings included: September 1875 Reserve November 1875 Nantwich January 1879 Broxton September 1880 Reserve July 25th 1892 Hon Sergt.

Other comments from his record: June 1881 long and faithfully service. 1 good conduct Badge Merit Badge and pay of £3 per annum.

4th October 1876. Neglecting to fill up his journel from 22nd to 31st ultimo. Fined 5s and cautioned.

7th October 1898. Disobeying the orders of Serg Leah in charging Henry McDermott with assaulting him (the Serg) in the execution of his duty at Chester Railyway Station on 6th October 1898. Fined 10s. Neglecting to make out report of the apprehension of the above on Form No 18.

Discharged on a pension of £64 17s 9d per anuum from 31st October 1901.

During his marriage to Emma he had an affair with Emily Smith who bore him several children before Emma died and he was able to marry her. They then had a further four children

William is missing from the 1861 and 1901 censuses.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1871 in Sandbach, Cheshire. William (23) is a tailor living in Union Street with Emma (27).
- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Hoole, Cheshire. William (30) is a sergeant of police living at 11 Thompkinson St. with Emma (36).
- He appeared on the census in 1891 in Hoole, Cheshire. William (40) is a Police Sergeant living in Hamilton Street with Emma (45).

William married **Emma Parkes** on 23 Jun 1870 in Sandbach, Cheshire. Emma was born about 1845 in Sandbach, Cheshire and died in 1905 aged about 60.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 2q 1870 Congleton 8a 400.

General Notes: Emma was the daughter Walter and Ann Parkes.

It is most likely Emma died after the birth of Lionel Wellesley Smith, the last of William's children by Emily Smith, and before he married her in 3q 1905. The registration of the death of Emma aged 60 is indexed in both the second and third quarters of 1905 at Nantwich, references 8a 216 and 217 (probably repeated in error).

William next married **Emily Smith** on 13 Sep 1905 in Nantwich Primitive Methodist Chapel, Cheshire. Emily was born on 28 Jul 1870 in Sound, Nantwich, Cheshire and died on 21 Apr 1949 in Chester, Cheshire aged 78.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 3q 1905 Natwich 8a 746.

General Notes: Emily's birth was registered in 2q 1869 Nantwich 8a 332. This makes her 13 when Charles was born. There was then a 7 year gap to her next child so it is possible the affair with William began after Charles was born.

Emily was the daughter of Thomas Smith and Elizabeth Sharpes.

Noted events in her life were:

- She appeared on the census in 1871 in Sound, Nantwich, Cheshire. Emily is just 8 months old and living with her parents Thomas and Elizabeth in Newtown.
- She appeared on the census in 1881 in Newhall, Cheshire. Alice (10) is living with her family in Hollin Lane.
- She appeared on the census in 1891 in Aston By Newhall, Cheshire. Emily is absent from home (and cannot be found in the census, but her children Charles (7), and Jessie (11 months) are living in Aston Heath (near George and Elizabeth Warburton, William's brother and sister-in-law) with her parents Thomas and Elizabeth. Also present is Agnes E (2) the illegitimate daughter of Emily's sister Sarah who later married George Burrows and is living with him in 1901.
- She appeared on the census in 1901 in Newhall, Cheshire. Emily (31) is a charwoman living in Aston Heath (next door to George and Elizabeth Warburton, William's brother and sister-in-law) with her parents Thomas (73) and Elizabeth (70), and children Jessie (10), Alice (8), and Stanley (2).

Children from this marriage were:

41 M i. Charles Smith was born in 1883 in Aston By Newhall, Cheshire.

General Notes: Charles's birth was registered in 4q 1883 Nantwich 8a 341. His mother Emily would be just 13 years old.

42 F ii. **Jessie Smith** was born in 1890 in Aston By Newhall, Cheshire.

General Notes: Two Jessie's were registered at Nantwich, in 2q 1890 ref. 8a 387, and in 3q 1890 ref. 8a 373. Jessie married **Jack Elliot**.

43 F iii. Alice Smith was born in 1893 in Aston By Newhall, Cheshire and died in Hoole, Cheshire.

General Notes: Alice's birth was registered in 2q 1893 Nantwich 8a 412.

Alice married Albert Payne on 7 Apr 1917 in Chester Registry Office. Albert was born in 1886 in Chester,

Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: Albert and Alice had 3 sons and a daughter.

44 M iv. **Stanley Smith** was born on 13 Aug 1898 in Bickley, Cheshire, was christened in Bunbury, Cheshire, and died in 1983 aged 85.

General Notes: Stanley's birth was registered in 4q 1898 Nantwich 8a 359. He was living in Ivy Cottage, Sadlers Wells, Bunbury at the time of his death.

Stanley married **Mabel Woolley** on 3 May 1921 in Chester Registry Office. Mabel was born on 27 May 1898 in Fullers Moor, Broxton, Cheshire and died on 1 Jul 1970 in Bunbury, Cheshire aged 72.

