The Will of Richard Bowin, Sr. (transcribed for the Mayflower Descendant by George Ernest Bowman)

The will and inventory of Richard Bowin, Sr., of Rehoboth, were recorded in the Plymouth Colony Wills and Inventories, Volume III, Part I, pages 147-149. They are here printed in full, at the expense of Mr. Herbert Bowen.

Especial attention should be called to the married name of Richard Bowin's daughter Ruth. Pope's "Pioneers of Massachusetts," page 60, calls her Ruth "Leverich"; but the original record plainly reads "Ruth Kenericke," in two places. The first letter of the surname is the same as in the word "Knowne," at the beginning of the will, and is entirely unlike the capital letter in "Leanto" and "Lands," in the same record.

[Richard Bowin's Will]

[3:1:147] The last Will and Testament of Richard Bowin senir of Rehoboth in the Collonie of Plymouth in New England exhibited to the Court held att Plymouth aforsaid the fouth of June Anno: Dom 1675 on the oath of Mr John Pecke as followeth

Be it Knowne unto all men by these prsents that I Richard Bowin senir: of Rehoboth in the Collonie of New Plymouth in New England Doe the Day and Date above written ordaine and make this my last will and Testament being in my Good and prfect Memory and understanding as followeth;

Item I Give to my beloved wife Elizabeth two Cowes and one heiffer a yeer old and a Mare 5 yeer old and a Mare Colt two yeer old and one Colt that followeth the Mare;

Item I Give unto my wife my best bed; with all that belonges to it; and all my linnine two Pewter platters; with som other small peeces of pewter; both the bras kettles I Iron pott I skillett one frying pan all my poultry and halfe my swine younge and old alsoe I Give to my wife one Coffe; and halfe my provisions after my buriall; halfe of my Corne; halfe my hay that is Gathered in or may be Growing att my Decease; halfe my butter Cheese Bacon and porke; one hake with the eke belonging to it; one Cherne one brewing tubb one powdering tubb one beer barrell and my milk vessells; Cushens one Candlestick; all these foremensioned prticulars; I Give to my beloved wife to Dispose of att her Death unto whom shee will; moreover I Give unto my wife my bible my warming pan; halfe my house that prte of the Leanto, nearest unto the Chimney; as alsoe halfe my orchyard; and halfe my home lott; excepting that prte I sould unto Stephen Paine senir: being an acre more or lesse; all these I say I Give unto my beloved wife, the full tearme of her life; moreover my wife shall have libertie to mow two load of hay on my meddow att Palmers River and three load more on my meddow on the New meddow necke, every yeer soe longe as shee liveth;

Item I Give to my son Willam one hundred pounds Comonage; my lott on the East syde of the plaine my lott in the second Devision; my prte of ffresh meddow lying and being neare the mile run; my ffresh meddow at Palmers

River all my meddow that I have mowed att my meddow on the New meddow necke The other pte of this meddow, I have Given unto my son Obadiah; and my son Richard, as will appeer by a Deed of Gift under my hand; Moreover I Give unto my son Willam; halfe my house halfe my barn; halfe my orchyard halfe my home lott except that I sould to Steven Paine senir: and it is my Will that that after my wifes Decease that my son Willam shall have all my housing and barnes orchyard homlott with all those lands and meddowes before mensioned unto him and his heires forever;

Item I Give unto my son Willam halfe my swine halfe my Corne halfe my hay; Ingathered or may be Growing and halfe my provisions; butter Cheese bacon Porke;

Item I Give to my son Willam halfe my Cart and wheeles my Cart Rope with my plow and plowirons belonging to it 2 Chaires two hogsheads, and all other Corne vessell my wife Can spare; my hake with the Ringe; on it; my Great brasse pott an Iron pott and my Great brasse pan; and alsoe it is my will that hee shall have the land which is to be Devided according to the Devision of 20 acres to the hundred pound estate; and alsoe my lott lately layed out on the necke Called Wachamaquat necke; and all such lands as shalbe Devided after the Date hereof; according to the propotion of a hundred pound estate; I alsoe Give unto my son Willam; my Chest in the hall my Coffe in the seller loft my Chaine my hay knife Dung forke Pikes Rakes hand saw augers 2 beetle ringes and all my Iron wedges; as alsoe that oxe Called Duke; and my bible after my Wifes Decease;

Item I alsoe Give unto my son Willam the bed hee now lyeth on and the furniture belonging to it; and one bed sheet and my winnow sheet; and all my boards about my house, and all my wearing apparrell;

Item I Give unto my son Obadiah halfe a hundred pounds of Comonage; my plow Irons of my breakeing plow and my thawrtcutt saw and halfe my logg Chaine; and the other halfe I Give to my son Willam;

