

Ennis Staton to James E. Ross

This indenture made this 7 day of March A D 1862 between Ennis Staton of the County Union and State of North Carolina on the one hand and James E. Ross of County of Union and State aforesaid on the other hand. Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars in hand paid by James E. Ross to the said Ennis Staton the receipt and payment, bargained, sold, confirmed, and conveyed and by these presents does give, grant, bargain, sell, confirm, and convey unto the said James E. Ross his heirs, executor, administrator, and assigns all that tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in County of Union and upon the waters of Negro Head Creek beginning at a stake by two pines Statons corner and runs S 50 W 56 chs to a stake in ##### Griffin's line thence S 60 E 38 chs and 50 links passing a corner of marked trees five chs to a stake, thence N 34 E 29 chs to a stake in Jacob Littles line, thence with his line W 12 chs and 50 links to Littles corner stake by Post oak and Black oak and pine thence N 26 chs to the beginning containing one hundred acres be the same more or less to have and to hold together with all woods, waters, mines, minerals, and appurtenance to the said land belonging or appertaining to hold to the said James E. Ross, his heirs and assigns forever, and said Ennis Staton do for myself, my heirs, executor, administrators and assigns do covenant, promise, and agree to warrant and Defend the said land ##### appurtenance thereon belonging unto the said James E. Ross his heirs and assigns forever against the claims or demands of all and every other person whatsoever in as right a manner of the most learned in the Law can devise. In Witness Whereof have hereunto set my hand and seal the year and day first herein written signed, sealed, and delivered in presence of J. E. Smith