Marriage Notes: Stanley and Mabel had 6 daughters, Freda, Nora, Edna, Joan, Nesta and Brenda who all took the name Smith, except Nora where Stanley entered his name as Warburton on her birth certificate.

- + 45 M v. **Lionel Wellesley Smith** was born on 28 Nov 1904 in Wrenbury, Cheshire and died on 19 Oct 1967 in Hale Barns, Cheshire aged 62.
- + 46 M vi. **Wraybourne Wilby Warburton** was born on 24 Feb 1906 in 13 St Anne Street, Chester, Chestire, died on 16 Feb 1936 in 15 St Anne Street, Chester aged 29, and was buried in New Cemetary, Overleigh Road, Chester.

General Notes: Samuel's birth was registered in 1853 and can be found on Cheshire BMD (C BMD Wrenbury WR/08/048) but not FreeBMD.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1871 in Broomhall, Cheshire. Samuel (19) is a farm servant at Heatley, the farm of John Robinson.
- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Barthomley, Cheshire. Samuel (28) is a labourer living at Mill Gate with Hannah (34) and Charles Warham (15 mths) who is described as a boarder.
- He appeared on the census in 1891 in Barthomley, Cheshire. Samuel (37) is an agricultural labourer living at Mill Gate with Hannah (43) and Henry (10).
- He appeared on the census in 1901 in Barthomley, Cheshire. Samuel (47) is a farm labourer living at Mill Gate with Hannah (55), Charles Warham (21) a boarder, and Frederick Warburton (3) a nephew. No birth registration can be found for Frederick on FreeBMD near to his place of birth which is Audley, Staffordshire. Since Hannah is from Staffordshire he might be a nephew on her side who was given the wrong name.

Samuel married **Hannah Copestake** in 1875. Hannah was born about 1846 in Fenton, Stoke-On-Trent, Staffordshire.

50 M i. **Henry Warburton** was born about 1880 in Audley, Staffordshire.

General Notes: Henry's birth registration is not obvious on FreeBMD. He is also missing from the 1901 census though there is no death record for a Henry of the correct age.

51 M ii. Fred Warburton was born about 1897 in Old Colwyn, North Wales.

General Notes: Frederick was the son of William Warren and Mary Elizabeth Coates but was adopted by Samuel and Hannah.

14. George Warburton (*Ralph* ², *Joseph* ¹) was born about 1855 in Aston By Newhall, Cheshire and died after 1901.

General Notes: George's birth is not registered at Nantwich according to FreeBMD.

Noted events in his life were:

• He appeared on the census in 1871 in Broomhall, Cheshire. George (17) is a farm servant at Oak farm, run by George Wright. Brother Joseph is also present.

- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Sound, Nantwich, Cheshire. George (26) is an agricultural labourer living at Sandfords Bridge with Elizabeth (25), George (4), and Mary A (3).
- He appeared on the census in 1891 in Aston By Newhall, Cheshire. George (36) is a farmer living at Aston Heath with Elizabeth (35), George (14) a farmer's assistant, Mary A (13), William (8) and Elizabeth (4).
- He appeared on the census in 1901 in Aston By Newhall, Cheshire. George (46) is a farmer living at Aston Heath with Elizabeth (45), Mary A (23), William (18) a farmer's son, Elizabeth (14), and Enoch Elijah (7).

George married **Elizabeth Hughes** in 1876 in Nantwich (Civil Marriage). Elizabeth was born about 1855 in Sound, Nantwich, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: The marriage was registered in 1q 1876 Nantwich 8a 451.

Children from this marriage were:

52 M i. **George Hughes Warburton** was born in 1877 in Sound, Nantwich, Cheshire.

General Notes: George's birth was registered 1q 1877 Nantwich 8a 398. He cannot be identified certainly in the 1901 census, but there is no matching death registration on FreeBDM. There is a George H of the right age living in Yorkshire but his place of birth is wrong.

53 F ii. Mary Alice Warburton was born in 1878 in Sound, Nantwich, Cheshire.

General Notes: Mary's birth was registered 1q 1878 Nantwich 8a 383.

Mary married Thomas Chesters in 1909.

Marriage Notes: Mary and Thomas had 3 sons and 2 daughters.

54 M iii. William Warburton was born in 1883 in Sound, Nantwich, Cheshire.

General Notes: William's birth was registered in 2q 1883 Nantwich 8a 399.

55 F iv. **Elizabeth Warburton** was born in 1886 in Aston By Newhall, Cheshire.

General Notes: Elizabeth's birth was registered in 3q 1886 Nantwich 8a 392.

+ 56 M v. Enoch Elijah Warburton was born on 30 Jun 1893 in Aston By Newhall, Cheshire and died in 1959 aged 66.

15. Joseph Warburton (*Ralph* ², *Joseph* ¹) was born in 1856 in Aston By Newhall, Cheshire and died in 1927 in Nantwich, Cheshire aged 71.
