First I bequeath to my Father Edward Goddard the sum of Fifty pounds the intent of which to be paid him yearly during his Life time

Item I give to my Eldest Brother Thomas Goddard the sum of Twenty pounds

Item I give to my sisters Four Children each of them Five pounds to be paid at the time of their coming to the age of Twenty one years

Item I give to my B^r Stephen Goddard the sum of Twenty pounds

Item I give to my Brother Stephen Goddard the sum of Fifty pounds after the death of my Father Edward Goddard. I also desire my B^r Stephen Goddard to take the trouble of being my sole Executor to this my Last will and Testament

Item I also desire that if there is any over/open ___ money That Mourning Rings be given to my Friends following
