^{*}These have been selected from the list of subscribers on account of their interest to Virginia genealogists. Of these Dade was, certainly, and Broadnax, Burdett, Cotton, Fowke, Pettus and Stone, probably, the ancestor of the Virginia families of the same names. The Pendletons were descended from the Pettus and Dethick Familes of Norfolk. The Gleanes of New York probably came from the Gleanes of Norfolk and Hoptons of Pennsylvania may be traced to the Shropshire family; one Virginia family may have descended from the Harrisons of Essex.
