

Deed Record Book 8 page 65 Ennis Staton Deed to Sarah Staton and her heirs  
This indenture made this 14<sup>th</sup> day of September 1869 between Ennis Staton of the  
County of Union and State of North Carolina of the first part and Sarah Staton his  
wife and her children their names will appear on the back of this Deed of the other  
part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the love he has for my wife Sarah  
Staton and her children he give grant convey and confirm unto them a certain piece  
of land lying and being in the county of Union and State aforesaid on the East side  
of Negro head creek and bounded as follows viz Beginning at a white oak on the  
North side of Brushy Branch Godwin's corner and runs S 70 W 29 chains and 30  
links to an ash stump in the mouth of Brushy Branch a water oak and gum pts  
thence up the various courses of Negrohead Creek 37 chains to an ash stump 2 ash  
pts thence S 36 E 36 chains and 50 links to a pine stump a corner of a 300 Acre  
survey granted to Elijah Coburn thence with a line of sd survey South 89 Et 41  
chains and 50 links to Dead Black Oak by a post oak thence North 78 chains to  
Wm. Holly's field thence South 85 W one chain and 25 links to the corner of said  
field thence N 6 W 15 chains to a post oak in Godwin's line Supposed to be Holly's  
corner thence with Holly's and Godwin's lines to the beginning containing four  
hundred and fifty five Acres more or less and I the said Ennis Staton doth agree to  
warrant and defend the title of said land with all and every appurtenance thereunto  
belonging or in anywise appertaining ( provided however that I reserve the same for  
myself during my natural lifetime) unto them the sd Sarah Staton and her children  
against the title or claims of any and all persons whatever In witness whereof I  
hereunto set my hand and affix my seal the day and date above written signed and  
delivered in presence of
