## **Ancestors of Thomas Boisclair**

#### **First Generation**

1. Thomas Boisclair, son of Joseph Beriault Boisclair and Josette Paquin, was born in 1819 in Massachusetts and died about 1851 in Michigan about age 32.

General Notes: St. Anne's records, p. 3496. Godfather of Margarite Rouleau, daughter of Pierre Rouleau and Margarite Cicotte. 24 Jan 1843. (BHC, Detroit)

Pierre Rouleau was the 2nd husband of his niece Marie Louise Boucher.

St. Anne's records p. 3520: Witness at baptism of Lucien, son of Basil Mallett and Delaute Delay. Recorded in Latin. 1843 Nov.

Occupation listed as farmer.

Birthplace not verified: Eliza Beauclair Moore listed "Massachusetts" as father's birthplace in 1870 census.

Thomas married **Ann Dix**, daughter of **Jacob Dix** and **Susanne Metay**, on 16 Apr 1844 in Detroit, Wayne, Michigan, USA.

Comparing townships of Springwells and Ecorse to Plymouth, it appears that the French population concentrated in Springwells and Ecorse, while Plymouth had more English and German inhabitants.

General Notes: It has been difficult to determine the parentage of Josette Paquin. Her parents' names are not listed in the marriage record of Josette and Joseph Boisclair, although Joseph's parents are named. Looking at Paquin families that resided in Louiseville, Que, the site of the marriage, the most likely parents seemed to be Francois Paquin (son of Francois and Marie Anne Gregoire) and Marie Louise Trottier Desruisseaux Pombert (PRDH family # 63680). However, a marriage for this Josephte was found in Louiseville in 1810 to Basile Racine, and so she is ruled out.

Josette married Joseph Beriault Boisclair on 12 Jan 1807 in Louiseville, Quebec. 5

Pointe-du-lac: parish opened 1742, just upriver (sw) of Trois Rivieres.

Family included 3 sets of twins

15 Children, at least 7 died before age 3

Marie married Joseph Bériault Boisclair on 21 Feb 1773 in Pointe-du-lac, Quebec. 11

birthplace: St-Germain, Hermeray, ev. Chartres, Ile-de-France (ar. Rambouillet, Yvelines). St. Germain was known as the parish of royalty.

II-de-France is the Paris metropolitan area, and has been the center of power during most of French history. Hermeray is identified in Wikipedia as "a commune in the Yvelines Dept in Ile-de-France."

**18.** Charles Maranda Marandeau, son of Jean Maranda Marandeau and Jeanne Cousin, was born on 26 Apr 1670,<sup>20</sup> was baptized on 1 May 1670 in Quebec, died on 12 Jul 1744 <sup>20</sup> at age 74, and was buried on 13 Jul 1744 in St-Laurent I.O. Quebec.

General Notes: PRDH shows 12 children in this family, born between 1697 and 1724. All children born at St-Laurent I.O, Quebec.

Charles married **Denise Fiset** on 24 Nov 1695 in L'Ange-Gardien, Quebec, Canada.<sup>20</sup>

- **19. Denise Fiset**, daughter of **Francois Abraham Fiset** and **Marie Denise Savard**, was born on 21 Apr 1678 in L'Ange-Gardien, Quebec, Canada, <sup>21</sup> was baptized on 21 Apr 1678, died on 17 Jun 1731 <sup>21</sup> at age 53, and was buried on 18 Jun 1731 in St-Laurent I.O. Quebec.

Denise married Charles Maranda Marandeau on 24 Nov 1695 in L'Ange-Gardien, Quebec, Canada. 20

**20.** Francois Girard, son of Pierre Girard and Suzanne Lavoie, was born on 5 Apr 1673 in Quebec, <sup>22</sup> was baptized on 12 Apr 1673 in Quebec, and died on 11 Mar 1752 in Trois-Rivieres, Quebec at age 78.

General Notes: Francois and Marie Antoinette had 10 children (listed in PRDH) between the years of 1702 and ca 1725. Locations of births not recorded, but most of the marriages of their children took place in Trois-Rivieres.

Francois married Marie Antoinette Lemay before 31 Dec 1702 in Quebec. 23

**22.** Pierre Émond, son of Isaac Emond and Marie Garineau, was born before 1664 in St-Louis, Rochefort, Saintonge, France.<sup>26</sup>

General Notes: Married at Riviere Ouelle: parish opened 1685. Located on south shore of St. Lawrence River

PRDH: baptised St. Louis, v. Rochefort, ev la Rochelle, aunis (ar. rochefort, charente-maritime)

1681 census: 17 years old / 1690 census: Beaupre, in the employ of Pierre Maufils; 25 years olf.

Pierre and Marie Agnes had 10 children, born between 1691 and 1712. Family apparently resided in Riviere-Ouelle. Children: Marie Agnes, b. 1691/ Pierre, b. 1692 / Marie Angelique b. 1695 / Joseph, 1698 / Augustin, 1700 / Cecile,1702 / Marie Ann, 1706 / Jean Baptiste, 1709, and Genevieve, 1712.

