1. ELLIS¹ BARRON was born 1600 in Waterford, Ireland, and died Oct 30, 1676 in Watertown, Middlesex Co., MA¹. He married (1) GRACE ? About 1625. She was born About 1604 in England, and died Aft. 1647 in Watertown, Middlesex Co., MA. He married (2) HANNAH ? Dec 04, 1653². She was born Unknown, and died Aft. Oct 30, 1676.

BARRON, ELLIS, or ELLIZ, Watertown, freeman 2 June 1641, brought from England probably three or four children for Bond names the issue in this order, Ellis, Mary, who married 10 December 1650, Daniel Warren; Susanna, who married 14 December 1653, Stephen Randall; Hannah, who married abt. 1659, Simon Coolidge; John; Sarah, born 4 July 1640; Moses, 1 March 1643; and Peter, a soldier in Moseley's Company killed by the Indians September 1675. He had two wives: Grace (thought to be mother of all those children), and Hannah, widow of Timothy Hawkins, married 4 December 1653; was constable 1658, selectman 1668, and died 30 October 1676. His will made four days before, proved 19 December following, provides for widow, the seven children remaining after loss of Peter, and for grandchild Elizabeth Barron.

From POPE, The Pioneers of Massachusetts:

BARRON, Ellis, and Elliz, Watertown, Freeman June 2, 1641; proprietor; bought meadow in Cambridge in 1653. Wife Grace. Ellis, age about 20 in 1653 [Middlesex Files] (married 14 (10) 1658, Hannah Hawkins), Mary (married December 10, 1650, Daniel Warren), Susanna (married 14 (10) 1653 Stephen Randall), Hannah (married 17 (9) 1658, Simon Coolidge), John, Sarah born 25 (4) 1640, Moses born (1) 1643. He married second, Hannah, widow of Timothy Hawkins, Senior, whose will, dated 18 August 1683, probated October 6, 1685, mentions her son Timothy Hawkins and her daughter Hannah Barron's children, grandchildren Benjamin and Benoni Garfield. He died October 30, 1676. His will probated December 19, 1676, bequeaths to wife, sons Elizeus, John and Moses, and the rest of his seven children; to grandchild Elizabeth Barron. The inventory mentions "barbaren instruments" and tools "to draw teeth," etc.

From Farmer's Genealogical Register of the First Settlers of New England:

BARRON, ELLIS, Watertown, who, from the colony records, is called by Mr. Savage, Barrow, was admitted freeman 1641, had a wife Grace; a daughter of this name born 1640, and a son Moses, born 1643, who probably settled at Chelmsford, and was ancestor of Oliver Barron, Harvard College 1788, a physician, who died in the Isle of Man, in 1809. W. Winthrop.

RANDALL, STEPHEN, Watertown, married 14 December 1653, Susanna, daughter of Ellis Barron, had Elizabeth who married Stephen Codman; Stephen, born 20 August 1655, who probably died young; Susanna, who married William Shatuck; and Mary, 24 June 1662. He was perhaps elder son of that widow Elizabeth, who died at Watertown 24 December 1672, aged 80; and he died 26 February 1708. The will of 13 January 1698, names the three daughters and Mary married only six weeks after that date

Abraham Chamberlin; yet the will was not, of course, potential in the match. He left no male descendants.

She married DANIEL WARREN¹⁰ Dec 10, 1650 in Watertown, Middlesex Co., MA^{10,11}, son of JOHN WARREN and MARGARET BAYLY. He was born About Feb 25, 1626/27 in Nayland, Suffolk, England^{12,13}, and died Feb 13, 1714/15 in Watertown, Middlesex Co., MA.

WARREN, DANIEL, Watertown, son of the first John, born in England married 10 December 1650, Mary, eldest daughter of Ellis Barron, had Mary, born 29 November 1651; Daniel, 6 October 1653; Hannah; Sarah, 4 July 1658; Elizabeth 17 September 1660; Susanna, 26 December 1663, died under 15 years.; John, 5 March 1666; Joshua, 4 July 1668; and Grace, 14 March 1672. He swore fidelity 1652, was selectman between 1680 and 98, twelve years Mary married 29 May 1668, John Child, and next, 13 April 1677, Nathaniel Fiske; Hannah married 24 September 1675, David Mead; Elizabeth married 6 December 1681 Jonathan Tainter; and Grace married 20 January 1691, Joseph Morse.

