during her life and after her decease to pay the same to any poor widow or widower of

from time to time forever I give and bequeath to the Treasurer or Treasurers for the time being of the Charity School of the said parish of Kensington the sum of thirty pounds to be applied for the use and support of the said School I give and bequeath to my faithful servant Abigail mis(?) the sum of one hundred pounds I give to my servant Robert Williams the sum of twenty pounds to my servant Elizabeth Williams the sum of ten pounds and to my servant Elizabeth Reynolds the sum of five pounds if they the said Robert Williams Elizabeth Williams and Elizabeth Reynolds respectively shall be living with me at the time of my decease I give and bequeath to the said Samuel Davis of Portland Plane in the county of Middlesex Esq and Benjamin Pountney of Gerrard Street Soho in the county of Middlesex aforesaid woolen draper Executors of this my will ed the sum of fifty pounds each as an acknowledgement for their troubles in such Executorship and as to all the rest residue and remainder of my Estate and Effects whatsoever and wheresoever and of what nature or kind ____ I give and bequeath the same to my said Daughter in Law Ann Davis to and for her own proper use and benefit and I do hereby nominate and appoint the said Samuel Davis and Benjamin Pountney and the said Ann Davis Executors and Executrix of this my last Will and Testament and I will and direct that they shall each of them respectively be answerable for his and her own acts and receipts only and not the for the others of them nor for any involuntary loss of or to my Estate and Effects and that they may respectively reimburse themselves out of my Estate all costs and expenses which they may expect to or sustain in or about the execution of this my will and I do hereby revoke all former wills by me made and do publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have to this my last Will and Testament contained in two sheets of paper set my hand and seal that is to say have set my hand to the first sheet and to this second and last sheet have set my hand and seal this twenty third day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Seventeen S Goddard Signed Sealed published and declared by the said Stephen Goddard the Testator as and for his last Will and Testament in the presence of us who at his request in his presence and in the presence of each other have subscribed our names as witnesses here to Henry Jeanneret W L/T Stubbs Golden Square
