leave since Augt. 17th. - July & Augt. 1862, present. - Sept. & Oct.

1862, private, absent without leave, fined \$12. by St. Ct. Dayton. -

Nov. & Dec. 1862, absent without leave & dropped from rolls. -

Subsequent rolls, to June 30/63, name not borne. - July & Augt.

1863, absent, deserted, to be charged \$9.50 per transportation from

Albany to New York. - Sept. & Oct. 1863, same report. - Muster out

roll dated Augt. 30/65 reports him, deserted Oct. 22. 1862.

The records of this office furnish no evidence of alleged

murder in arms, Mch. 1862, nor of capture and

discharge, July 1862. Morning report book

given to Sept. 1864 (see report register (regt)) not on file.
