1. **George MAINS**^{1,2,3} was born on 12 May 1748 in Pittsburg Co., PA.^{1,3,4} County came from Pension Record. He served in the military in 1777 in Fayette Co PA.¹ His tax was paid in 1783 in Springhill Township, Westmoreland Co., PA² His tax was paid in 1785/86 in George's Township, Fayette Co PA² This also lists Philip, Henry, John and Robert MAINS. He appeared in the census in 1790 in George's Township, Fayette Co PA.⁵ There were four males under 16 years and 3 females. He lived near Locus Creek in Bracken Co., KY on 1 Mar 1802.⁶ Records of Bracken Co, KY show Philip Buckner and Taby, his wife conveyed 100 acres of land on Locust Creek to George Mains, March 1, 1802. Between 1802 and 1830 he was a Cooper in Bracken Co, Ky. He appeared in the census in 1810 in Bracken Co., KY.⁷ There are 2 males 10-16, 1 Male 16-26, 1 male 45 and up. The said soldier served in the capacity of a private soldier in the Virginia Line. He was aged 84 years and died on 11-9-1833. He applied for his pension from the County of Bracken in the State of Kentucky on the date of August 6 of the year 1817 while he was at the age of 70 years. He was placed on the pension rolls on 11-16-1828 and his pension really began on 12-16-1828.

The said George Maines also stated that he had been born in the County of Pittsburg in the State of Pennsylvania on May 12 of the 1748 He also stated and swore that he had enlisted in the County of Fayette in the state of Pennsylvania in the year 1777.

The said George Maines also stated that his children were named as fellows: He had one daughter, an invalid since her birth, and he did not give her name.

Before me this subscriber primary Justice of Peace for said county, this day an open court personally appeared George Mains a citizen of Bracken County aged seventy years and being sworn makes the following statement in order to obtain the benefit of the act of the late congress entitled "an act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and naval services of the United States in the Revolutary War. That the said George Mains, enlisted in the year 1777 in the County of Fayette State of Pennsylvania in the company commissioned by Capt Henry Heathof Winchester, Viriginia for the term of three years, that he continued to serve in the 8th,9th, and 13th Regiments a part of the time under Col. Gibson but in which of those Regiments he enlisted originally he cannot now tell, that he was under the command of Gen'l. Hand and Gen'l Broadhead that while under the command of Gen'l Hand he went with a detachment of the Indians at Coyahagan that he was finally discharged in the 1780 in Pittsburgh after serving three years fourteen days-. that he was in siderel circumstances, stands in the need of assistance of his country for a support, and that he never has received any pension from the United States - Sworn to before me this 6th August 1818.

George Maines produced in court a declaration in conformity to the act of congress in that case made and provided and sworn to the same in court which it ordered to be filed It is ordered to be certified to the Secretary of War that this court it

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satisfied from evidence of Phillip Main, sworn in open court that the said George Mains is possessed of no property, other than that contained in said declaration and that is the same is of the value of One Hundred and seven dollars eighty seven and a half cents'

On this 14th day of January 1822 personally appeared in open court, (being a court of record for the County aforesaid expressly made by the laws of the State which created it and having the power of fine and imprisonment) George Mains aged seventy three years who being first duly sworn according to law doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the provision made by the acts of Congress of the 18th March 1818 and the 1st May 1820. that he the said George Mains enlisted for the term of three years in the month of April in the year 1777 in Fayette County in the State of Pennsylvania in the company commanded by Capt. Henry Heath of the Regiment commanded by Col. George Gibson being to the best of his recollection the 10th Regiment in the line of the State of Virginia on the Continental establishment that he continue to serve in the said corps or in the service of the United States for three years and fourteen days when in the Spring of 1780, he was discharged from the said service in Pittsburgh in the State of Pennsylvania that he was in the Battle of Big Beaver and several skirmishes and that he has no other evidence in his power of his said services except the testimony of Peter Garfield and James McGill under date 20 July 1821 and attached to his original declaration of the 6 Aug. 1818, And in pursuance of the act of the 1st of May 1820 I do solemnly swear that I was a resident citizen of the United States on the 18th day of March 1818. And that I have not Since that time by gift, sale or in any manner disposed of my property or any part thereof with intent thereby, so to diminish it as to bring myself within this provision of an act of Congress entitle to. An Act to provide for certain person engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the Revolutionary War. passed on the 18th day of March 1818, and that I have not nor has any person in trust for me any property or securities contacts or debts due to me nor have I any income other than what it contained in the schedule hereto annexed and by me subscribed.

