FATHER NOTES: Archibald6Aa5 Douglass

General: Archibald6Aa5 = Archibald, 6th generation, if he was descendant from William 1610, which per GHJ Douglas' book of 1879, he is not. Per page 444, Archibald descends from Thomas, b. 1745. [The name Archibald is in Scottish history.]

The first source for Archibald Douglass is the Family Search IGI family tree, (International Genealogical Index. Birth of 20 Jan 1781 in New Jersey.

Can't find Charlotteburgh Furnace as a town. About 20 furnaces in New Jersey. Old ones in counties: Oxford in Warren Co. 1742. The Oxford Iron and Nail Company, Oxford, Warren County. [Burgh is a Scottish term for a town.]

In the 1820 US Census, official date 7 Aug 1820. Archibald Douglas is in Covert, Seneca, New York, page 318, image 14 of 15. Males: 1=0 thru 9, 2=10 thru 15, x,=16 thru 17 x=16 thru 25, 1=26 thru 44.. Females: 4=0 thru 9, x=10 thru 15, 1=16 thru 25, 1=26 thru 44.

[There are no 1820 US Census records for Franklin County, Ohio.]

In the 1830 (1 June) US Census, Archibald is in Town of Worthington, Franklin County, Ohio. Males: x x 1=10 thru 14 (b.1816-1820), x 2=20 thru 29 (b.1801-1810), x 1=40 thru 49 (b.1781-1790). Females: 1=0 thru 4 (b. 1826-1830), 2=5 thru 9 (b. 1821-1825), 1=10 thru 14 (b.1816-1820), 2=15 thru 19 (b.1811-1815), x x 1=40 thru 49 (b. 1781-1790)

In the 1840 (1 June) US Census in Monroe, Knox Co., Ohio, Archibald is in the 60 thru 69 range, b. ca 1771 - 1780. Thus pretty close to 1781. Also, 1 male b. 1801-10, fits Thomas, b. ca 1806 or John, b. ca 1808. And 1 male b. 1811-20, fits A. J., b. ca 1819 per 1850 Census. Females: 2 in 1821-1825, fits Mary b. ca 1820 and Jane, b. 1822. Also 1 female in 1826-1830, fits Sophia, b. 1825, after census date of 1 June 1840.

Children are: Margaret 1804, Thomas 1806, Almira 1810, John 1808, and Maria 1812. A total of 11 children. In the process of adding children to Archibald's file, he had children in Franklin County, Ohio! The same county as George H. Andrews, and Ray W. Andrews!

See notes with the children for more details.

7. Were Sophia Douglas and aka Ray W. Andrews twins? Maybe, maybe not. Census ages would support births ~one year apart. Ray first, 1 Jun 1825 - 31 May 1826 and then Sophia 1 Jun 1826 – 31 May 1827. [Using 1825/6 and 1826/7 as birth years for aka Ray and Sophia, respectively, for record ordering.]

Source for death: Find A Grave #54115855: Archibald Douglass, in Gambier, Knox, Ohio, death date: 9 Dec 1848, Cemetery: Kenyon College Cemetery. Along with death date is "(aged 66-67)".

MOTHER NOTES: Rachel Fisher

General: The first source for Rachel Fisher is the Family Search.org's IGI database: International Genealogical Index, a family tree database. Her death date is given as 1837 in Worthington, Franklin, Ohio. This is the same county as George H. Andrews and his wife, Maria Fisher, b. in New Jersey.

Who were Rachel's (b. 1785) parents? The preponderance of genealogical evidence leads to the conclusion that they were Peter (#2) Fisher, b. 1763 and Maria Van Houten, b. 1766 in New Jersey. The evidence: 1. Peter and Maria were of legal age, 21 and 18, in 1784, to be married. 2. Peter moved his family to the Ithaca, NY area after the birth of Rachel's first child. (Rachel m. Archibald Douglas, b. 1781.). 3. Rachel named a son, b. 1819, A. J. Douglas, after her sister's (Catharine b. 1791) husband, Arad Joy, b. 1790.

Rachel's b. year is about 1785, based on the 1804 birth of her first child, and married at age 18 in ca 1803. Her last child b. ca 1826, so then age \sim 41.

Per IGI family tree, Rachel m. Archibald Douglass and they had children in Ithaca, NY. One child was **Arad Joy Douglass**, b ca 1819. Here is some interesting **info from the Tompkin Co. message board**:

[Arad Joy was born April 5, 1790 in Guilford, Windham, Vermont, and died April 16, 1872 in Ovid, Seneca, New York. He married Catherine Fisher January 2, 1814 in Genoa, Gayuga, New York. She was born May 25, 1791 in Pompton, New Jersey, and died May 18, 1872 in Ovid, Seneca, New York.

