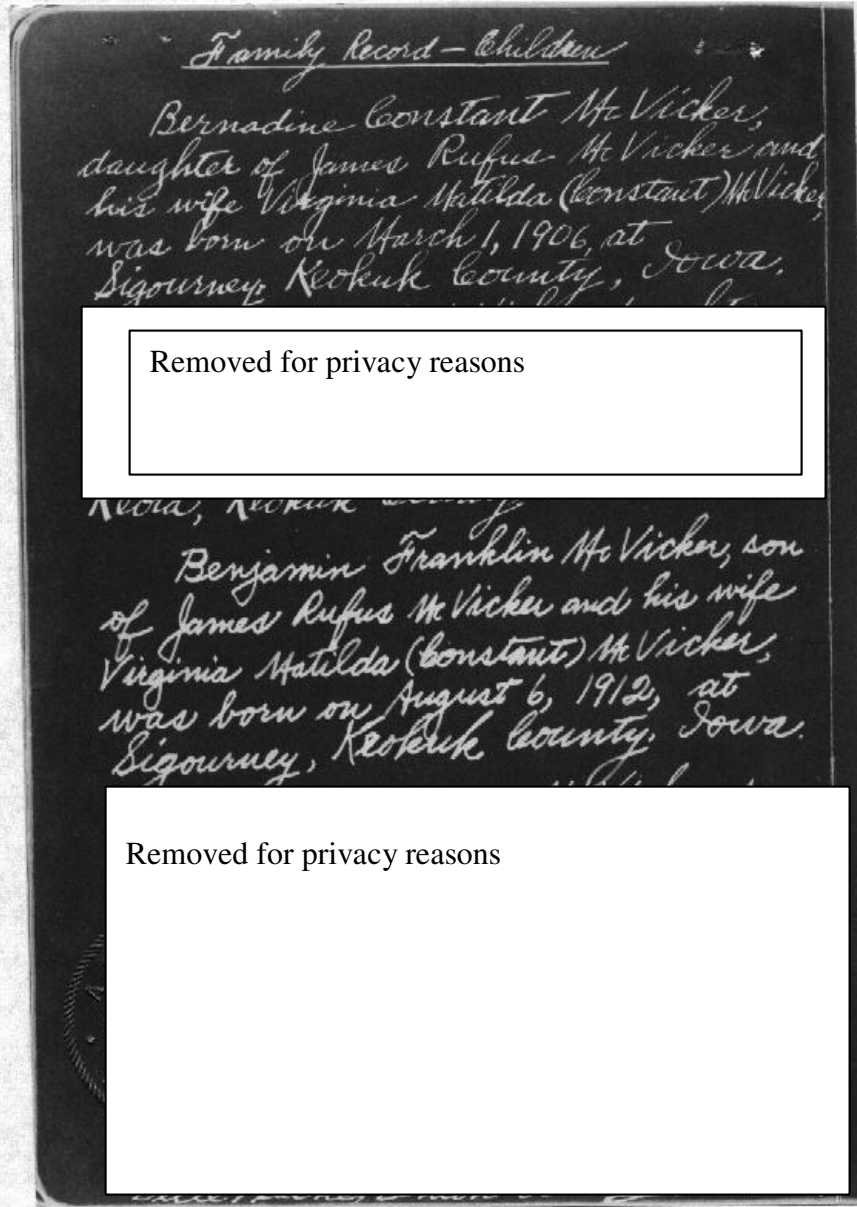

McVicker, having my residence with my family at 1117 East College Street, Iowa City, Johnson County, Iowa, on oath do state and certify as follows: That I am 66 years of age; that I am a lawyer by profession, having practiced law and taught in Colleges of Law; that I am employed as Assistant State Law Librarian in the Iowa State Law Library, State House, Des Moines, Iowa;

That I have charge and custody of the Family Bible of my Grandfather James Hill (1815-1859), formerly of near Masontown, Fayette County, Pennsylvania, the said Family Bible bearing the following inscription in writing(within the book)--

"James Hills Book. Bought By him in the year of our Lord 1836."

That the said Family Bible contains written records of members of the James Hill Family, including their births and deaths and the marriage of James Hill to Martha Keffer and of their daughter Elizabeth Ann Hill to William Kauffman.

That James Hill lived on his farm place near Masontown, Fayette County, Pennsylvania, until and when he died on January 2, 1859, and his widow, Martha Keffer Hill (1816-1867), continued to live on the same home place until her death, on November 17, 1867; that thence and thereafter the possession of James Hill's Family Bible passed into the hands of their daughter, Margaret Emma Hill (1849-1899), who married Norvel Wilson McVicker (1827-1923) on September 8, 1876, at Muscatine, Iowa, and of which union four children were born at Wilton Junction, Muscatine County, Iowa.

