- b. 13 July; bapt. 26 July 1752 at St. Peter's Luth. Ch. (Stone Ch.)
   Rhinebeck, Dutchess Co., NY; sponsors-Paul & Catherine Wager;
   d. (1790-1810 census)
  - m. ca. 177\_ Lawrence Teal, son of William; b. 26 August 1747; d. 1818, age 72 (1790-1810 census)

    She was called Catherine Teel in her father's will.

    They settled in Claverack Town, Columbia Co., NY.

Children: (Several identified by church recs.; others possible from census, although they may just be extra persons in the hshld.)

- i. Perhaps David Teal b. bet. 1770-1774; d. after 1818 (1790 census) (A male 16+ is with them in the 1790 census, and a David Teal was one of the adm. of Lawrence's estate in 1818, but I don't find a possible David in later censuses, so perhaps it was a relative.)
- ii. Margaretha Teal b. 28 August 1773 (rec. St. Peter's Luth. Ch. (Stone Ch.)); d. (prob. 1790-1800 census)
  She had an "unlawful child":

I. William Boehm Diel bapt. 3 November 1794; d. (prob. in 1800-1810 census with gr.parents) bapt. at Loonenburg Zion Luth. Ch., Greene Co., NY, as child of William Boehm, son of John, and Margaret Diel, dau. of Lorentz; sponsors were Lorentz Diel & Catarina, his wife.

iii. Perhaps Lawrence Teal b. 1774-1790; d. (1790-1800 census) (Or he could fit bet. Catherine & Elizabeth) A Lawrence Teal was named as one of the adm. of Lawrence's estate, so I thought David & Lawrence might be the 2 oldest sons, since males the right age are in their hshld. However, I do not find an extra Lawrence the right age in the later census, so he may just be a relative.

iv. William Teal b. 8 January; bapt. 22 February 1778 at Rhinebeck
 Flatts Dutch Ref. Ch.; d. (Is he the William Teal who d. 13 November
 1867, age 92; bur. 15 November 1867 (Christ Luth. Ch. of Ghent recs.)
 He should be only 89, so it may be a different William.); bur. Old
 Ghent Cem. (1790-1820 census) (Broome Co., NY in 1860)

m. 6 April 1801 Margaret Waltermeyer, dau. of Michael;
b. 3 July; bapt. 24 July 1785; d. 5 August 1845, age 60y.23da.;
bur. 01d Ghent Cem., Columbia Co., NY.

vi. Elizabeth Teal b. 1 January 1786; bapt. at St. Peter's Luth. Ch. (Stone Ch.), Rhinebeck; d. (1790-1800 census?) (Either Elizabeth or Barbara may have d. bef. 1800, or Elizabeth may have been counted in the 16-26 age group.)

- vii. Barbara Teal b. 21 September; bapt. 4 November 1787 at St. Paul's Luth. Ch. of Wurtemburg; sponsors— Andries Thiel & wife Barbara; d. perhaps bef. 1800 (1790 census, unless it was Elizabeth who d.y. and Barbara was also in 1800 census)
- viii. Magdalena Teal bapt. 31 January 1789 at St. Peter's Luth. Ch. (Stone Ch.), Rhinebeck; d. (1790-1810 census)
  - m. 13 November 1808 Levi Janning (perhaps called "Gennis" on one census
    rec.) b. bet. 1784-1794; d. (1810 census)
    They lived in Claverack, Columbia Co., NY.
    Children:
  - I. Perhaps (Son) Janning b. 1808-1810; d. (1810 census)
  - II. Elmer Janning b. 3 December 1811; bapt. 25 January 1812; d.
  - III. Catherine Janning b. 6 January; bapt. 3 April 1814; d.
    - ix. Maria Teal b. 15 April; bapt. 21 April 1792 (Loonenburgh Ch. recs., Greene Co., NY); d. (1800-1810 census)
    - x. Perhaps (Dau.) Teal b. 1790-1794; d. (1800-1810 census)
    - xi. Perhaps (Son) Teal b. 1794-1800; d. (1800-1810 census) (The other boy under 10 with them in the 1800 census could be Margaret's son.)

(H.W.W. has an Anna Teal who m. 16 February 1800 Johannes/John Milius/Melius as their dau. He was b. 1773; d. June 1857, age 84; bur. Christ Luth. Ch. of Ghent. They had 3 daus. b. bet. 1800-1810. I cannot fit her into this Lawrence's family in the census, and have found no proof that she belongs here.)
