### **First Generation**

1. Peter Warburton was born poss 1746, was christened on 26 Feb 1746 in Mobberley, St Wilfred, Cheshire, and died in Hough, Wilmslow, Cheshire.

General Notes: Peter is probably the son of Peter Warburton and Ann Astle who were married at Mobberley St Wilfred on 1 Dec 1744. Peter is described as 'of Morley', and Alice 'of Dean Row'. Their son was baptised on 26 Feb 1746 in the same church but his father is described as 'of Fulshers (Fulshaw) Hall in the parish of Wilmslow'. Two further sons were baptised at Wilmslow, Thomas on 14 May 1748, and John on 22 March 1749.

The origins of Peter snr. are unclear. He does not belong to the established Mobberley families, where Peters occur but are accounted for. There are several Peters baptised at Rostherne, one in 1745, son of Thomas and Martha, who is another candidate for Peter jun., one in 1723, son of Peter and Hannah, and others in 1706, 1702, 1696 (Wilmslow), 1681, 1677, and 1640 (Wilmslow). Since names frequently run in families, and Peter was relatively uncommon at this time this run of Peters probably indicates a single extended family.

It is interesting that after the first daughter was baptised in Manchester the others were baptised at Dean Row Unitarian Chapel whilst the sons were baptised at Wilmslow Parish Church.

The death of a Peter was recorded at Wilmslow on the 28 July 1793. No age is given, but no other Peters of a suitable age are recorded in the next 50 years (Family Online which covers Wilmslow). The location of his death at Hough is uncertain.

Peter married **Catherine Holt** on 21 Mar 1769 in Wilmslow St Bartholomew, Cheshire. Catherine was born circa 1741 and was buried on 25 Aug 1826 in Wilmslow St Bartholomew, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: Wilmslow Parish Register: Peter Warburton and Catherine Holt by banns. Witnesses: John Holt and Thomas Antrobus.

General Notes: IGI doesn't show a Catherine Holt born around Wilmslow, so she may have come from further afield. Two Catherines were buried at Wilmslow St Bartholomew. However the Catherine Warburton buried 12 Jan 1834 aged 85 fits with Katherine Hooley baptised 4 July 1749 at Mobberley, wife of William Warburton. Therefore the Catherine Warburton buried 25 Aug 1826 aged 85 may be her.

  - General Notes: It is unusual she was christened in Manchester, but her parent's names are fairly rare and the dates fit. An Elizabeth married William Stubbs at Wilmslow on Oct 20th or 22nd (IGI has entries for both dates).
- 3 M ii. **James Warburton** was born in 1774 and was christened on 2 Oct 1774 in Wilmslow St Bartholomew, Cheshire.
- 4 F iii. **Mary Warburton** was born on 24 Feb 1777 and was christened on 8 Apr 1777 in Unitarian Chapel, Dean Row, Cheshire.
- + 5 F iv. **Alice Warburton** was born on 20 Feb 1779 in Hough, Wilmslow, Cheshire, was christened on 23 Apr 1780 in Unitarian Chapel, Dean Row, Cheshire, England, died on 27 May 1829 aged 50, and was buried on 31 May 1829 in Wilmslow, St. Bartholomew, Cheshire.
  - 6 M v. John Warburton was born in 1784 in Wilmslow, Cheshire, England, was christened on 18 Apr 1784 in Wilmslow St Bartholomew, Cheshire, died on 8 Oct 1867 in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire aged 83, and was buried on 13 Oct 1867 in Wilmslow St Bartholomew, Cheshire.
    - General Notes: Death certificate says John Warburton of Macclesfield aged 90, occupation Farm labourer, residing on St.Georges Street, Sutton, at time of death. Informant John Warburton, of St. Georges Street. Died of Senile decay, asthenia certified. His age would appear to be exaggerated as he was about 83 years old.
  - 7 M vi. **Thomas Warburton** was born in 1788 and was christened on 5 Oct 1788 in Wilmslow St Bartholomew, Cheshire.