CHILD, or CHILDS, JOHN, Watertown, by Bond thought to have been a nephew of Ephraim, by first wife Mary had Mary, born 8 January 1664; and by second wife, married 29 May 1668, Mary Warren, eldest daughter of Daniel, had John, 25 April 1669; Elizabeth 24 July 1670; and Daniel, whose birth is not seen, but his baptism 5 June 1687, was several years after the death of his father and second marriage of his mother. He died 15 October 1676, aged 40; and his widow married 13 April following Nathaniel Fiske.

JOSHUA WARREN lived on Warren Street just west of the Watertown line. He was born in 1668 the son of Daniel and Mary (Barron) Warren and grandson of John Warren who came to Watertown in 1630. The later was selectman in 1636 and 1640. He was granted by the town about 290 acres and purchased other lots. One of these purchases was a lot of 16 acres upon which his son Daniel was living when John made his will in 1667. Daniel was married in 1650 so may have built in that year. By five deeds between 1700 and 1704 he sold or gave to his son Joshua nearly all his land including his homestead of 20 acres occupying the same site

as the 16 acres he had received from his father. About 1695 Joshua married Rebecca Church a granddaughter of Richard Church of the Mayflower. They had twelve children of whom the youngest was Phinehas and to him in 1745 they deeded "for a satisfactory and valuable consideration" the same homestead of 20 acres and two other lots. He had in the course of his lifetime purchased and sold several other tracts of land. Rebecca died in 1757 nearly seventy-nine years old and he in 1760 in his ninety-second year.

She was born Jun 10, 1637 in Watertown, Middlesex Co., MA^{58,59}, and died Unknown. He married (2) LYDIA PRESCOTT 1678 in Watertown, Middlesex Co., MA, daughter of JOHN PRESCOTT. She was born Aug 15, 1641 in Watertown, Middlesex Co., MA⁶⁰, and died Unknown.

BARRON, ELLIS, Watertown, son of the preceding, married Hannah, daughter of Timothy Hawkins, and Bond gives the date which I have taken for marriage of her mother with the father of this husband, though he may be right, and possibly mother and daughter, father and son were married on one day, yet it seems less probable. He had Ellis, born 22 April 1655; Hannah, 6 March 1658; Elizabeth 14 April 1660, died soon; Sarah, 4 November 1662; and perhaps Elizabeth again; removed to Groton, there had Grace, 29 July 1665; Mehitabel, 22 June 1668; Timothy, 18 April 1673; Dorothy, 6 March 1675, perhaps died young; and Abigail, 14 November 1676. At Lancaster he made his will 31 December 1711, proved 7 October following, which teaches us the names of husbands for six of his daughters: Abigail Houghton, Mehitabel Parker, Hannah Cady, wife of James, Elizabeth Philbrick, wife of Ephraim, Sarah Taylor, and Grace Stevens. He had preferred Lancaster to Groton after the equal destruction of both. From Groton he was delivered in Philip's war, and reappears at Watertown with wife Lydia.

COOLIDGE, SIMON, Watertown, son of first John, probably born in England, married 17 November 1657, Hannah, daughter probably of Ellis Barron, first of the same, had Mary, born 11 December 1660; Obadiah, July 1663, died soon; Obadiah, again, about 1664; Joseph, 31 May 1666, both before mentioned; Sarah, who married 10 July 1701, Samuel Hastings, as second wife; Hannah, 7 December 1671, who married 3 November 1693, Daniel Smith, and next, 22 May 1729, deacon Nathan Fiske; Stephen, 1 June 1674, died young; and Lydia, 1677, died soon. His wife died 24 July 1680, and he married 19 January 1682, Priscilla Rogers, and died 27 December 1693, aged 71. His widow died next year.

Bond tells of marriage of the third wife 10 July 1701, Sarah, daughter of Simon Coolidge, who had Daniel, and Benjamin, again, both baptized 19 July 1702; and Nathaniel, of which 1728, his uncle Joseph Coolidge, was guardian and died between 11 April 1722, the date of his will, and 19 August 1723, when it was proved. *
