William Frederick Johns, 49, World war veteran, resident of 321 West Main street, died this morning in the Veterans' hospital, Chillicothe, where he had been a patient the past three months.

He had been in ill health since he was in the service, having been wounded and gassed. He took part in some of the principal drives in the World war, and was in the service two years. Eighteen months of the time he was in France.

He enlisted at Cincinnati June 16, 1917, in the Marine corps and took his training at Ft. Royal, S.C. and at Quantico, Va. He sailed for France the following September and saw action as Verdun, Tuolons, Soissons and the second battle of the Marne at Chateau Thierry.

He was wounded June 19, 1918, at the battle of Soissons when a piece of shrapnel struck him in the arm and he was sent to a hospital. Following his return to this country he was a patient at the Naval hospital in Brooklyn, N. Y., and was discharged from the service June 24, 1919, at Quantico.

Newark Man Stricken At Auto Races

Paul T. Johns Dies En Route To Hospital After Viewing Wreck

Rushing to what looked like a serious accident Sunday afternoon at the Mound Auto Race track east of Newark, Paul T. Johns, 26, was stricken with a heart attack and died a short time later in an automobile en route to the City hospital.

His death is the second in the family circle in less than three weeks, his nephew, Gerald Johns, Jr., 3-year-old son of his brother, Gerald Johns, 408 Woods avenue, was drowned in Log Pond run May 31.

Johns, resident of 46 Gay street, a foreman at the Owens-Corning Fiberglas company, accompanied by his wife and Mr. and Mrs. Charles Thomas, relatives, drove to the track earlier in the afternoon to witness the races.

Suddenly a car driven by Clifford Warthen went out of control and turned over several times, and Johns with others started toward the car to give assistance. He collapsed and Dr. O. A. Skinner, who was near, announced that his condition was serious and arranged for his removal to the hospital. A physician pronounced Johns dead when he arrived there. Warthen, driver of the racing car, suffered only minor

injuries.

Johns' relatives said he had arisen at 3:30 a.m. Sunday and made a fishing trip to Buckeye lake, returning before noon, and was apparently in his usual health when he started for the track.

Jerry Johns, 3-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Gerald Johns, 408 Woods avenue, drowned in Log Pond run Friday afternoon. The child had been playing with other children at the Woods avenue bridge. He became separated from his playmates and accidently fell off the bridge at 1:40 p. m. into the swift-running waters. He was carried four blocks down stream to Buckingham street, where Samuel Honenberger, 65 Shields street, carried the child out of the water at 2:05.

City Fireman Samuel Pfeffer and Capt. Dwight Jones, with the inhalator, worked until 2:55, but were unable to revive the victim. The firemen were assisted by Drs. Paul Grove and James Johnson.

The body was removed to the Egan & Son's undertaking rooms where it was viewed by Acting Coroner Dr. Paul C. Keller, who rendered a verdict of accidental drowning.

This is the first drowning in the city this year. The happening recalls a similar incident in a flood of 1918, when Councilman Frank P. McNealy, while fishing for driftwood in the same stream lost his balance, fell in and was drowned. His body was carried to the American Bottle company yards, more than a mile away, and was not recovered until 10 days later, after the waters had receded.