### **Second Generation (Children)**

**5. Alice Warburton** (*Peter* <sup>1</sup>) was born on 20 Feb 1779 in Hough, Wilmslow, Cheshire, was christened on 23 Apr 1780 in Unitarian Chapel, Dean Row, Cheshire, England, died on 27 May 1829 aged 50, and was buried on 31 May 1829 in Wilmslow, St. Bartholomew, Cheshire.

General Notes: The Wilmslow Parish Register of burials states: Alice Warburton of Hough, aged 45yrs.

Noted events in her life were:

• She signed a will on 16 Nov 1828. Her Will states that she died 27 May 1829, leaving an estate of under £200 to her"illegitimate" son John Warburton. Executors of her will were: John Grimshaw, and Joseph Stanfield Grimshaw of Audenshaw, Gentlemen. Audenshaw is near Ashton-under-Lyne, Lancashire, now part of Greater Manchester. Witnesses were Isaac Goodier and Eli ?(can't decipher). Probate was granted on 2 Jul 1829, stating her personal Estate was within the Diocese of Chester.

Alice had a child.

## **Third Generation (Grandchildren)**

**8. John Charles Warburton** (*Alice Warburton* <sup>2</sup>, *Peter* <sup>1</sup>) was born on 16 Jun 1808 in Wilmslow, Cheshire, England, was christened on 24 Jun 1808 in Dean Row Unitarian Chapel, Wilmslow, Cheshire, and died on 9 Jan 1878 in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire aged 69.

General Notes: 1878 Death Register for John Warburton: Died 9 January 1878, aged 69, silk weaver residing at 1 St Georges Place, of chronic bronchitis lasting 3 years. Informant Ann Brownridge daughter of 1 St Georges Place, Sutton.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1841 in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire. John (32) is a silk weaver living in St Georges Street with Mary (36) also a silk weaver, Ann (7), Alice (5), Henry (4), Maria (3), and Elizabeth (1). Also present are John Warburton (55), probably an Uncle, and Mary Albison (68), probably mother-in-law.
- He appeared on the census in 1851 in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire. John (43) a silk weaver is living at 28 St Georges Street, with Mary (38), Ann (17), Alice (16), and Henry (16), all silk weavers, plus Maria (14), Elizabeth (11), Emma (9) and Harriet (7), all silk winders, and John (5), Maria (3), Emma (Hannah?) (1), and Thomas (? months). Also present is uncle John Warburton (75).
- He appeared on the census in 1861 in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire. John (52) a silk weaver is living at 15 St. Georges Street, with Mary (48) housekeeper, Henry (24), and Maria (22), silk weavers, Elizabeth (21), Emma (19) and Harriet (17), silk winders, John (15) shoemaker, Mary (13), Hannah (11), and Thomas (10) silk winders, James (7) scholar, and uncle John Warburton (83) charman.
- He appeared on the census in 1871 in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire. John (62) a widower and silk weaver is living at 15 St. Georges Street, with Maria (32), and John (25) also a widower, silk weavers, Mary (23), and Hannah Jane (11) silk workers, and James (17) silk weaver.

John married **Mary Albinson** on 22 Jul 1832 in Manchester Cathedral, daughter of **Joseph Albinson** and **Mary Bore**. Mary was born about 1812 in Wilmslow, Cheshire, England and died between 1861 and 1871.

Marriage Notes: Manchester Cathedral Marriage Entry: 22 July 1832 John Warburton, Bachelor, Silk Weaver, and Mary Albinson, Spinster, both of this parish, by Banns, both signed with an X.Witnesses: Thomas Parry and Joseph Adshead.

Children from this marriage were:

9 F i. **Anne Warburton** was born in 1834 in Macclesfield, Cheshire.

General Notes: Daughter Anne Brownridge is listed as informant for death of father JohnWarburton.