According to Jette, Pierre died between 5 Feb 1714 and 30 April 1719 at Riviere-Ouelle.

**23.** Marie Agnes Grondin, daughter of Jean Grondin and Marie Sainte Migneault Chatillon, was born on 14 Mar 1673,<sup>28</sup> was baptized on 19 Mar 1673 in Beauport, Quebec, died on 23 Nov 1752 at age 79, and was buried on 24 Nov 1752 in Beauport, Quebec.

General Notes: PRDH: born/died at Beauport. Parish opened 1664; location just downstream of Quebec City (ne) before Ile de Orleans.

Marie married Pierre Émond on 31 Jan 1690 in Riviere-Ouelle, Que. 27

Marie next married Gabriel Donge Auger on 3 Jun 1719 in Quebec.

**38.** Francois Abraham Fiset, son of Abraham Fiset and Catherine Labrecque, was baptized on 31 Aug 1635 in Rouen, Normandy, France<sup>29</sup> and died on 23 Dec 1700 in L'Ange-Gardien, Quebec, Canada at age 65.

General Notes: PRDH shows baptism at St-Jacques, v. Dieppe, archev. Rouen, Normandie (ar. Dieppe, Seine-Maritime)

LaForest: baptism at church of St-Ignace, Dieppe. v. 11 p. 43

LaForest v. 11 p. 43-51:

Emigrated about 1653. Signed contract 25 April 1654 with Paul Chalifour, who taught him carpentry and paid him 60 livres after the 2nd and last year of his apprenticeship. He was promised room and board until 20 March 1657.

After receiving his credential of competence in carpentry, he needed to supplement his income by farming, so he applied to Jean de Lauzon, Grand Senechal of New France, for a grant of land in the fief of Lotinville.

He was ceded a tract of land measuring 3 arpents in frontage on the river, near the present church of L'Ange Gardien. Here Abraham built a cabin and cleared the land. He lived his whole life on this parcel.

Jean de Lauzon was killed by Iroqois in 1661, and the fief passed into the hands of Bertrand Chenay de la Garenne on 30 Aug 1664. Now Abraham paid his seigneurial rents to this new owner.

Abraham worked for 10 years in this country before signing a marriage contract on 30 Nov 1663 with Denise Savard, daughter of Simon Savard and Marie Hourdouille. An earlier contract mentioned Abraham doing carpentry work for Simon Savard, so this might be how the couple met. On this document, Abraham's parents are listed as Abraham and Catherine Labrecque.

PRDH shows 12 children in this family, born between 1665 and 1688. La Forest has 14 children in this family: 6 daughters: Anne, Genevieve, Marie Madeleine, Marie, Marguerite, Denise, and 8 sons: Jean-Baptist, Joseph, Denis, Francois, Michel, Charles, Louis, and Francois. Jean-Baptiste was baptised at Chateau-Richer, but later children were baptised at L'Ange Gardien, after the parish was established in 1670.

The Fisets provided dowries for all their daughters, even going into debt to make up a dowry of 50 livres for Marie-Madeleine; giving 100 livres for Anne and 200 for Denise, who also was provided with "one mother cow".

Abraham Fiset was hospitalized at Hotel Dieu in Quebec on 5 April 1694 for ten days. He lived 6 more years, until 23 Dec 1700.

Notary Etienne Jacob began a property inventory on 26 Jan 1701 in the presence of the widow, Denise Savard. However, by July 1704, the record of the Sovereign Council shows that she too had passed away.

The details of the 1701 inventory show that the Fisets were relatively prosperous for that time. Their property consisted of 50 arpents in plowed land, prairie and pasture. The house measured 36 feet long and 18 feet wide. The barn was 30 feet long and 20 feet wide; the stable 20 feet by 20 feet.

They owned 1 plow, 2 axes, 2 guns, 8 sickles. Animals included 1 mare, 1 heifer, 2 calves, 3 cows, 4 oxen, 4 pigs, 11 hens and 1 rooster. The farm produced wheat, barley and oats.

Son Charles bought the farm from his brothers and sisters, which had been equally divided, as was the custom. In the second generation, several members of the family settled in the vicinity of Portneuf, at Neuville.

Francois married Marie Denise Savard on 5 Feb 1664 in Chateau Richer, Quebec, Canada. 30

Marriage Notes: Marriage contract 30 Nov 1663 Notary Vachon (Jette p. 421)

Married by priest Thomas Morel. Witnesses were Simon Savard, Martin Prevost, François Fortin, and Charles Lefrançois. (Prevost was a native of Montreuil-sur-Bois, as were the Savards. Fortin was a native of St. Jacques in Dieppe, and must have known Abraham).

- v. **Marie Fiset** was born on 7 Jun 1673 in Quebec, <sup>32</sup> was baptized on 29 Jun 1673 in Quebec, and died on 19 Sep 1710 in Montmagny, Quebec <sup>30</sup> at age 37.
