PRIOR, THOMAS, Scituate, came in 1634 from London, with Lothrop, died 1639, buried says Lothrop, 22 June; in his will of June in that year names sons Samuel, and Thomas, daughters Elizabeth and Mary, all in Old England and his three sons here, before mentioned.

Mr. Timothy Hatherley to have oversight of this. Witnessed by John Winter, Joseph Tilden, Wm. Crocker, George Kennerich.

From Pope's The Pioneers of Massachusetts:

PRIOR, PRYOR, Thomas, Scituate, took oath of allegiance 1 February 1638.

He was buried June 22, 1639; will probated September 28, 1639. Son John executor; probably the John who came in the Hopewell in September 1635, age 16 years;) other sons Joseph and Daniel here, and Samuel and Thomas and daughters Elizabeth and Mary in England in England; [Reg. IV, 36.] He was formerly of Watford, co. Herts, maulster; sons John and Daniel sold property there 28 (6) 1640. [L.] Joseph, not yet 20 years old, sued Daniel and his wife Mary 5 Nov. 1644, for his portion of the patrimony.
