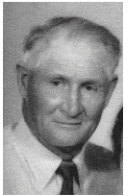

Source (2002): Leonard Ruel Olp, son of Charles Samuel Olp and Grace Vivian Viles.

My great uncle Bill (William Olp, b: 1833, married to Vienna Mesico) is listed as a merchant in the 1870 census and my grandfather, Herman Olp (born 1845), as a clerk. My great uncle Bill owned the Prairie City Mercantile. Both uncle Bill and my grandfather left the business, under what circumstances we don't know, and homesteaded ranches near Prairie City. My father (Charles Samuel Olp (b: 1888) and many of his children were born on that ranch. The family was forced to sell the ranch in 1933 to pay debts due to the effects of the Great Depression. George Hall, who married Ruth Olp (b: 1890), owned a ranch just below the Olp's, bought the Olp homestead. Again, unfortunately, George sold the ranch before his death in 1966, but not to a descendant of Herman Olp. After the ranch was sold, Charles Samuel Olp became a laborer in a saw mill.

Source (2002) : Leonard Ruel Olp

Story of how Charles Olp and Grace Viles met. "Charles was born on the ranch at Prairie City and graduated from high school there. Grace Viles' father was first a dry land farmer in the Horse Heaven Hills near Prosser, Washington. An infestation of grasshoppers wiped him out. He tried building in and around Prosser with some success. My mother's father, Clement Viles, met Effie M. Van Eaton there and they were married in Yakima, Washington on July 27, 1892. How they met, I don't know. But Clement Viles got the gold bug and moved to Prairie City during the gold rush days. He opened a mine that was singularly unsuccessful. Grace Viles attended high school, and graduated, from Prairie City High School. We have high school pictures and class pictures, of both Charles and Grace. Grace insisted that she graduate from high school before they marry. A cute side-note. When Judd and I were boys we were poking around some old bluffs that contain Indian paintings. We came across the initials C.O. + G.V. That custom is really quite old."

Source: Gene Olp:

In regard to my name. That is quite a story. I, like most of the kids in our family, was born at home, mother being attended by a visiting country doctor. Mother named me Eugene Franklin, after her uncle Gene and her brother Frank. The attending doctor felt that that name was not sufficiently euphonic, so he put Francis Eugene on the birth certificate, so that is my "official" name with which I do business, while I normally go by Gene or Eugene, depending on how formal I think I should be."

Source: Leonard Ruel Olp, 12/2002, regarding his relationship with Eugene (Gene) and family:

"Gene retired about 10 yrs (approx. 1992) ago as supervisor for the Klamath County Juvenile Dept. Most recently he has been teaching Spanish in a private school. But due to some recent health problems, he had to give that up. "

"I (Leonard) lived with him and his family some as a teen-ager. He lives in cattle ranch country and was pastoring a country church about 30 miles east of Klamath Falls when I was a teen. I went over to his place and worked on a ranch when I was sixteen. Out of that I think we developed some strong bonds that I have really enjoyed. He's been having some difficult health problems and finally had to give up teaching. After retiring he took a part-time teaching position in a Christian school teaching Spanish. Now I think he is really retiring. The doctors really never figured out what the cause of his problems were, but he was so dizzy he was seasick and had double vision. He has recovered to a great extent, but still experiences some relapses.

Source: 12/2002 email from Leonard Ruel Olp to Sandra Ballenthin Van Erp:

"Mary is our church secretary and I am a part-time staff pastor. After retiring from teaching in a Christian school, I was invited to join our staff. Mary and I have had both pastoral and mission's experience in our past. Part-time in a church doesn't mean you work part-time, it means you get part-time pay and benefits, but I'm not complaining. I am thoroughly loving what I am doing."

"I lived with Judd's (Julius Olp) family some as a kid also, so we have been quite close. In fact, when we were in 8th grade together, I pointed Nancy o(Olp) ut to Judd. He was smart enough to take good advice. "

"All three of my older brothers pastored at one point or another, and my sister Ruth's husband is a retired Assembly of God minister. The brother just older than me, Everett, served as a pastor or evangelist for 35 years before retiring. He's now building houses in Phoenix -- at 71 years of age! "

Source: 12/21/02 email from Leonard Ruel Olp to Sandra Ballenthin Van Erp:

"When the ranch was sold in 1933, my dad and his older brother Robert, along with my oldest brother Paul, herded the cattle to Payette, Idaho. There they attempted to start over again. But the financial situation in the Great Depression simply led to another failure. A couple of years ago I drove to Boise and had my sister take me to all the places where my family had lived in Western Idaho. The folks were living in Payette when I was born in Ontario, OR. Ontario had the closest medical facilities."

Military Service from Leonard to Sandra Van Erp May, 2008: I entered the U.S. Navy October 24, 1954 and received an honorable discharge having received the rank of E-5 on August 24, 1958. Technically I qualify as a Korean War Veteran simply because I went in before the ink was dry on all the papers that stopped the shooting. I have received an invitation to join the Veteran's of Foreign Wars organization but didn't follow through.
