Patrick Henry Esquire Governor of the Commonwealth
of Virginia to all to whom these Presents shall come Greeting
Knowye that by Virtue of a Certificate in Right of Settlement
Given by the Commissioners for adjusting Titles to unpatented
Lands in the District of Monongalia, Gohogania & Ohio
and in Consideration of the Ancient Composition of
Two Pounds Sterling Paid by Samuel Bonnet into the
Treasury of this Commonwealth. there is Granted by
the said Commonwealth unto the said Samuel Bonnet
a certain tract or Parcel of Land containing Four
Hundred Acres. by Survey bearing date the Twenty
Second day of July. one Thousand Seven Hundred
and Eighty five. lying and being in the County of
Harrison (formerly Monongalia) on Hackers Creek
adjoining Lands of William Lowther and Lands of
John Sleeth. and Bounded as followeth To Wit
Beginning at a Black oak & Running thence South
Eighty four degrees West Two Hundred and Ninety
Six Poles by Lands of said Lowther and Crossing
said Creek to a white oak South Twenty four degrees

East

East one Hundred and Twenty two Poles to a Black oak South
 fifteen degrees West forty eight Poles to a white oak South forty
 five degrees East eighty Poles crossing Monnets run to a Gum
 North thirty five degrees East Ninety Poles to a white oak
 South fifty five degrees East eighty Poles to a Sugar tree
 North Seventy six degrees East Two hundred and sixteen
 Poles to a white oak North thirty seven degrees West
 Two hundred and Twelve Poles to the Beginning with its
 Appurtenances: To have and to hold the said tract or
 Parcel of Land, with its Appurtenances to the said
 Samuel Bonnet and his Heirs forever: In Witness
 whereof the said Patrick Henry Esquire Governor of the
 Commonwealth of Virginia hath here unto set his
 Hand, and Caused the lesser Seal of the said Common-
 wealth to be Affixed at Richmond on the Twenty
 Seventh Day of October, in the Year of our Lord, one
 Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty six, and of
 the Commonwealth the Eleventh.
