

Declaration.

In order to obtain the benefit of the 3d section of the act of Congress of the 4th July 1836 and the acts amending the same.

State of New York.

Putnam County &c. On this twelfth day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty four, personally appeared before the Court of Probate in and for said County Ann Bonkling, a resident of the town of Carmel in the County of Putnam aforesaid, aged seventy five years, who being first duly sworn according to law, doth on her oath, make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the provisions made by the act of Congress passed July 4th 1836, and the acts amending the same: That she is the widow of Natham Bonkling who was a private in the 4th Regiment of New York Continental forces in the company under the command of Captain Platt, which Regiment was under the command of Colonel of Henry B. Livingston. That he entered the service in said Company and Regiment on the 1st of November 1776, and that he continued therein one year and upwards according to the best of this deponents information and belief, for proof that he did enter the service as above stated, she begs leave to refer to the certificate of Philip Phelps, Deputy Comptroller of the State of New York hereto annexed - That he also entered the service in a Company of militia under the command of Captain John Brane in the Regiment under the command of Colonel Henry Biddington on the 18th June 1779, as a private and continued therein until his pay amounted to £1. 19. 6. - That he again entered the state service of New York in a Company under the command of Captain Thomas Hunt in Colonel Frederick Misenfels Regiment on the first of December in the year 1781, that he continued therein until his pay amounted to £8. 10. 8. for proof of which last mentioned services she refers to the certificate of

the said Philip Phelps Deputy Comptroller of the State of New York bearing date the 24th January 1844 and hereto annexed - She further declares that she was married on the twenty sixth day of March 1786 to the said Nathan Conkling in the town of Carmel in the County of Putnam aforesaid by the Reverend Natham Cole, a Baptist preacher, that that there is no record of her said marriage either on the records of the Baptist Church of said town, or on the town records, as will appear by the certificate of the Clerk of said Church and the clerk of said town hereto annexed, nor is there any person now living who was present at said marriage to her knowledge or her belief, she begs leave to refer to the original entries of her marriage kept in her family bible, which record she has cut out of her said bible and appended hereto. She further declares that her husband the aforesaid Nathan Conkling died on the 26th day of August 1808, and that she has remained a widow ever since the death of her aforesaid husband, as will appear to the testimony hereto annexed.

reported in the neighbourhood, that they were married— and
from that time up to the time of his death, they were reported
as husband and wife, that while they so lived together they
had the following children who are now living viz: Amy
now the wife of David Hazleton, Joseph Conkling— Betty
now the wife of James Early and Mary now the wife of
Jonathan Odell— and deponent further saith that the
eldest ^{child living} is now aged about fifty two years—
