DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

On this 9th day of June, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and eleven, personally appeared before me, a Notary Public, within and for the county and State aforesaid, Nelson P. Dolbeck, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 73 years of age, and a resident of Ticonderoga county of Essex, State of New York; and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED as the 30th day of June under the name of Nelson P. Dolbeck, on the 30th day of June, 1861, as a Private, in Co. B. 62 New York Infantry (Here state rank, and company and regiment in the Army, or vessels if in the Navy.)

in the service of the United States, in the Civil war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at New York City (State name of war, Civil or Mexican.) on the 19 day of May, 1865. That he also served (Here give a complete statement of all other services, if any.)

That he was not employed in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above. That his personal description at enlistment was as follows: Height, 5 feet 7 inches; complexion, light; color of eyes, grey; color of hair, dark; that his occupation was Farmer; that he was born Apr 30th, 1836, at Franklin Vermont.

That his several places of residence since leaving the service have been as follows: (State date of each change, as nearly as possible.)

That he is _____ a pensioner. That he has _____ heretofore applied for pension 660987 (If a pensioner, the certificate number only need be given. If not, give the number of the former application, if one was made.)

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the act of February 6, 1907.

That his post-office address is Ticonderoga, county of Essex, State of New York.

Dolbeck, the claimant, sign his name (or make his mark) to the foregoing declaration; that they have every reason to believe, from the appearance of the claimant and their acquaintance with him of 9 years and 20 years, respectively, that he is the identical person he represents himself to be, and that they have no interest in the prosecution of this claim.
