

## NINES OF SIX EACH.

### Why Ball Playing Has Ceased on Prindle Street For the Present.

Twelve boys were arraigned in line before his honor, Judge Studley, in the city court this morning. They were charged with playing ball on Prindle street Thursday. Their names were Thomas Gaffney, aged 14, Fred Henker, 12; Samuel Ferris, 13; John Adams, 13; Harry Flynn, 10; Luke Kentfeld, 14; August Fechner, 14; Bernard Fitzpatrick, 14; George Drexler, 17; Theodore and Leonard Menzinghagen, 17 and Patrick Donnelly, 18. After considerable ado they all pleaded guilty to the charge and Judge Studley administered a lecture and advised those of the boys' parents who were in court that their children would be severely fined if they were brought in again. He suspended judgment in the cases of all but Donnelly, Leonard, Theodore Menzinghagen and George Drexler, who were the oldest in the party, upon whom a fine of \$2 each, without costs, were imposed. The residents of the upper part of Wooster street sent a petition to Prosecuting Attorney Cable asking him to attend to this crowd of boys, as they were continually annoying the neighbors.
