

NIXON THOMAS, 84, DEAD

Retired Contractor Was Veteran of
Civil War—Funeral Wednesday.

Nixon Thomas, age eighty-four, a retired contractor and civil war veteran, died Sunday at the home of his daughter, Mrs. W. J. Condrey, 3820 Rookwood avenue. Mr. Thomas was born in Jennings county, March 17, 1841. In the civil war he served as a member of Company K, 12th Indiana volunteers, and in Company D, of the 2d Indiana cavalry. His wife, Addie P. Reynolds, whom he married at Paris, Ind., in 1866, died in 1912. Mr. Thomas came to Indianapolis in 1902.

He was a member of the George H. Thomas Post, G. A. R.; of the Improved Order of Redmen, and of the North M. E. church. He is survived by the daughter, Mrs. Condrey; a son, Frank L. Thomas; a granddaughter, Mrs. John A. Goll, Jr., and three great-grandchildren, John, Frank and Nellie Goll, all of Indianapolis. Funeral services will be held Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the home. Burial will be in Crown Hill cemetery.
