GEORGE CALVERT, 1st Lord of Baltimore, b. circa 1580; d. 15th Apr. 1632; became private secretary to Sir Robert CECIL; was appointed by the King, Clerk of the Crown and Assize in Co. Clare, Ireland; in 1613, appointed Clerk to the Privy Council; knighted in 1617. In 1619 was made Principal Secretary of State. Was member of Parliament from Yorkshire in 1621. 18th Feb. 1621, the King granted him a manor of 2300 acres in Co. Langford, Ireland, which was erected into the Manor of Baltimore, from which he derived his baronial title. Elevated to the Irish Peerage as Baron Baltimore, 16th Feb. 1625; m. (firstly) circa 1605, Anne MYNNE, [p.164] d. 8th Aug. 1622, dau. of John MYNNE, Esq., of Hertingfordbury, and Elizabeth WROTH, his wife, dau. of Sir Thomas WROTH of Durance in Enfield, Middlesex, Knight; m. (secondly) Joan—as mentioned in legal papers; her surname unknown.

Catholic colonizer of Maryland. Born in London in 1606, Cecilius or Cecil, was the eldest son of George Calvert, Baron of Baltimore in Ireland. On his father's death in 1632, Cecilius succeeded to the title. He immediately began to realize his father's dream of establishing a colony in America as a refuge for his fellow Catholics. On Nov. 22, 1633, Calvert dispatched to Maryland two ships, the Ark and the Dove, with between 200-300 settlers aboard, the majority of them Protestants. Among these were the Jesuit priests Andrew White and John Altham, accompanied by a lay brother Thomas Gervase.

Determined to avoid religious strife in the new colony, Cecilius instructed his brother Leonard Calvert who, he had appointed governor, that all settlers were to be granted religious liberty. He invited the Society of Jesus to care for the spiritual needs of Maryland's Catholics provided they construct self-supported missions, land for which they would obtain from him. When the Jesuits insisted on their right to acquire unlimited land grants from the Indians, Cecilius pressured the Jesuit General to order his subjects to conform to proprietary law and to grant the proprietor a veto over missionaries assigned to the colony.

During the English Civil War Maryland was seized Virginia Puritans who expelled Governor Leonard Calvert. He regained control of the colony but died shortly thereafter in 1647. To diffuse religious tension, Cecilius appointed as Governor a Protestant, William Stone, in 1648. When Charles I was executed in Jan 1649 and the Commonwealth created, Calvert wrote "The Act Concerning Religion" adopted by the colony on April 21, 1649, which was designed to allay Puritan suspicions and save his proprietorship. Though Virginia Puritans again seized Maryland in 1655, it was returned to him in 1658. Calvert died in London on November 30, 1675.

LEONARD CALVERT, II, b. 1606; d. 1647; he was Prothonotary and Keeper of the Writs in Connaught and Thomond, Ireland, in 1621, and was Governor of Maryland from 1633 to 1647, having been appointed by his brother, Cecilius, Lord Baltimore; he came with the Ark and the Dove in 1633 and in 1641 returned to England, so it must have been about this time that he was m. to Anne BRENT (who predeceased him), a dau. of Richard and Elizabeth (REED) BRENT of Larke Stoke and Admington, Gloucestershire, and a sister of "Mistress Margaret Brent," Mary, Giles and Fulke BRENT, who migrated to the Province.

He Was Aged Sixty-five and Had
Been Deputy Sheriff and Chief
Of Police

Lyman Pierce, one of the best-known citizens of Owensboro, died of apoplexy at 5 o'clock Tuesday afternoon at his home at 932 Leitchfield road. He had been ill but a short time and his death was entirely unexpected. Mr. Pierce had always been apparently a hearty and healthy man.

Mr. Pierce was sixty-five years of age and was born at Rockport, Ind., August 21, 1844. He had been a resident of Owensboro for many years and was engaged in the grocery business several times. For eight years he was a deputy sheriff of Daviess county and for four years he was chief of police of the city. He was a Confederate veteran and was a member of the Rice E. Graves camp of Owensboro. A meeting of the camp has been called for 3 o'clock this afternoon to arrange for the camp attending the funeral in a body.

He is survived by five sons and one daughter. His wife died several years ago. The children surviving are: L.E.; L. H.; H. W.; F. M.; W. D. Pierce and Mrs. P. J. McArdle.

The funeral will take place at 10 o'clock Thursday morning from the residence with services by the Rev. J. H. Young, of Settle Memorial church, of which the deceased was a member. The interment will be in the Iron Ore Hill cemetery.