He signed a will on 20 May 1830 in Bracken Co., KY.^{2,10} Deeds conveying the 100 acres and 20 acres on Locust & Willow Creeks are signed by George Mains and Alse, his wife; Abraham Thorp and Mary, his wife; Mark Weatherington and Elizabeth, his wife; James Wood and Catherine, his wife; Peter Mains and Elizabeth, his wife; Philip Mains, and Mary, his wife; Jacob Mains and Sarah, his wife; and Levi Mains and Rachel, his wife.

He appeared in the census in 1830 in Bracken Co., KY.¹¹ He died on 19 Nov 1833 in Bracken Co., KY. He had his estate probated in Dec 1833 in Bracken Co, Ky.² American Revolutionary Soldier Pension File S. 36080 filed claim in 1818 and 1822 and states he is 73 years: Also the record says 8 children and one mentally unbalanced daughter. George Mains is on the Georges Township Fayette Co PA Tax List 1785 & 1786; According to Peter Mains obit, they came to KY 1792 at Augusta KY on the Ohio River.

George MAINS and Mary VANE were married on 4 Jan 1771 in Sussex Co., NJ.^{2,4} The marriage bond (M 362) filed in the office of the Secretary of State, was signed by George Mains & Philip Hoffman, of Newton, and witness by John Van Tuyl and Thomas Andrews. He died on 11 Jul 1871 in Stepstone, Bracken Co KY.² He died at the home of his son, Joseph, at Stepstone, in Pendleton Co, KY and was buried by the side of his first wife in Wesley Chapel Cemetery, where

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there graves are marked by Stones. His on 16 Jul 1871 in Stepstone, Bracken Co KY² "The following appeared in a local publication at the time of his death:

Peter Mains was born in eastern Pennsylvania, Feb. 26 1785. His parents moved to Kentucky in 1792 and settled in Bracken County. where Augusta now stands. With limited educational opportunities Peter grew to manhood possessing a well developed body and a mind that could have pursued books to advantage. He was married June 19, 1806, to Elizabeth Wood, a Christian woman with whom he lived happily to the day of her death, March 23, 1853. All of his children, seven sons and four daughters, lived to be grown. Four of them have died well. The remaining seven are professors of religion.

In his thirtieth year Peter Mains united with the Methodist Episcopal Church at Doran's Meeting House, now Mt. Zion, four miles back of Augusta, having previously obtained a clear evidence of the pardon of his sins. He was soon made class leaders and served the church well in that capacity. In 1824 he was licensed to exhort (to make urgent appeal); received license to preach in 1826; was elected to local deacons order in 1834 by the Kentucky Conference and ordered to Mt. Sterling by Bishop Soule.

When a growing pro-slavery spirit drifted the Kentucky Annual Conference into the Methodist Episcopal Church, South, Brother Mains with Doctor Tomlinson and others remained faithful to , and continued in, the Methodist Episcopal Church: hence with his brethren on the now historic border he bore responsibilities and suffered persecution.

In Covington in 1853, at the first session of the present Kentucky Conference of the Methodist Episcopal Church, Bishop James presiding, he was elected local elder and ordained. In 1854, Brother Mains married Mrs. Emily Sowerby and soon after removed from his farm to the city of Covinton. When Main Street charge was organied, he and his wife became, and continued, members therof until death released them. She died May 13, 1870, and he followed July 11, 1871. A few weeks before his death he went from the house of his son John, where he made his home, to Pendleton County, to visit his children, after reaching there, he preached twice with fair strength and acceptability to the to the people.

He was sick one week; was able to talk but little but was peaceful and happy. He died in Pendleton, amooong his children and grandchildren and close by the graveyard where he first wife was laid to rest. The old veteran of eighty-six summers having lead a useful and happy life, now sleeps by the companion of his youth, but their spirits are in the sun-bright clime. (Signed) W. H. Black." He was buried in Wesley Chapel, Mentor, Campbell Co., KY. He lived in Bracken Co., KY.
