To all to whom these presents shall come I the said  
Hawley Lt Govern. do send greeting. Now  
know ye that I the said Lt Govern. do with  
the consent of the Council of State accordingly give  
and grant unto Thomas Burbage twelve hundred  
and fifty acres of Land situate lying and being in the  
County of Armonk (viz) on the Northward side  
of the mouth of a Creek called Hungans Creek  
next adjoining to the Land granted by patent unto  
William Childers abutting westerly upon the bay  
easterly with the breadth by the maine Creek southerly  
upon the point of the mouth of the Creek and running  
northerly into the maine woods which said Land was  
formerly granted by patent unto William Gaymy  
the said twelve hundred and fifty acres of Land  
being due unto him the said Thomas Burbage by  
and for the transportation of six and twenty persons  
into this Colony to him and to hold &c dated the  
fourth of March 1638 &c initials

know ye that I the said Lt Govern. do with  
the consent of the Council of State accordingly give  
and grant unto Rice Hoo three hundred acres of  
Land situate lying and being in the County of James  
City North upon the Land formerly granted by patent  
to him the said Rice Hoo abutting west upon the maine  
river and rising Easterly upon the Land of David Jones  
and upon a Creek called David Jones his Creek —  
the said three hundred acres of Land being due unto  
him the said Rice Hoo by and for the transportation  
of six persons into this Colony whose names are in the  
Records mentioned under this patent to him and  
to hold &c dated the fourth of June 1639 &c initials
