HARRISON BLANTON born 13 Aug 1791 Va.; d 9 Nov 1879 Frankfort, Kentucky, is buried at Frankfort. The Blanton lot in Woodford County Cemetery, on a hill overlooking the Kentucky River, is about 100 feet east of the tomb of Daniel BOONE. Harrison Blanton was a son of Richard (1760/6 Va-1809 Ky.); grandson of Richard (1720 Va-1819 Ky); and great-grandson of Richard Blanton whose will was proved 1734, Spotsylvania Co Va.

In 1799 the family moved from Virginia to Fayette County, Ky. In 1807 Harrison Blanton became a resident of Frankfort; for many years he was a prominent citizen of Franklin County, Ky. He obtained stone from the bed of the Kentucky River near Buffalo Crossing, with which to build his handsome residence "Beechwood."

HARRISON BLANTON married 17 Nov 1812 Fayette Co. Ky., Miss "Betsy" Elizabeth, dau of the Rev Ambrose DUDLEY, a native of Virginia, and a Captain in the Revolution, who died at Lexington, Ky. at 6 a.m. on Thursday 27 Jan 1825, at age 75 years. He marr. Anne PARKER in 1773. The Dudley's are of English origin and trace their ancestry back to the 13th Century.

The Homeplace was later occupied by his son JOHN, whose Estate was settled 1811, and later still by John's son WILLIS BLANTON (1789 Va-1859 Ky). The home was on a hill overlooking all of the hills that surround Frankfort, Kentucky. The land was lately owned by the widow of Lafayette CRUTCHER, and is in full view of the site of the old Grassy Springs Church, and the nearby cemetery, both of which have recently become abandoned.




