 VIRGINIA. To all to whom this present writing shall come send  
 greeting in our beloved Everlasting Will We Dennis Conyer of Stafford  
 County upon his supplication of a certain quantity of Land belonging to us in  
 the County of King George and Stafford which is not yet granted did on the  
 third day of July last obtain a warrant from our Office for laying out the same  
 and having returned a survey thereof under the hands of Capt. Thomas  
 Cooper Surveyor, dated the seventh day of February last. Know ye  
 therefore that we the said Proprietors for and consideration of the composition  
 to us paid and the Annual Rent hereafter to be paid. We granted made  
 ever and confirmed and do by these presents grant make ever and confirm  
 unto the said Dennis Conyer eight hundred and forty Acres of Land lying &  
 being in the County of King George and Stafford aforesaid and on the head  
 branches of Chicking run bounded according to the said survey as followeth  
 To wit Beginning at a small corner mark the office of standing on the lower  
 side of the uppermost fork of Chicking run being corner to the land of Mr. James  
 Withers and at the Distance of two poles from a great corner mark the white  
 oak in the said Withers line mark for the said Conyer and extending  
 from the said office along the said Withers line to the sixty Degree  
 West Eighty Pole to a white Oak standing on the side of a branch thence  
 thirty eight Degrees West One hundred forty Pole to a steeping thence  
 in a line to the seventy nine Degrees West One hundred and forty Pole to a  
 corner mark of a white Oak being corner to the said Withers and the same  
 proceeded for some distance thence leaving the said Withers Land  
 to the East and to the North by a white oak great Oak standing on  
 the side of the water of point where a road is to be made of the plantation  
 of the said Withers and to the East and to the North by a white oak  
 corner mark the white Oak standing in the line of the land of Mr. Rice thence to  
 the said head of the river to the East to a corner mark fifty six Pole corner

mark the white Oak and other small mark trees being corner to the said Head  
 and the Land of Col<sup>l</sup>. Thomas Lee thence South Forty Degrees East fifty  
 Pole to a white Oak and Poplar standing on the said Chicking run side  
 near the head thereof thence down the said Chicking run according to the  
 several Courses and Meanders thereof to the Beginning Togeth<sup>r</sup> with  
 with all rights Members and Appurtenances thereunto belonging. Reserving  
 to us Excepted and a full third part of all Lead Copper Tin Coals Irons  
 and other that shall be found thereon. To have unto hold the said eight  
 hundred and forty Acres of Land Together with all rights profits and benefits  
 to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining except before excepted.  
 to him the said Dennis Conyer his heirs and Assigns forever he the said Dennis  
 Conyer his heirs and Assigns therefore yielding and paying to us  
 our heirs and Assigns or to the Certain Attorney or Attorneys of us  
 the said Proprietors or to the Certain Attorney or Attorneys of our heirs and  
 Assigns Proprietors of the said Northern Neck yearly and every year on the  
 first of Saint Michael the Arch Angel the second of June the sum of  
 five shillings for every fifty Acres of Land hereby granted and so proportionably for  
 every greater or lesser quantity. We will that if the said Dennis Conyer  
 or his heirs or Assigns shall not pay the before reserved Annual Rent so that the same  
 or any part thereof shall be behind or unpaid by the space of two whole years  
 after the same shall become due if lawfully demanded that then it shall and  
 lawfully for us our heirs or Assigns Proprietors as aforesaid our or their  
 Certain Attorneys or Attorneys of us or of our heirs or Assigns shall have  
 full power to enter and hold the same Land with this grant had never  
 been made at our Office in the County of Stafford within the said Northern Neck  
 of Virginia. We will that our Attorney or Attorneys of us or of our heirs or Assigns  
 shall have full power to enter and hold the same Land with this grant had never
