In 1759 he was a Mennonite living at Ibersheim with his two children. He was a tenant at Ibersheim on 12 Nov 1762. He was then released and later captured again and put in the prison at Ottenbach for 60 weeks with some other brethren. They took all of his money and tortured him for 16 weeks. His wife was in prison for about 18 months. They were released and then hunted again. While they were being hunted his wife gave birth to twins. Their family was scattered and had to pay a tax of 1000 guilders to the government. They were not listed in the 1650 census at Dürnten. He was probably the Anabaptist Minister Hans Müller who lived at Mackenheim, Alsace in 1660. He was probably the Mennonite Hans Mueller who was at Alsace in 1660 and then in 1662 was at Dühren, Germany. He and Hans Meili were invited by Baron von Vennigen to move from Alsace to Dühren, Germany.
