 bearing date the fourteenth of November one thousand seven hundred and eighty
 and made or to be made between Thomas Gale of Sampsons Court
 in the Queens County Gent: and Mable his wife and Anthony Gale Merchant
 of the said Thomas Gale of the first part, Peter Gale of the Town of Dunlowry
 John Gale of Ashfield in the Queens County Gent: and Stephen Fitzgould
 of Ballydavis in said County Gent: of the second part, and Anne Delany
 eldest Daughter of Malachai of Rathleague in the Queens County of said Gent:
 of the third part. Whereby after reciting that a Marriage was speaking to be had
 and solemnized between the said Anthony Gale and Anne Delany the said Thom:
 Gale for and in Consideration of the said intended Marriage and of the Marriage
 portion of three hundred pounds to be received with the said Anne and for bearing
 a provision or maintenance for her in case she should survive the said Anthony
 did grant bargain sell assign and make over unto the said Peter Gale John
 Gale and Stephen Fitzgould all that and those the several Towns and Lands
 of Samson Court and Knockardigur with their appurtenances and all the the
 said Thomas Gales Right Title and interest y^e in and to the same Situate lying
 and being in the Barony of Cullinagh and Queens County, aforesaid to
 hold unto the said Peter Gale John Gale and Stephen Fitzgould and
 the Survivors and Survivor of them and to the Heirs of such Survivor in Trust for the several
 uses and purposes therein contained but in particular the first place to pay and discharge
 all rents and other dues that should from time to time respectively become due and payable
 out of the said several Lands of Sampsons Court and Knockardigur to the respective Land
 Lords thereof and from and after the payment and discharge of the same to permit and
 suffer the said Thomas Gale and his Heirs to receive and take to him and their sole
 and proper use of all the rents issues and profits of said lands for and during his natural
 life and upon further Trust that if the said Anne Delany should survive the said Anthony
 that she should from and immediately after his decease have received take and enjoy
 several Lands and premises the yearly value of thirty pounds to the sole and proper use
 of her and her Heirs for and during her natural lifetime to be paid by four quarterly
 payments which said was witnessed by Thomas Smith of Rosmalis in the Queens
 County Gent: H. Dickson of Ballybrittas in the said County Gent: and the Rev: John
 Carter Chap: of Ballynash in said County Carter and son of Dunlavin in the County
 of Wick and this Memorial witnessed by the said John Carter and James Hoiles
 John Gale Seal signed sealed and delivered in presence of John Carter James Hoiles
