2. <u>Martin Friedrich² Strege</u> (Martin¹)¹ was born Abt. 6-28-1766 in Prob. Kreis Usedom-Wollin, Pommern, Germany², and died 11-25-1835 in Leussin, Usedom-Wollin, Pommern, Germany².

He married (1) <u>Regina Maria Kohlat</u> bef. 1805 in Prob. Colzow, Kreis Usedom-Wollin, Pommern, Germany, daughter of Kohlat and Unknown. Her birth date and location are unknown, She died bef. 11-25-1835 in probably Chinnow or Leussin, Kreis Usedom-Wollin.

Martin remarried to (2) <u>Regina Maria Mahron</u>. According to the baptism records, the Mahron family and the Strege family were close being baptism sponsors to each other's children. Regina was born abt. 1769 in probably kreis of Usedom-Wollin or Cammin. The families were very near the borders of the two kreis. Other records indicate more Strege and Kohlat family members in kreis Cammin villages. Regina died 12-21-1829 in Leussin, Usedom-Wollin, Pommern, Germany.

Notes for Friederike Dorothea Charlotte Strege:

Born in Chinnow, Kreis Usedom-Wollin, Pommern and baptized there. Baptism sponsors: She had 3, all from Chinnow. The names need translation, but include <u>Dorothea Louisa</u> <u>Richmann, Christian Friedrich Mahron, and one other.</u> (Source: LDS film 1273039, item 3)

Confirmed in Colzow (sp. Kolzow) in 1822. Emigrated with husband and family May-Sept., 1849. Lived 5 yrs. in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, moving to Cooperstown Township., Manitowoc Co., Wisconsin as a member of St. John's Lutheran Church and is buried with her husband in their cemetary located south of the church, on the south side of the Village of Maribel on County Trunk A. Earliest gravestone is 1859.

He married <u>Johanna Sophia Olp</u> 11-13-1818 probaby in the Kolzow church as that is where these events were recorded. Johanna Sophia was the daughter of <u>Samuel Olpe</u>. A non-translateable german word in the entry seems to indicate she was a foster daughter from a previous marriage of his wife, but took the Olpe surname as was custom. Johanna Sophia was born abt. 5-30-1774, and died 1-27-1823 in Leussin, Usedom-Wollin, Pommern, Germany. Military service: Iron Cross, 2nd class Occupation: 1-15-1850, Mühlenmeister from Leussin

 i. <u>Caroline Wilhelmine Adophine³ Olp</u>, a foster child to Michael, indicating Johanna was marred before Michael Strege. Caroline married <u>August Friedrich David Volbrecht</u> 1-15-1850 in prob. Colzow, Kreis Usedom-Wollin, Pommern, Germany.
