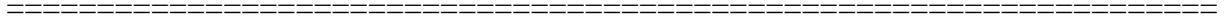

SUNBURY COUNTY

PARISH FORMATIONS

Sunbury County is another of the original counties formed when New Brunswick became a separate province. It retained the name once used for the bulk of what is now NB. It has about the same boundaries that it was given when first set off. There were four original parishes, with some lands left unassigned. Three more parishes were added later.

BURTON - included Blissville

LINCOLN - included Gladstone

SHEFFIELD - as at present, with only minor changes on the rear lines

MAUGERVILLE - extended onlu about 1/2 of the distance to the County line pre 1854

BLISSVILLE - set off in 1834 from Burton and Lincoln

NORTHFIELD - set off in 1857 from unassigned lands

GLADSTONE - set off from the part of Blissville that had been in Lincoln

MARRIAGE RECORDS FOR SUNBURY COUNTY

The government set of Registers for Sunbury County are missing. However a number of marriage records for the county found in various record sources make it possible to cover many time periods... they are by no means complete. Mrs. Elizabeth Sewell has published a book on these records. It is also wise to check both York and Queens County records as many residents were married in either county. Record sources are as follows:

SHEFFIELD RECORD BOOK - contains marriages for 1767 - 1835. There are also a few odd items recorded in this book, such as stray cattle found, etc.

MAUGERVILLE ANGLICAN CHURCH RECORDS - contains records for the time period of 1787 - 1803, and a few from 1847 - 1871. There are many marriages that may not have taken place in Sunbury County recorded in this record, as the rector travelled far up the Saint John River, and a few of his marriages are recorded in York County Marriage Register. It would be wise to look at York County records before determining where the marriage actually took place.

HUBBARD PAPERS - contain marriage licences and bonds for 1788 - 1826

MARRIAGE CERTIFICATES FOR SUNBURY COUNTY - contains marriage records for the years 1812 - 1837 & ---- - ----. These are copies of the certificates sent to the County Registrar for recording in the official resisters.

WESLEYAN METHODIST CHURCH - SHEFFIELD (UNITED) - contains records for 1835 to ----.

NEWSPAPERS OF THE PROVINCE - have marriages for many areas of NB

WARD BOOK - is a record made by Clarence Ward, in Saint John, of items from an NB newspaper. It is arranged alphabetically.

sworn before me this 10th day of September, 1795, Wm. Hubbard, Q.H.S. Isaac Hubbard, J.P.

(Note by CBB: The name Maugerville is spelt throughout without the u in the above item. Also, the term do means ditto, or the same as above.)

[R. P. Gorham made a note as follows about the next item.....

On the cover of the poll book are lists of names which appear to have been a voters list. Some of the names have a pen scratch through them.]

(Note by CBB: R.P. Gorham gives no indication which names were scratched out in the list.

There are some duplications from the foregoing list. If it were these names it might indicate that the following people owned land in Sunbury County, but were residents of other areas. ??? The first list were names of actual voters, and who they voted for (no secret vote).)

Among the other papers I mentioned for the foregoing group are individual listings of taxes due by those in the Upper, Lower and Middle Districts of the Parish of Burton, plus the township of Maugerville. Items apparently taxed in the latter place are listed as: Meadow land, Plow land, Pasture land, Horses, Oxen, Cows, 3 year old cattle and Sheep. There are lists for the years 1811 and 1812.
