a provision or maintenance for her in case she should survive the said Christopher

John Gale and Stephen FitzGerald all that and those the several Towns and Lands
of Sampson Court and Knockardogue with their appurtenances and all her
said Thomas Gales Right Title and interest in and to the same situated County
and being in the Barony of Cullynaher and Queen County aforesaid to
hold unto the said Peter Gale and John Gale and Stephen FitzGerald and
the survivors and Successors of them and to the heirs of such survivor in Trust for the several
uses and purposes herein contained in particular the first place to pay and Discharge
all rents and other dues that should from time respectively become due and payable
out of the said several Lands of Sampson Court and Knockardogue to the respective Land
Lords thereof and from and after the payment and Discharge of the same to permit and
Suffer the said Thomas Gale and his assigns to receive and take to him and his sole
and proper use of all the rents issues and profits of said lands for and during his natural
life and upon further Trust that if the said Christopher Gale should survive the said Christopher
that she should from and immediately after his decease have received and take out of said
several Lands and premises her yearly sum of Thirty pounds to the said Christopher Gale