Children of Arad Joy and Catherine Fisher are:

i. Charles Arad Joy, born 1823 in Ludlowville, Tompkins, NY.

ii. Cornelia Catherine Joy, born Abt. 1825 in Ludlowville, Tompkins, NY; died Aft. 1876. She married Heman Dyer 1850; born September 24, 1810 in Shaftsbury, Bennington, VT; died July 29, 1900 in New York City, NY.

Cornelia C. Joy Dyer wrote a book entitled, "A Brief History of the Joy Family by One of Them", published in 1876. On page 23 of the 1876 edition, there is a tribute by Henry M. Field to the memory of Arad Joy, which states, "Last August, while in the country, this good patriarch came with his wife to visit their son, Prof. Charles A. Joy of Columbia college, who has a summer retreat among the Berkshire hills."

I assume that this Charles A. Joy is your Charles **Arad Joy**. I know nothing of his other siblings. The date I have for his birth is from you, which is entirely consistent with Arad Joy's marriage date. They had 7 children in Ludlowville (5 lived), and they moved to Geneva, Ontario, NY in 1826.]

Archibald and Rachel F. Douglass lived in both Ithaca and Ovid, NY. Thus, it is likely that Rachel was related to Catherine Fisher.

Another bit of info from Tompkins message board:

Believe that Inlet Valley cemetery in Ithaca was once known as **Fisher**. Headstones were not found in 2000, but there are entries for Peter Van Houten and **Rachel** Van Houtten in this cemetery's records:

From Wikipedia:

[So for 1790 Census, try Montgomery Co.]

Cayuga County was formed in 1799 by the splitting of Onondaga County. This county was, however, much larger than the present Cayuga County. It then included the present Seneca and Tompkins counties.

[So for 1800 Census, try Cayuga Co.]

In 1804, Seneca County was formed by the splitting of Cayuga County.

[So, for 1810 Census, try Seneca Co.]

On April 7, 1817, Tompkins County was created by combining portions of Seneca and the remainder of Cayuga County. The county was named after then Vice-President (to President James Monroe) and former New York Governor Daniel Tompkins. Tompkins almost certainly never visited the county named for him.

Find a Grave memorial # 54115856 for Rachel. Buried in Knox County, Ohio.

Males: 1=0 thru 9 (fits AJ), 2=10 thru 15 (fits Thomas & John), x,=16 thru 17 x=16 thru 25, 1=26 thru 44.. Females: 4=0 thru 9 (fits Almira, Maria, Angeline & Eliza), x=10 thru 15, 1=16 thru 25 (**fits Margaret**), 1=26 thru 44.

Various Ancestry.com hints, marriage in Franklin Co., Ohio, to a Dayton Topping, and US Census records from Greene Co., Indiana, show that they were close to William C. Andrews' activities in Worthington, Indiana. It's a small world.

Douglass, 31, b. ca 1819, in New York, and Maila Douglass, 21, b. ca 1829, in Ohio [believe nee Andrews]. From this A. J. 's given name is known. [Thomas was never married, per GHJD.]

Per the Family Search International Genealogical Index (IGI), Thomas' father is Archibald Douglas(s), b. 1781 and the mother is Rachel Fisher, d. 1837 in Worthington, Ohio (The same county as Maria Fisher who married George H. Andrews. And Ray W. Andrews b. ca 1825 - 1826, with Y-DNA that matches a Douglass!

An Ancestry.com hint gives a Pennsylvania Death Certificate of Almir, born Ithaca, NY, married to Herman Dyer.

The location and/or date of birth don't make logical sense, in that Worthington, Ohio is in-between. So maybe other siblings locations/dates are not correct.

The first mention of **Douglass** is from George H. Andrews will:

This from an article about George T. Andrews published in Iowa.

George (H. Andrews) lived to be 78 years old, dying 15 or 16 March 1861 in Franklin County, Ohio. He signed his will on 9 May 1856 and it was admitted to probate on 2 April 1861. In it he named his wife Maria, sons George T. Andrews and William C. Andrews, daughters Anna A. Gunn, **Maila R. Douglass**, Clarissa Ann Davis, Zelda Andrews, and the children of his deceased daughter, Lydia Pinney. George was buried in Walnut Grove Cemetery, Worthington, Ohio. Maria lived another ten years, dying on 4 September 1871, age 84, and was buried beside her husband.

