Dear Hawkins Cousins,

When I look back to our first *Hawkins Heritage* issue, compiled by Kathleen Briglio, a Texan in Canada, I find it difficult to believe this many years have passed.

Five Hawkins descendants who had never met, but discovered each other through correspondence, formed a round-robin letter. These cousins were Kathleen, Joan George, Helen Markwell, Gail Hawkins, and Olyve. Edna Colgan of Flemingsburg, KY, also actively contributed, although she did not have Hawkins lineage herself. Joan, Gail, and I are the remaining members of the original group. I've had the pleasure of later meeting Kathleen and Gail.

Our major goal in Hawkins research was, and still is, to prove the lineage of James Hawkins, b. ca. 1765 and died 23-7-1834 in Fleming CO KY, and his wife Margaret (surname?) b. ca. 1769 and died 1-4-1838 in Fleming CO. Preponderance of evidence shows James' parents to have been William Hawkins and Elizabeth Bourne, but only that. And without proof. . . .

The round-robin letters became so long, we decided one person would be "collector" of information, compile it, and mail it to the others. Kathleen volunteered, editing the first three issues. After many inquiries, we opened it to all Hawkins branches. As noted in each issue, we stipulated we'd continue, providing subscribers would send in their queries, lineage, and even Hawkins notes that were not necessarily of their respective lines. I think we all accumulate information at the library, not knowing for sure until later if they do or don't connect with our ancestors.

Because of health problems, Kathleen asked your current editor to continue until she regained her health. Unfortunately, she passed away, much too young, a few years ago. According to long-time member and contributor, Wanita Lucas, Kathleen's research papers are in the Fort Wayne Library.

Eighteen years is a long time, and during that period, we have gained and lost members. I know for sure that some of our subscribers found what they needed from our publication. Hawkins isn't the only surname out there, although sometimes it seems like it! The Internet offers so many Hawkins websites, that the need for hard copy has lessened. If you don't work with a home computer, librarians will be glad to assist you.

I would like to dedicate this last issue to Kathleen Briglio, and to former members and cousins, including Nancy Buell, Charles O. Austin, Tom J. Abbott, Jr., Billie H. Mills, Leland Hawkins and to other former members who have perhaps found their ancestors through a Higher Power.

This publication required the help of many, and I am grateful for your contributions. I appreciate the friends I have come to know through *Hawkins Heritage*. A giant thanks to Joan George, membership chairman and treasurer. We will continue our search, as I hope you will continue with yours. Bright Blessings for 2005 and for all the days and years to follow.

## **Wilbert Ashley Hawkins**

### ***The Trek to Georgia***

It seems that people moved a great deal in the early days of our country. Perhaps it was to better their lot – perhaps it was to see “what was on the other side of the mountain.” Perhaps it was to make that fortune that so many were searching for. At any rate, the Hawkins men moved about as much as did their families. William Eaton was born in South Carolina in 1794 and died in Missouri in 1851. Of his eleven sons, at least six moved from Greenville SC to Phelps County, MO.

The third son of William Eaton was named Wilbert Ashley. He was a Baptist preacher and a teacher or “professor.” He married Amanda Melvina Mayne. Her father ran a wagon and buggy shop where you could “buy a new buggy or repair your old one.” He also made coffins, the average price being about \$5.00 for adult size down to small for \$.75 for small lined. Wilbert and Amanda had a daughter named Elizabeth Millicent, called “Lizzie,” and a son, Robert Duncan. When Robert was four months old, his mother called for her children. She laid Robert on her breast, gathered Lizzie in her arms, and told them goodbye—she died at the age of 20. Wilbert Ashley left his children in the care of his parents-in-law (in Hall CO GA) and returned to his father’s home in Missouri.

At the age of 33, Wilbert Ashley married Martha Ellen Hooker, whose family lived in the vicinity of Phelps County, MO. They had 6 children—3 boys and 3 girls. Happiness was not theirs to keep. Martha Ellen died on September 11, 1866. She is buried in the St. James Cemetery, St. James, MO.

On Christmas Day, 1866, Wilbert Ashley married Martha’s widowed sister, Christina Caroline Hardy. She brought to the family 2 children and combined with Wilbert Ashley’s, there was a house full of children.

His health had never been good, and he decided to return to Georgia. All the children except the eldest, Amanda Alice, agreed to go back with their father. Amanda was married, had a little boy, and she wanted to stay in Missouri.

Some time during the years 1873 or 1874, the family made the move. Accompanying Wilbert Ashley were his third wife, Christina Caroline, 5 children of Martha Ellen’s, 2 children of Christina Caroline by her first husband, and 3 children of Wilbert Ashley and Christina Caroline, ranging in age from 2 to 17 years. And Christina was very pregnant.

Wilbert Ashley died on July 15, 1874. One month to the day, August 15, 1874, Christina gave birth to a little girl. She named her Wilbert Ellen.

