- <u>PURPOSE</u>: The Hawkins Family Organization began in 1985. It is conducted by mail and has no scheduled meetings. We want to promote genealogical research on Hawkins families and related lines; to promote and share family history; and to strengthen extended family ties.

- QUERIES: Members are also encouraged to send queries to the editor. Send enough to cover your questions. Please include siblings whenever possible.
- MEMBERS AND SUBSCRIPTIONS: We began HAWKINS HERITAGE with the hope of identifying the parents of James and Margaret? Hawkins, b. c1765 and 1768, probably in Virginia. Taxation records show that they lived in Stafford CO Virginia from 1793 until 1825, when they migrated to Clark CO Kentucky. One son, John R., married into the Hawkins/Bourne line, which may be a connecting branch of the above James. Because of an apparent need for group research, our publication is now open to descendants of all Hawkins lines.

Individual membership and subscription is \$12 per year. Contributing Membership and subscription is \$20 per year (may vote.)

Subscriptions begin with the April issue. Subscribers during the membership year may receive back issues of the current year or begin with the next year and pay for and single back issues, which are \$4 each. The 1st issue: December 1986; 2nd, April 1987; then three issues per year beginning April 1988 to current.

PEDIGREE SERVICE: You are welcome to send your Hawkins pedigree chart to be checked with our collection. You will be given any additional information which we might have on file, that would match up with your own. Your chart will be filed for possible future contact. #### Research Notes

Mic Barnett writes an interesting column, "Your Family Tree," in the Houston Chronicle. In the July 29, 2000 issue, he reports of a project begun by the USGENWEB. They call it the "USGENWEB Tombstone Transcription Project."

It is an attempt to publish on the Internet the inscription of gravemarkers from all over the United States. The organization is hoping for volunteers to visit cemeteries near their home and transcribe the inscriptions, then publish them on the project's website.

A site exists for every state. They have a list of cemeteries with hyperlinks in each county that has transcribed cemeteries. After clicking on the hyperlink, names, dates, etc. that have been transcribed by the volunteer will appear.

Note: This is one great project, so if you have access to the Internet, you may want to look forward to it.

In the November 2000 issue, Mr. Barnett gives information concerning the Cherokee culture. This course, offered by the Cherokee Cultural Society was offered last

December. I mention it because if you are from Cherokee lineage, other towns or cities may present the same. It was taught by Cherokee Nation certified teachers.

In one of Mr. Barnett's columns, he lists The BCG Genealogical Standard Manual Millennium Edition, designed to clarify, edify, and organize the generally accepted uniform standards of genealogy. It is organized in four sections: From standards for writers, researchers, and teachers, as well as furthering skill development, to a subject index to the text.

Mr. Barnett says the Standards Manual should be "read and re-read by researchers wishing to conduct accurate, reliable and credible genealogical research."

Incidentally, if you do have Cherokee ancestry, you might be interested in the book by Devon Mihesuah:

Cultivating the Rosebuds: The Education of Women at the Cherokee Female Seminary, 1851-1909. Another of her books, American Indians: Stereotypes & Realities is in its 5<sup>th</sup> printing. Dr. Mihesuah's The Roads of My Relations gives a strong sense of Choctaw culture from the Indians' removal from Mississippi to Indian Territory. This book just won the Oklahoma Writers Federation's award for "Best Fiction Book of 2001." If you have Indian heritage, you might like to check out her website: http://jan.ucc.nau.edu/~mihesuah

#### Query #1

I am attempting to confirm the ancestors and descendants of John HAWKINS, b. 1806 in Person. Co. NC, d. after 1850. He is believed to have first married Jane (Jennie) BURCH (Jan 24, 1827, some indicate she was 2<sup>nd</sup> wife July 24, 1848), secondly to Mary L. LIPSCOMB (Nov. 18, 1835), and thirdly Elizabeth L. MORTON (Aug. 9, 1859). He is believed to have had the following children: (William) Calvin HAWKINS, b. Dec. 6, 1827 and Elizabeth Catherine HAWKINS, b. 1840. Several researchers and sources have conflicting data and I'm trying to solidify this weak link in my family tree. I'm willing to share information that I have collected.

#### Query #2

Ephraim HAWKINS, Sr. Was born in Baltimore County, Md., July 8, 1761 and at "an early period" moved to Orange Co., North Carolina. He married Nancy Ann FARMER on May 1, 1788 in Caswell Co. NC. (a portion of Orange Co. was subdivided into Caswell Co. and later into Person Co.) Ephraim served in the Revolutionary War. Circumstantial information indicates that Ephraim had 2 brothers, John and Joshua, and that they were the children of William HAWKINS b. Jan. 20, 1726 and Mary WOODS b. September 23, 1720 and appear to have married by 1749 when mentioned in her brother's will. Would like to know why they moved to NC. I am seeking information on this family's descendants and ancestors. I'm willing to share information that I have collected.