That the said Margaret Emma Hill McVicker died on February 18, 1899, at the family home in Sigourney, Iowa, and that thence and thereafter the possession, charge and custody of the said James Hill Family Bible, ~~XXXXXX~~ according to the expressed wish of ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ the said Margaret Emma Hill McVicker, passed into the hands of her eldest son, James R. 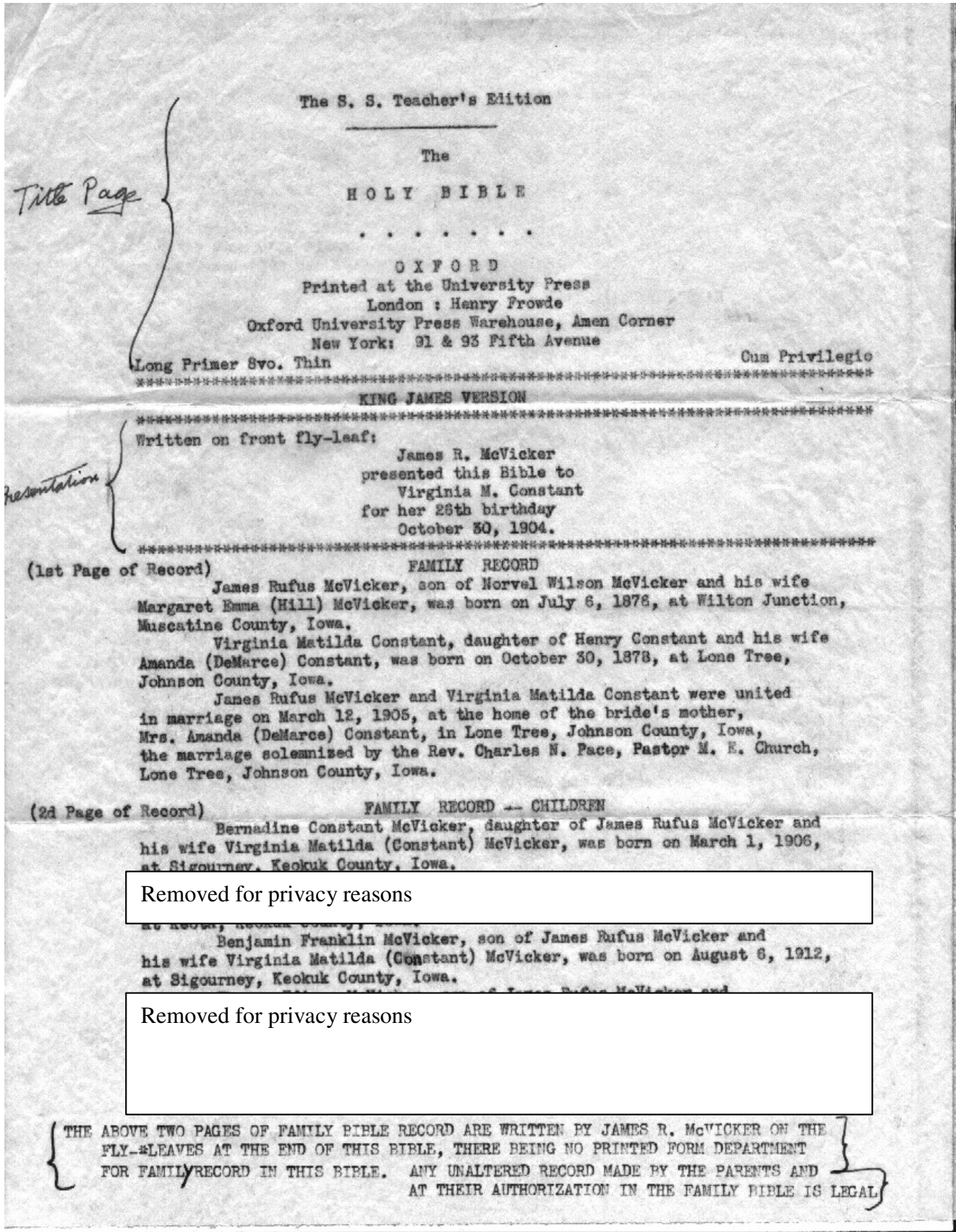