### **Gravestone for Wilbert Ashley Hawkins**

The Methodist Church stood at the corner of Broad Street and Bradford Street, just off the square. Farmers came to Gainesville from all around the countryside to do their trading. The headstones of the Methodist Church Cemetery made excellent hitching posts for the horses, mules, and wagons while the farmers were taking care of their business. As time went by, tombstones were knocked down, broken, and misplaced, or put at the wrong gravesites.

A bad situation became worse, and it was decided to move the cemetery. Families were notified. Citizens made arrangements to transfer the graves to the Alta Vista Cemetery on the south side of Gainesville. As the deadline approached, a sense of panic set in. Not everyone had been able to identify the site of all the graves. Confusion ruled the day, and the project of moving the graves came to a halt. Construction began on the new City Hall, and a wonderful building was completed, along with the adjacent Federal Building.

John Wilbert Hawkins, the next to eldest son of Wilbert Ashley, was especially distraught over the mix-up. As head of the family, he felt that he had not done a satisfactory job. But he did all he could do.

The tornado of 1936 destroyed the church, City Hall, and Federal Building, as well as most of the records housed therein. President Franklin Roosevelt came by train to speak to the citizens of Gainesville, encouraging them to continue to rebuild their city. As a consequence, the business area of Gainesville is lovely today, and the complex of the City Hall and the Federal Building and grounds are beautiful. Wilbert Ashley Hawkins can rest assured that he has the grandest headstone of them all—he is buried beneath City Hall.

**NOTE:** After writing this vignette, I talked with the manager of Alta Vista Cemetery. He said he had never heard of a church just across from the square. That may have something to do with the fact no one knows for sure where Wilbert Ashley Hawkins is buried. He will let me know. He said, "We may have to rewrite history." ~ Bolyne

### **Whence – Christina Caroline Hooker Hawkins**

As a child, I was fascinated by the way my grandfather, John Wilbert Hawkins, could rattle off the name of that lady. When I asked him about her, he would give me a short non-committal answer, and I learned nothing really. Much later, I learned she was beloved by all who came into contact with her. She started out with several strikes against her, but she persevered—and how!

She was born to Benjamin and Martha (Clemmons) Hooker. Thus, she began life as CHRISTINA CAROLINE HOOKER.

She had a sister five years older, who was married to Wilbert Ashley Hawkins. That sister, Martha Ellen, died when she was about 31 years old, leaving 6 children. Tina, as she was called by her friends and family, had married Daniel Hardy, who was killed in a hunting accident. There were 2 Hardy children out of this marriage. Their mother was known as CHRISTINA CAROLINE HOOKER HARDY.

After Ellen's death, the widow Christina married the widowed Wilbert Ashley Hawkins, and her name now was CHRISTINA CAROLINE HOOKER HARDY HAWKINS.

NOTE: A great-granddaughter in the family wrote a history of her ancestors, which included information on the Hooker and Hawkins families. She spelled her grandmother's name as CHRISTINA. I reasoned that, since she knew Christina better than some of the rest of us, that she is probably right in the spelling of Mrs. Hawkins' name.

## Century Old Table and Hymnbook Owned by Earlington Man; Table Made in Penitentiary in 1812

Retired Miner, 75, Still Acts as Mine Guard on Pay Days; Has Looked After Invalid Wife for Four Years; Gallant and Tender Toward Her as Young Swain

Earlington, Ky., Jan. 18.—(Special) P. E. HAWKINS, 75-year-old retired miner who even now works as a special guard for the West Kentucky Coal company on pay days, takes great pride in two possessions older than he is—a hymnbook published in 1813 and a little table made in 1812.

The hymnbook has been in the Hawkins family more than a century. It is a small book although it contains 550 pages, closely packed with hymns and psalms of generations ago. Many of the songs, however, are still in use. The book is yellow with age.

On the flyleaf is the following:

"A selection of hymns from various authors. Designed as a Supplement to the Methodist Hymnbook. Compiled under the direction of Bishop Astbury and published by order of the general conference. (Then follows the quotation from Colossians 3:16) Published by Dave Hitt and Thomas Ware for the Methodist Connection in the U. S. A. J. C. Totten, Printer. 1813."

### USED BY GREAT-GRANDMOTHER

The book was the property of Hawkins' maternal great-grandmother, Mrs. Rebecca Ashby of near Ashbyburg, and was used by her at New Salem Methodist church when she was a girl.

The other interesting possession of Hawkins is the piece of furniture made in the Frankfort penitentiary in 1812 and bought by his paternal grandfather, Benjamin Franklin Hawkins of Woodford county. It was brought here by David M. K. Hawkins, father of P. E. Hawkins, in the 40's.

The table is about two and a half feet square and on it rests a little chest of drawers which looks like a miniature old-fashioned bureau with a mirror set in the top. Its beauty is marred by many coats of varnish which Hawkins plans to remove. He is uncertain about its use but thinks

it probably was intended for a shaving stand.