Item I Give to my Daughter Alice Wheaton my Daughter Sarah ffuller and my Daughter Ruth Kenericke my old mare and a Colt that suckes on her;

Item I Give to my Daughter Alice Wheaton my fflagon and two pewter platters;

Item I Give to my Daughter Sarah ffuller my warming pan after my wifes Decease; and a pewter platter when the will is proved;

Item I Give to my Daughter Ruth Kenericke one pewter platter;

It is alsoe my will that if any of these fornamed beasts [p.148]: viz: neat beasts or horses given Doe Die or come to any lose, the lose shalbe to the pticular prson or prsons unto whom they were Given; my executor shalbe free hee shall not make it Good to him or them;

Item all the Rest of my Goods lands Chattles or whatsoever I have not Given in this my Will and Testament; I Give to my son Richard whom I make and ordaine my sole executor to pay my Debts and to Discharge my legacyes and to see my body buried; witnes my hand the Day and yeer above written

BOWEN FAMILY NOTES, by Charles Shepard

In the Heraldic Notes on the Bowen family, printed in the Collections for July, 1931, pages 132-133, the statement is made that Dr. Richard Bowen, father of Jabez, was "son of Thomas Bowen of Salem," who was son of Richard Bowen of Rehoboth. Following the statement in Savage's Genealogical Dictionary of New England, Thomas Bowen of Salem is frequently confused, as here, with the contemporary Thomas of Rehoboth and New London, and since the latter was a direct ancestor of that branch of the Bowen family which was most prominent in Rhode Island, a few notes on the two Thomases may not be amiss."

...

"The other Thomas Bowen, the father of Dr. Richard Bowen, was apparently the younger of four known sons of the elder Richard Bowen of Rehoboth, who was buried there in February 1674/75. It is reasonable to guess that he

was born about 1633, so that he was nearly if not fully ten years younger than the other Thomas of Marblehead. He moved to New London, apparently about 1657, was living there in 1662, and still owned his land in New London when he made his will in 1663, having then returned to Rehoboth where he apparently died. His will may be found in the Mayflower Descendant for 1914, vol. 16, page 128, and that of his father is printed in vol. 17, at page 247."

{Thomas Bowen's Will}

"Thomas Bowin late Inhabitant of New London in the Jurisdiction of Conecticott; though att present sojourning in the towne of Rehoboth in the Collonie of New Plymouth" made his will 11 April, 1663. Bequests were as follows: To "my son Richard Bowen one matchlocke muskett and one sword with all my tooles belonging to the trad of a Cooper; and four pewter platters; alsoe...one 2 yeare old heiffer; and alsoe my will is that my welbeloved wife Elizabeth Bowen shall keep this heiffer and the encrease therof for my son Richard Bowin and that shee shall bring him up in the feare of the Lord and teach him to write and Read;"

To "wife Elizabeth Bowen all the Rest of my household goods" also "one house and home Lott containeing seaven acres and an halfe more or lesse lying in the abovesaid New London; as alsoe one allotment of upland and meddow lying on the east side of the great River in the same towne Containeing thirty six acres more or lesse with all privilidges and Just Rights therto belonging" also "two Cowes with their encrease and three younge Cattle; and I Doe make...my...wife my sole exequitrix....to whom alsoe I give all my Debts Requireing her to see the legacyes given unto my son Richard aforsaid payed ....and paying all my Debts"

"I also will....that my Brother Obadiah Bowen and my brother in law Robert ffuler bee overseers of this my last will"

Died

In this town, on Friday morning inst., after a long and peculiarly distressing illness, JOHN CARTER, Esq. aged 69 years -- He was a native of Philadelphia, and, after honourably serving a faithful apprenticeship with those eminent Printers, Messrs. Franklin & Hall, removed to this town, and, for about 45 years, was the sole Proprietor and able Editor of the Providence Gazette. Dr. Franklin, his friend and benefactor, appointed him Postmaster in this town, which responsible office he faithfully discharged until the year 1792, when he resigned. His patriotick principles and delicate sense of propriety were manifested (through various vicissitudes) by the correctness of his manner in conducting his paper, the columns of which were uniformly devoted to the best interests of his country, by the dissemination of important political and moral truths. In his multifarious transactions, as a man of business, his honour and integrity were unblemished. The genuine benevolence of his heart was displayed by the courtesy of his manners in the exercise of the rights of hospitality, and the unfortunate and the poor excited his sympathy, and partook of his bounty. By an affectionate discharge of the relative duties of domestick life, he attached the reverential regard of his wife, children and friends.

On Sunday afternoon, after the burial service had been impressively

performed by the Rev. Mr. Crocker, his remains were respectfully deposited in the cemetery of St. John's Church.
