# April Conference 1843

... Rec'd Bertha, a colored girl of Brother Hargroves

### June Conference 1844

... reported a case of Bro Hargroves negro girl Kesiah of improper conduct for which she was Excommunicated...

## August Conference 1844

... went into an election for delegates to the Association when the following brethren were elected Wm. Sapp, E. Sapp & & A. Davis & J. Lassiter, & H. Hargroves alternate

#### December Conference 1844

... on the 3d Sabbath the church restored Kizziah the property of Henry Hargroves & Viney the property of Mrs Reddy to the fellowship of the church.

#### July Conference 1845

... committy appointed to hold a correspondence with Big Buckhead Church Brother Sapp & A. B. Graham & H. Hargroves

<u>August Conference 1845</u>... went into the choice of delegates to the Association when Wm. Sapp, E. Sapp & H. Hargrove were elected, & R. Elliston, A. Davis & G.L.C. Rice alternates Bro Wm Sapp write the letter.

## May Conference 1846

Moved and seconded that on Saturday the regular meeting takes place that the church call a Deacon suggested Brother H. Hargroves

#### June Conference 1846

...went into choice of a Deacon unanimously chosen Brother Henry Hargroves

and ordered Brother W. Sapp, Brickett, Churchill to assist at next meeting on his ordination

## July Conference 1846

...the presbyters met & ordained bro H. Hargroves deacon viz W. B. Brickett, C. P. Churchill & Joseph Polhill

## August Conference 1846

... went into the Election of delagates to the Association when the Brethren E. Sapp, Wm. Sapp and Jesse Rice were chosen, & H. Hargroves & M. Herrington alternates...

## January Conference 1847

... the committee appointed to labor with Brother Martin Herrington & H. Hargroves reported that the difficulty was settled... Appointed Wm. Sapp, H. Hargroves, E. Sapp & M. McElmurray delegates to our general meeting, Wm. Sapp to write. In conference on 3rd Sabbath excommunicated Keziah belonging to H. Hargroves & Eliza belonging to I. Sapp.

## August Conference 1847

... went into an election for delegates to the Association when E. Sapp, H. Hargroves, Wm. Sapp were elected, and J. Lassiter, M. McElmurray & A. Mills, alternates

### September Conference 1848

...moved and seconded that we go in to the choice of delagates to our next Association, when Wm. Sapp, E. Sapp & H. Hargroves were elected, & R. Ellison & H. McElmurray, alternats. . .

#### December Conference 1848

... agreed to appoint the following brothers to the general meeting at Black Creek (viz) J0 Coflin (probably Caughlin), Wm. Sapp, H. Hargroves and A. F. Graham, Wm. Sapp to write, and that we ask for a general meeting. . .

#### May Conference 1849

... received a letter of love from the Baptist Church of Christ at Big Buckhead by the hands of the brethren B. L. Perkins and H. Thorn And resolved to correspond with them, and the brethren H. Hargroves, A. Mills, . B. Cates, A. Graham and E. Sapp volunteered to visit them, E. Sapp to write...

## August Conference 1849

...moved and seconded that we go in to the choice of delagates to our next Asspciation, when William Sapp, E. Sapp and H. Hargroves were elected and R. Ellison and M. McElmurray as alternates

Brother Sapp departed this life 6 October 1849

#### March Conference 1850

Appointed Brethren R. Ellison, A. E. Graham, H. Hargroves & Wm. Sapp delagates to Bethlehem general meeting convened on Friday before the 5th Sabath in this month...

### April Conference 1851

... 4th Sabbath received Mariah belonging to Brother Henry Hargroves.

## July Conference 1851

... the church having been informed of the case of Hiss Elva Hanberry who has been guilty of adultery and will soon bring forth Resolved unanimously that she be excluded from the church\*

\*I included this because Elva Hanbury is enumerated in the household of Henry Hargroves in the 1850 census.(D.D.S.)

### August Conference 1851

... Brother Hargroves reported that at last Sabbath conference for the blacks John the property of Dr. Hines was restored to fellowship.

### September Conference 1851

... Elected W. Sapp, H. Hargrove, R. Ellison, Wm. Kimbrel to the Association