New York, farmer, with Marla [looks like Maila without the i dotted.] R. D., 30, (1830), b. Ohio, Frank L. D., 10, b. Ohio, Harriet P. D., 8, b. Ohio and Thomas Douglass, 3(5?)4, b. ca 1826 (1806) in New York.

Civil War: Source: United States Civil War Soldiers Index, 1861-1865 via Family Search .org: Arad J. Douglass, aka A. J. Douglass, Military Service, Rank: First Lieutenant (Beginning & Final), Military Side: Union, State: Ohio, Military Unit: 71st Regiment, Ohio Infantry, Military Company, Affiliate Film Number = 28.

In 1870 US Census, on 6 July in Erie Twp, Nevada, Kansas, post office Erie, find Maila R. Douglass, 39, b. Ohio, dress maker, with Frank, 19, b. Ohio, clerk in store.

Also in the 1870 Census, Thos (Thomas) Douglas, age 64, b. ca 1806, b. New York, is a carpenter, living in College Twp, Knox Co., Ohio and Gambier is it's main village.

[Y-DNA testing of Ray W. Andrews' descendants shows a very close match to a Douglass! Is it possible that the Douglass clan in Knox County, into which Maila/Marla Andrews married, is the birth clan of Ray W. in ca 1825/1826.???]

Females: 1=0 thru 4(b. 1826-1830) (fits Sophia), 2=5 thru 9 (b. 1821-1825)(**fits Mary** & Jane),1=10 thru 14 (b.1816-1820)(fits Eliza), 2=15 thru 19 (b.1811-1815) (fits Maria & Angeline), x x 1=40 thru 49 (b. 1781-1790)(fits Rachel).

Ohio County Marriages has Mary Douglass m. 28 Oct 1852 to John Wright.

CHILD NOTES: aka Ray W Andrews Douglass

General: The presence of this likely twin, 1 boy and 1 girl, is based on the Y-DNA testing of Ray W. Andrews descendants, which matches other Douglass coming out of a William Douglass, b. 1610, living in New London Colony, Connecticut.

In the 1860 US Census (official date 1 Jun 1860), Ray W. Andrews is in Onarga, Iroquois, Illinois. He gave his age as 34. So, b. 1 Jun 1825 thru 31 May 1826. [Using 1825/6 for the purpose of record ordering.]

If Sophia Chase Douglass was a twin, her 1850 US Census age would support a birth range of **1 Jun 1826 thru 31 May 1827**. [Using 1826/7 for the purpose of record ordering.]

[Maybe not twins, born just one year apart, and so Rachel gave her baby boy to her 1st cousin Marie Fisher Andrews when her new baby girl, Sophia arrived?]

1850 (1 June official date) US Census (18 Sept 1850) in Harrison Township, Vigo, Indiana. William P. H., age 30 (1820), born New York, pork packer, with **Sophia C. Hamlin, age 23, (1 Jun 1826 - 31 May 1827), born Ohio**. Harrison Twp. is entirely contained in Terre Haute's city limits.

General: The source for Sophia is Family Search.org International Genealogical Index, IGI, a family tree database.

In the 1830 (1 June) US Census, Archibald is in Town of Worthington, Franklin County, Ohio. Males: x = 10 thru 14 (b.1816-1820), x = 220 thru 29 (b.1801-1810), x = 140 thru 49 (b.1781-1790). Females: 1=0 thru 4 (b. 1826-1830)(**fits Sophia**) [So birth 1 Jun 1825 to 31 May 1830.]

A birth year of 1825 is given for Sophia. For Ray W. Andrews, who's Y-DNA matches a Douglass, his birth is between 2 Aug 1825 to 1 Aug 1826. This based on census data and at one time Ray gave August as a birth month.

Thus, is it possible that mother Rachel Fisher gave birth to twins in 1825, and having so many children already, gave the boy to a relative, Maria Fisher, who was married to George H. Andrews. We don't know the marriage date for Maria and George.

Source for marriage and middle name: FamilySearch.org Ohio County Marriages database, with middle name initial C. Other Ancestry.com hints (North America, Family Histories) give Chase for middle name. And gives Pride for William P. Hamlin's middle name. Also gives Kansas as a place of death for Sophia.

Searching for husband, William Pride Hamlin. Via TREE on FamilySearch.org: William Pride Hamlin, b. 28 June 1820 in Lee, Oneida, New York. Have marriage as 23 Mar 1850 in Knox Co., Ohio.

1875 Kansas State Census: S. Hamlin in Harvey, Kansas. [Her?? No.]

Cannot find 1860, 70, etc census records for William and/or Sophia.
