Daniel Burket was born December 17, 1785, in Berks County, Pennsylvania, to John and Barbara (Fox) Burkhart. He was baptized a month later on January 29, 1786, at the Trinity Lutheran Church in Reading, Pennsylvania. His baptismal record spells the family name as "Burckhardt." His sponsors were John Strohecker and Juliana.

Daniel spent his early Years in Berks County, before his parents started their westward trek. By 1800, the family was in Somerset County, Pennsylvania, where Daniel met and married Susanna Mull circa 1805. (This marriage date is based on the birthdate of their first known child in 1806.)

The Daniel Burket household was counted on the 1810 census of Somerset County with one male age 16-26, 1 female age 16-26, and two males under age 10 Daniel "Burkhart" appeared on the Taxable Inhabitants List for 1814, Allegheny Township, Somerset County, Pennsylvania.

(Vol. E, page 162) This coincides with the year that he was to have left Perry County

At the 1840 census, in Washington Township, Sandusky County, Ohio, page 5, the Daniel Burket fair 1 male 50 60, 1 M 10 15, 1 M 20 30, 1 fema le 40 50, 2 F 5 10, 1 F 10 15, 1 F 15 20, and 1 F 20 30.

In 1850, Daniel and Susannah are in Washington Township, Sandusky County, Ohio, page 32, #1754/1 Daniel was age 65, Farmer, real estate \$2000, born Pennsylvania, couldn't read or write; Susan age 61, born Pennsylvania, couldn't read or write; Jacob 21, Laborer, born Ohio, couldn't read or write; Ann Ohio; Barbara 16 Ohio; and Malinda 9 Ohio attended school within the year. (My Note: This last girl must be a granddaughter.)

In 1860, Washington Township, Sandusky County, Ohio, page 186, #635/657: Daniel "Burkett" was a 74, born Pennsylvania, with \$300. real property and \$100. personal property; Susan was 72, born Pennsylvania; Barbara 22, born Ohio; and Ann 21, born Ohio. A William Parker, age 1 lived in the house, also.

At the 1870 census, Daniel "Burkert," age 85, born in Pennsylvania, lived with the Catherine and Jacob Box family in Providence Township, Lucas County, Ohio. (page 22, #149/142)

Sandusky County was their last home. Susanna died first, in 1862. Daniel died December 25, 1879 having reached the age of 94 Years. He had lived in his later Years with his daughter, Mrs. Ja Box, in Providence Township, Lucas County, Ohio, where his death record was filed. Both Daniel Susannah were buried at the Hessville Cemetery, although Daniells stone no longer remained when visited in 1982

The Sandusky County Pioneer Yearbook of 1913 noted: "Daniel Burket died in Lucas County, Ohio, December 25th, 1879, aged 94 Years. He was born in Reading township [Pennsylvania] and moved to county in 1832 where he resided until 1869, when he moved to Lucas County. He was a veteran of 1812.
