Frederick County Ct. By virtue of part of a treasury warrant. N^o 11047 there is Survey for Jacob Huffman of John Cordell 1 acre 2 rods and 16 square perches of land in the Borough of Winchester which is bounded as follows, that is to say, Beginning at a stake corner to a lot lately Surveyed for Peter Winde and in the line of Lewis Wolf thence extending with Wolf S 47° W 33 po 417 links to a stake corner to a lot of John Cordell, thence with him S 74° E 17 po 418 links to a stake at the corner of Heart Street and west lane, thence with the lane N 16° E 29 po 45 links to the Beginning. Of which the above is a plot. Surveyed the 25th of June 1791

1784 I have Surveyed for Frederick High of James Maury & John Lewis and of George Thompson & of Rob^t Plummer a tract of land in Hampshire County on the waters of Mill Creek and on Pattersons Creek Mountain including the long lick boundary as followeth Beginning at a white oak corner to David Grayville, thence with his line N 81° W 27 po to a drain of Mill Creek Cont^d 168 p to a white oak another of Grayvilles cor^r on the bank of another drain of mill Creek, thence with or near another line of
