

Chapter 20 Redding Eubanks 1801 -

Redding (Redmond) Eubanks (1801 – after 1870) appears in the 1850 Jones County census in the Pollocksville District with his wife, **Rachel** (1811- after 1880), and 9 children.¹ Sometime before 1860 he moved to Craven County and appears in the 1860 Craven census in Richardson's District (now the 8th Township).² A cooper and turpentine maker by trade, he lived in the area south of Clarks, NC, on SR 1225. He last appears in the 1870 Craven census in the 8th Township³ and Redding and wife Rachel are believed to be buried in the family burying ground off SR1225 in Clarks, now long abandoned, un marked, and unsurveyed.

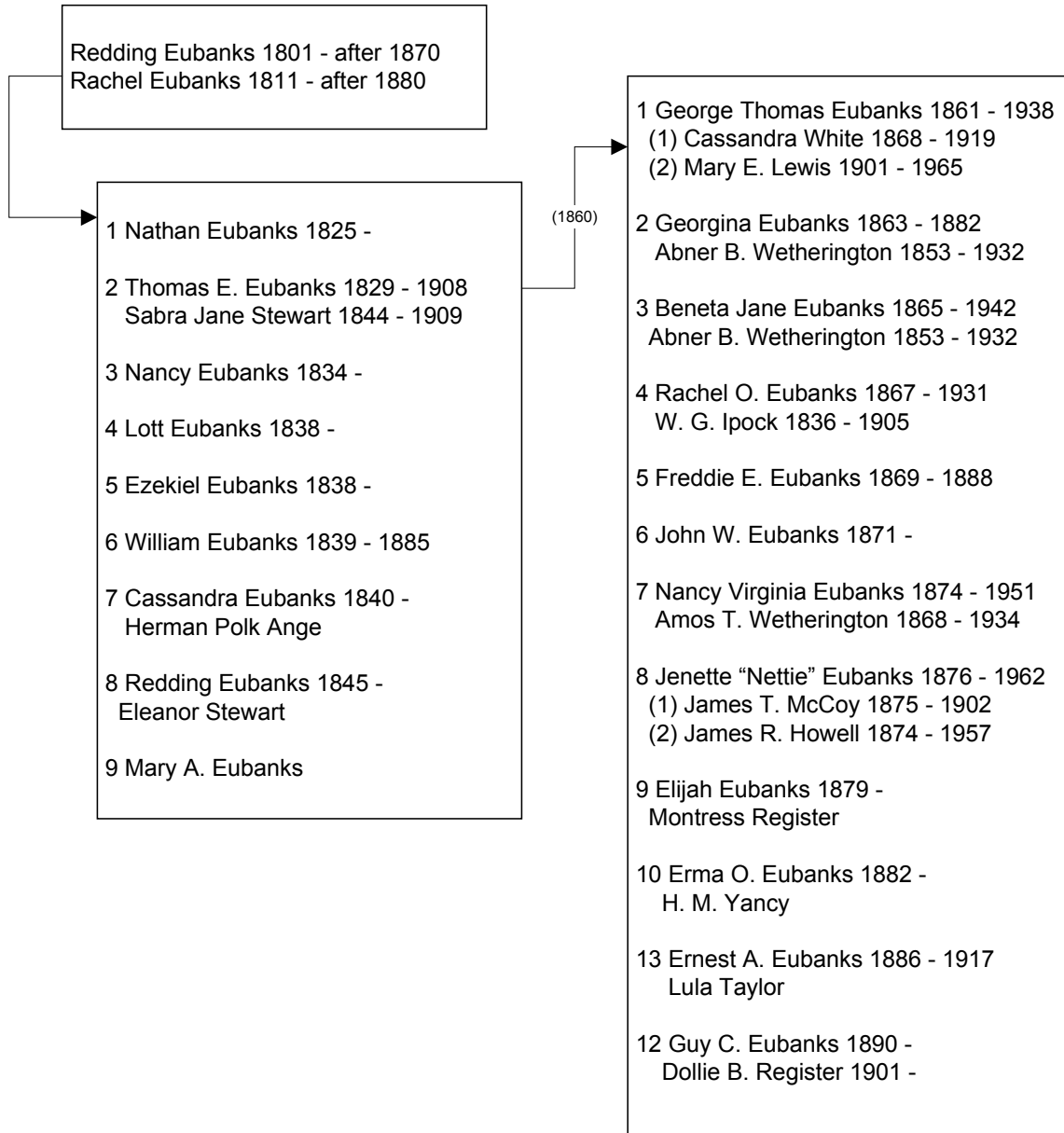


Figure 45 Redding Eubanks Family Tree