Anne married **William Brownridge** on 16 May 1852 in Prestbury, St. Peter, Cheshire, son of **Robert Brownridge** and **Maria Worrall**. William was born about 1831 in Macclesfield, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: Marriage Registration: William Brownridge 21, bachelor, mechanic of Sutton. Father: Robert Brownridge mechanic. Ann Warburton 18, spinster of Sutton, father: John Warburton, weaver. Witnesses: John Warburton and Alice Warburton.

Noted events in his life were:

• He appeared on the census in 1881 in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire. William (49) is an engine fitter living at 1 St.Georges Place with Ann (47), Mary M (23) called Brownridge but described as married, and Alica A (18) silk weavers, Albert E (16), and Emma (14) silk piecers, Hannah J (12), Elizabeth (10), George (6), Chalotte (6), and John J Holden (9 months) grandson. John is presumably Mary's son. Alice and Albert were born in Lambeth, Surry. Emma, Hannah and Elizabeth were born in Yeovil, Somerset. George,

Charlotte, and John were born in Macclesfield.

- He appeared on the census in 1891. William (59) is an engine fitter living at 1 St.Georges Place with Ann (56), plus Mary Holden (34) daughter, Emma (24), and Hannah (22) silk weavers, Albert E (26) locomotive stoker, Chalotte (17) cloth picker cotton, and John Thomas Holden (10) grandson.
- 10 F ii. Alice Warburton was born in 1835 in Macclesfield, Cheshire.

General Notes: Alice was a witness at her sister Ann's wedding in 1852, but Alice was not found with her parents in the 1861 Census. However Alice Davenport (25) born in Sutton, a silk weaver is living with her husband Charles (27) a brewery carter in Barton Street Maccesfield.

Alice married **Charles Davenport** in 1859 in Prestbury, St. Peter, Cheshire. Charles was born circa 1833 in Longmoss, Cheshire.

General Notes: Location of Longmoss is uncertain. Other censuses may be more specific.

- + 11 M iii. **Henry Warburton** was born in 1836 in Macclesfield, Cheshire, died on 4 Feb 1895 in Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey aged 59, and was buried on 6 Feb 1895 in Cedar Lawn Cemetery, Paterson, New Jersey.
  - 12 F iv. Maria Warburton was born on 6 Sep 1838 in Macclesfield, Cheshire and died after 1891.

General Notes: There is a discrepancy in Maria's age. When living with her father she was born in 1834. When living with husband she was born in 1839.

Maria married **James Parkinson** on 18 Aug 1877 in St. James Church, Macclesfield, Cheshire, England, son of **Edward Parkinson** and **Unknown**. James was born in 1832 in Pendelton, Lancashire and died after 1891.

Marriage Notes: Marriage Record: James Parkinson, full age, bachelor, joiner, resident in St Paul (Parish) Paddington-in-Pendleton, Salford, Lancashire, father Edward Parkinson, dyer. Maria Warburton, full age, spinster, resident in St James (Parish), Sutton, father John Warburton, silk weaver. Witnesses: Thomas White (bride's brother-in-law), and Hannah Jane Warburton (bride's sister).

Maria and James's children were Arthur (b. 1861), Herbert (b. 1864), Alfred (b. 1869), Ruth (b. 1872), and Frank (b. 1879).

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Pendleton in Salford, Lancashire. James Parkinson (49) is a carpenter/joiner living at 14 Pimbletts Place with Maria (42) of Macclesfield, Arthur (20) plumber/glazer, Herbert (17) printer compositor, Alfred (12), Ruth (9), and Frank (2).
- He appeared on the census in 1891 in Pendleton in Salford, Lancashire. James Parkinson (59) is a carpenter/joiner living at 14 Pimbletts Place with Maria (52) of Macclesfield, and Frank (12).
- 13 F v. Elizabeth Warburton was born on 9 Apr 1840 in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire.