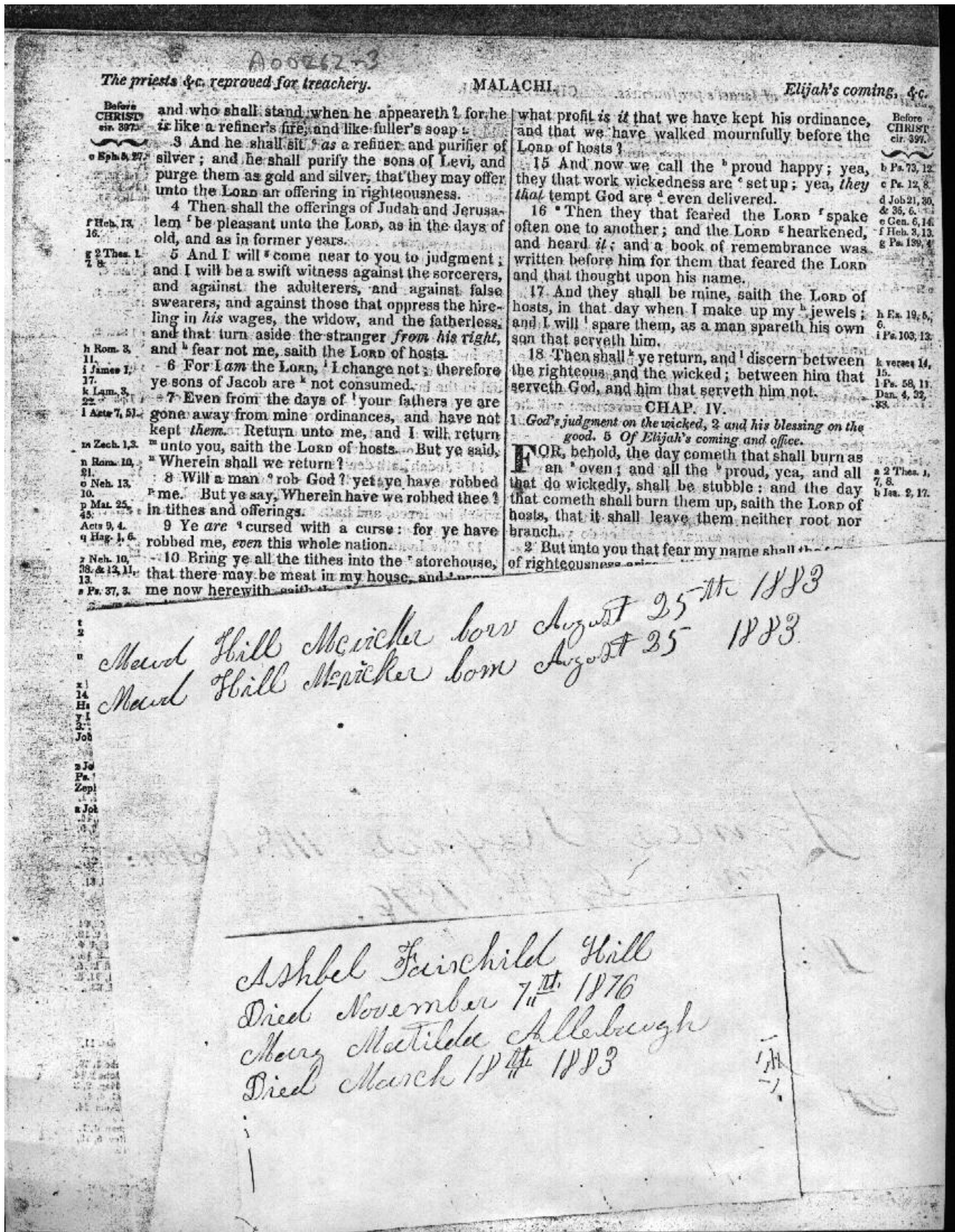

That I have charge and possession of the Family Bible of my Grandfather, James Hill (1815-1859), who resided near Masontown, Fayette County, Pennsylvania. That the said Family Bible bears the following inscription in writing within it at the head of the first page of the Family Record therein contained: "James Hills Book. Bought By him in the year of our Lord.1836."

That the said Family Bible contains written records of marriages, births, and deaths of members of the family of James Hill (1815-1859) and his wife Martha (Kefover) Hill (1816-1867).

That the said James Hill (1815-1859) resided on his farm-place near Masontown, Fayette County, Pennsylvania, until his death on January 2, 1859, and his widow, Martha (Kefover) Hill (1816-1867) continued to reside on the same home place until her death on November 17, 1867; that thence and thereafter the possession of James Hill's Family Bible passed into the hands of their daughter, Margaret Emma Hill (1849-1899), who married Norvel Wilson McVicker (1827-1923) on September 8, 1875, at Muscatine, Iowa, of which union four children including the affiant were born at Wilton Junction, Muscatine County, Iowa.

That Margaret Emma (Hill) McVicker died on February 18, 1899, at the family home in Sigourney, Keokuk County, Iowa, and that thence and thereafter the possession and charge of the Family Bible of the said James Hill (1815-1859), according to the expressed wish of his daughter Margaret Emma (Hill) McVicker, passed into the hands of her eldest son James R. Leverich and visited him at his home in Wilton Junction, Iowa, in 1894, our family having moved from Wilton Junction to Sigourney, Iowa, in 1888. The affiant read many letters from said John H.