### CARES FOR INVALID WIFE

Dear Madam:

The records of this office show that Samuel Hawkins served in the U.S. Mounted Volunteers, and was disabled while in the service.

He was allowed pension from February 4, 1814, while a resident of Fairfield County, Ohio, on account of disability, the nature of which was not stated.

Samuel Hawkins died July 2, 1814 in Eaton, Preble County, Ohio. His age, place of birth and residence prior to 1814 are not stated.

Samuel Hawkins left surviving him, his first, second, third, fourth and youngest sons, as follows: Joseph Campbell Hawkins, who was Clerk of the Court of Preble County, Ohio, in 1824; John Jones Hawkins; Benjamin Worthington Hawkins; Samuel Hawkins, under twenty-one years of age; and Byrd or Bird Hawkins, also under twenty-one years of age. A grandson, Samuel Hawkins Smith, under sixteen years of age, also survived the soldier.

The name of soldier's wife is not given, nor are the names of his parents shown. It is not stated that he served during the War of the Revolution."

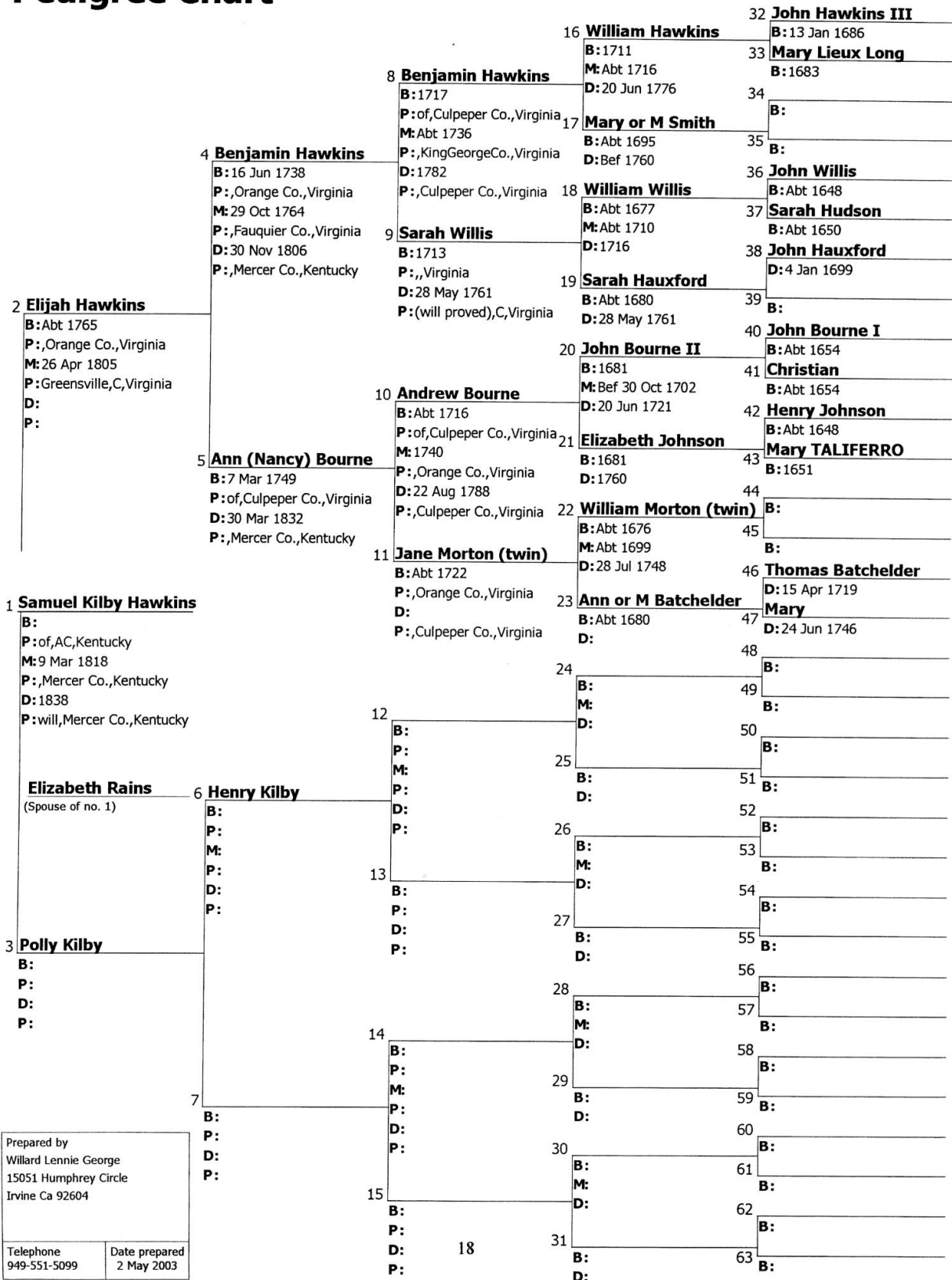