General Notes: Birth Certificate: Elizabeth Warburton, born Sutton, parents John Warburton, weaver, St. Georges Street, Sutton, and Mary Warburton formerly Albinson.

Elizabeth married **George Bradburne** on 25 Sep 1862 in Prestbury, St. Peter, Cheshire, son of **James Bradburne** and **Maria**. George was born in 1837.

Marriage Notes: Prestbury, St. Peters, parish register: George Bradburne (25), bachelor, schoolmaster of Sutton, father James Bradburne, dyer. Elizabeth Warburton (22), spinster of Sutton, father James Warburton, weaver. Witnesses: John Warburton, and Maria Warburton.

George and Elizabeth's children were Elizabeth Ann (b. 1867), Alice Emma (b. 1870), George H (b. 1876), and Ethel J (b. 1879).

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1881 in South Kyme, Lincoln. George Bradburn (44) of Macclesfield is a schoolmaster living with Elizabeth (41) schoolmistress of Macclesfield, Elizabeth A (14), and Alice E (11), born Croxton Herrial, Leicester, George H (5) born Hough (on Hill), Lincoln, and Ethel J (2) born S. Kyme, Lincoln.
- 14 F vi. **Emma Warburton** was born in 1842 in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire.

Emma married **Charles Oldham** on 11 Jun 1865 in Prestbury, St. Peter, Cheshire. Charles was born in 1842 in Macclesfield. Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: Marriage record at Prestbury St Peters: Charles Oldham (23) bachelor, warehouseman of Macclesfield, father William Oldham, silk steward. Emma Warburton (23), spinster of Sutton, father John

Warburton, weaver. Witnesses: John Warburton and Sarah Ann Oldham.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Pendleton in Salford, Lancashire. Charles Oldham (31), born Macclesfield, is a warehouseman living at 14 Albion Place, with Emma (39) also born in Macclesfield, and two boarders, Martha Hall and Mary Hall.
- 15 F vii. **Harriet Warburton** was born in 1844 in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire.

Harriet married **Thomas White** on 14 Sep 1862 in Prestbury, St. Peter, Cheshire, son of **Edward White** and **Unknown**. Thomas was born in 1840 in Macclesfield, Cheshire.

Marriage Notes: Marriage Record at Prestbury St Peter: Thomas White 22, bachelor, Staffman residing in Macclesfield, father Edward White, maker-up. Harriet Warburton 18, spinster residing in Sutton, father John Warburton weaver. By Banns by Stephen Lea Wilson. Witnesses: John Warburton and Emma Warburton.

Harriet and Thomas's children were May (b. 1870), and Frank (b. 1872).

General Notes: Listed as a witness at the wedding of his brother-in-law James Warburton to Emma Clayton.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1881 in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire. Thomas (41) born Macclesfield, is a silk maker up living at 80 Peel Street with Harriet (37) silk weaver, May (11), and Frank (9).
- + 16 M viii. **John Warburton** was born on 5 Feb 1846 in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire.
  - 17 F ix. Mary Warburton was born in 1849 in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire.

General Notes: Still living with father in 1871, but not living with brother in 1881 at same address. Probably married between 1871-1881, Cheshire BMD shows 3 Marys marrying at Sutton or Macclesfield in that time.

18 F x. **Hannah Jane Warburton** was born in 1851 in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire.

General Notes: 1880 Census of Paterson New Jersey: Hannah Jane Warburton is enumerated with her brother Henry Warburton and family. It is not known if she was just visiting, got married, etc.

- + 19 M xi. **Thomas Warburton** was born in 1851 in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire.
- + 20 M xii. **James John Warburton** was born on 21 May 1853 in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire, died on 31 Dec 1920 in Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey aged 67, and was buried on 3 Jan 1921 in Cedar Lawn Cemetery, Paterson, New Jersey.

