named Richard Mack Dowall maketh oath that he saw the above named Sam^l.
Gale duly Seal and Execute the above named mentioned Lease and also saw the
said Sam^l Gale and the above named William Vicars Anthony Gale and Mary
Vicars duly Seal and Execute the above mentioned Release of which said
Deeds of Lease and Release the above writing is a Mem^l. and also saw the
said Samuell Gale duly Sign and Seal the said Mem^l. and that this Deft^r
