It also contains some of the deeds--both transcriptions and images from the respective deed books. Also, sundry plat maps, etc.

Deed. Andrew Biddle & wife to Frederick Miller.

This Indenture made this **seventh day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & six** Between **Andrew Biddle of Woodberry in the county of Huntingdon & Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and Christiana his wife of the one part**, and Frederick Miller of the township, county, and Commonwealth afsd of the other part.

Witnefseth whereas there was granted out of the land office of Pennsylvania a warrant unto Elizabeth Williams for four hundred acres of land situate in Woodberry township in the county ____ afsd about two miles form the mouth of Clover Creek lying on both sides of said creek: dated the seventh day of March A.D. 1785 And Whereas the said Elizabeth Williams together wither husband John Williams of the county of Huntingdon Esquire by their Deed Poll dated the 10th day of November A. D. 1786 for the considerations therein mentioned conveyed all their right & title in and to the warrant afsd unto Isaac Morrel? Who by his attorney Nathaniel Garrard by a deed ob conveyance duly executed bearing date the 21st day of December AD 1789 conveyed all the right and title of the said Isaac Morrel?