Henry Warburton** (*John Charles Warburton*<sup>3</sup>, *Alice Warburton*<sup>2</sup>, *Peter*<sup>1</sup>) was born in 1836 in Macclesfield, Cheshire, died on 4 Feb 1895 in Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey aged 59, and was buried on 6 Feb 1895 in Cedar Lawn Cemetery, Paterson, New Jersey.

General Notes: In Paterson, New Jersey Henry and family lived at 12 Seeley Street. Brother James lived at 14 Seeley. Henry was still at 12 Seeley in 1885 when Thomas Goodwin Warburton married, but he was at 14 Seeley at the time of his death. He died of Asthmatic Chronic bronchitis.

Noted events in his life were:

- He appeared on the census in 1870 in Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey. Henry Warburton (33), a tape weaver is living with Ann (25) who keeps home, Thomas G (6), and John W (4). Also present is William Goodwin (59). All were born in England except John W who was born in New Jersey.
- 1879 Paterson Directory: Henry Warburton, foreman, 436 Market Street.
- He appeared on the census in 1880 in Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey. Henry (43) works in a silk mill, and lives at 12 Seeley Street with Ann (45) who keeps house, Thomas (17), and John W (14) also at silk mill, and Charles (10) at school. Also present are Hannah J Warburton (29) sister, and William Goodwin (70) father-in-law.
- He signed a will in Jul 1894. Henry gave everything to his wife Ann. After her death everything would go to his three sons Thomas Warburton, John William Warburton, and Charles Henry Warburton. Witnesses: Sidney Farrar of 26 West Street, Paterson, and Maria Barlow of 14 Seeley Street, Paterson.

Henry married **Anna Whittaker Goodwin** on 16 Nov 1862 in Prestbury, St. Peter, Cheshire, daughter of **William Goodwin** and **Unknown**. Anna was born in Sep 1833 in Cheshire, died on 12 Jun 1915 in Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey aged 81, and was buried on 14 Jun 1915 in Cedar Lawn Cemetery, Paterson, New Jersey.

Marriage Notes: Marriage Record: Henry Warburton 26, bachelor, weaver, residing at Sutton, father John Warburton,

He was single, and aged about 68.

weaver. Ann Whittaker Goodwin 28, spinster, residing in Sutton, father William Goodwin, silk manager. By Banns by Stephen Lea Wilson. Witnesses: Henry Pickston and Mary Rockliffe.

Noted events in her life were:

• She appeared on the census in 1900 in Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey. Ann (66) is a widow born in England in April 1833, living at 12 Seeley Street with her son Charles (27) a silk weaver born in New Jersey in November 1878. Ann is described as the landlord.

At the same address is Samuel Hough of England. Apparently Samuel was widowed while living there in 1891. Another researcher (of the Hough line) says that he saw the house and that one family lived downstairs (Samuel Hough) while the Warburtons lived upstairs.

- + 21 M i. **Thomas Goodwin Warburton** was born in Jul 1863 in North Adams, Massachusetts or England and died on 27 Jun 1957 in Burlington, New Jersey aged 93.

General Notes: Frederick Warburton died in 1874. Buried with Ralph Hunt, and Thomas Berry. Owner of the Lot was Jane Hunt who married Joseph Bentley. Later, after his death, others were buried there. In September 1883 he was moved to newly purchased Cemetery lot owned by Henry and Ann Warburton.

According to New Jersey State Archives, there is no record of Frederick's birth.

**16.** John Warburton (John Charles Warburton<sup>3</sup>, Alice Warburton<sup>2</sup>, Peter<sup>1</sup>) was born on 5 Feb 1846 in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire.

General Notes: Birth Registration: Boy John Warburton, father John Warburton, weaver of St. George's Street, Sutton, mother Mary Warburton formerly Albinson. Registered 25th Feb 1846.

I cannot find the death of John but it is possible that he moved to the USA, maybe Massachusetts.

