William Sade of
 I the Citie of Norwich in the countie of Norff. gent. beinge of whole mynde and perfect memoerye
 doe make this my last will and Testament in manner and forme followinge: First I give my
 soule to God the Almighty and my bodie to be buried in the Church or Churchyarde where I
 shall depte this lyffe. Item I give to some of the poorest householders in the parsh of St. Andrew
 five shillings to carrye me to my grave fower shillings. The residue of charges
 I will to be payde that daye out of my goodes money or plate
 And wher as I have gyven to my wyffe out of my Lande in Hoxton some pouldes by the yere
 duringe her naturall lyf that is to saye everye halfe yere fyve pouldes to be payde by my some
 Thomas Sade accordinge to a dede made by hym a fore I was married to Susan Bette my wife
 further I doe give unto her some pouldes of lawfull money to be payde unto her by my Exor
 or his deputie the next daye after my buryall, also I give unto my said wyffe my best
 with the bouslee pillowe blanket two payre of sheetes and a Covering of downe and also all
 her apparell both linnen and wollen. all the rest of my goodes cattell money plate bonds and
 what soever; I give to my Exor to whom I ordaine and make my godsonne William Sade
 some and here of Thomas Sade of Catmington also Camington in the countie of Suff. I have
 by my will is written with my owne hande this seven tenth daye of December. At hon same
 five hundredth nyntie foure. These beinge witnesses Richard Cooley parshclerk of the
 a Godwill to be annexed to me Sade will under mynne martij. At house of five hundred nyntie
 fower: I. Me William Sade did give and bequeath to his wyffe all his household stuffe
 savinge his plate and his best fether bedd two pillowes, two payre of sheetes a payre of
 blanket and the blue Covering of rugge in the presence of Richard Cooley, Nicholas
 Emb. and Samuell Marton.

 hospice beinge sicke of bodie, but of good and perfect remembrance prayse be God; doe ordaine
 make this my present Testament and last will in manner and forme followinge: First I
 bequeath my soule into the merryfull handes of Almighty God my maker & Creator trustinge
 I shall by and thorough the death and passion of his sonne Christ Iesus to be saved, and to be
 made one of his elect children of the kyngdom of heaven. Item I give and bequeath unto Dorothy
 my wife all my Landes, tenement and hereditaments situate lyngge & beinge in Frytton Shelton
 and Hempsnall & elsewhere in the countie of Norff to her and her Assignes for and duringe all
 tyme and tyme of hee naturall lyf and after her decess. I will and give all the same lande tenement
 and hereditaments unto Nathaniell Kemynge my sonne and to his heires for ever. Item I give
 unto my Daughters Hanna Kemynge, Rebecca Kemynge, Lydia Kemynge, Priscilla Kemynge
 and Marye Kemynge, to everye of them
 To be payde them at theer severall ages of one and Twentie yeres. Item I will give and
 bequeath my messuage with thapperting situate lyngge and beinge in the parsh of St. Andrew
