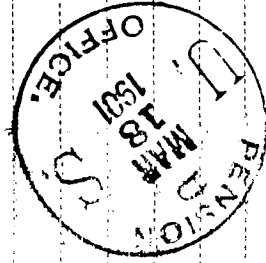

## CERTIFICATE OF DISABILITY FOR DISCHARGE.

(To be used, in duplicate, in all cases of discharge on account of disability.)

*John R. Hamm* a *Private* *20<sup>th</sup>* *Hoovers* *Company, (A)* of the *20<sup>th</sup>* *Regiment of United States*  
*Infantry* *Volts* was enlisted by *John Van Colkenburg* of  
 the *20<sup>th</sup>* *Regiment of Infantry* at *Lafayette Indiana*  
 on the *23<sup>rd</sup>* day of *July* 1861, to serve *three* years; he was born  
 in *Miami Co* in the State of *Indiana* is *Eighteen (18)*  
 years of age, *five* feet *6 1/4* inches high, *Fair* complexion, *Blue* eyes,  
*Light* hair, and by occupation when enlisted a *Farmer*. During the last two  
 months said soldier has been unfit for duty *60* days. (Here consult directions on Form 13, p. 325, Medical Dept. Gen. Reg.)  
*He appears to be suffering from dropsy of the*  
*belly.*