Noted events in his life were:

• He appeared on the census in 1871 in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire. John a widower, is living with father at 15 St. Georges Street.

John married **Mary Ann Holt** on 5 Jan 1868 in Prestbury, St. Peter, Cheshire, daughter of **John Holt** and **Rachel Walmsley**. Mary was born in 1845 in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire and died before 1871.

Marriage Notes: Marriage register: John Warburton 21, bachelor, weaver of Sutton, father John Warburton, weaver. Mary Ann Holt 20, spinster of Sutton, father John Holt. Witnesses: Thomas Holt and Maria Warburton. John is back living with his father in 1871 as a widower.

Thomas married Sarah. Sarah was born circa 1852 in Worthen, Nr. Westbury, Shropshire.

She had 6 kids, 5 living. The five were present also: John born July 1875, and Charles born Feb 1877 silk warpers, Ann born Mar 1879 a silk weaver, James Jr. born Aug 1883 a shipping clerk, and William H born Mar 1888 at school. All the children were born in England and were immigrants in 1886 except William who was born in NJ.
- He appeared on the census in 1920 in Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey. James (65) is living at 187 Hamilton Street with Emma (64) and Anna (40) a silk weaver. All were immigrants in 1884, naturalised in 1892.

James married **Emma Clayton** on 21 May 1874 in Prestbury, St. Peter, Cheshire, daughter of **Charles Clayton** and **Ann Brinley\Brindley**. Emma was born on 3 Apr 1854 in England, died on 24 Jul 1926 in Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey aged 72, and was buried on 26 Jul 1926 in Cedar Lawn Cemetery, Paterson, New Jersey.

General Notes: At the time of the Cedar Lawn Cemetary Lot purchase on Jan 21 1921 she was living at 187 Hamilton Ave, Paterson. She was living at 186 Hamilton Ave. at time of death in 1926. She died of carcinoma of the liver. Informant at death was daughter Anna Warburton of 187 Hamilton Ave.

33 F iii. **Anne "Nanna" Warburton** was born in Mar 1879 in Sutton, Macclesfield, Cheshire, died on 12 Sep 1964 in Hope Dell, Wayne, New Jersey aged 85, and was buried on 16 Sep 1964 in Cedar Lawn Cemetery, Paterson, New Jersey.

General Notes: At the time of death she was living at Ellison St, Paterson.

Anne married **Thomas J. Canning** after Jul 1926. Thomas was born in 1870 in Scotalnd, died on 24 Jan 1939 in Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey aged 69, and was buried on 26 Jan 1939 in Cedar Lawn Cemetery, Paterson, New Jersey.

General Notes: He was residing at 338 Ellison Street at the time of his death in 1939.

34 M iv. **James Warburton Jr.** was born on 21 Aug 1883 in Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey, died on 17 Apr 1971 in Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey aged 87, and was buried on 21 Apr 1971 in Laurel Grove Cemetary, Totowa, New Jersey.

He was residing at 438 Lafayette Ave, Hawthorne, NJ at the time of his death. He died of Pulmomary edema, and was buried in Lot 133 A Hemlock Grave 2. Lot owner: Kenneth J. Moser and wife Phyllis.

• 1890-1893 Paterson Directory: I. A. Hall & Co 30-32 Division (later became Hamilton St). I. A Hall & Co., 185 Division. This is the company that James Warburton Jr. worked for (see his Social Security Application).

James married **Mary** " **Minnie** " **S. Hall** after 1900, daughter of **Robert B. Morehead** and **Sarah Hall**. Mary was born on 18 Dec 1884 in Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey, died on 8 Mar 1956 in Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey aged 71, and was buried on 10 Mar 1956 in Cedar Lawn Cemetery, Paterson, New Jersey.

General Notes: Mary's family owned the Hall Mill that manufactured buggy whips. The Mill was later converted into a mill that manufactured some form of textile. Mary later died of cancer, and James married the nurse hired on to care for Mary while she was ill.
