WILL of Susanna Scruggs:

In the name of God amen. I **Susanna Scruggs** of the County of Amherst being very sick and weak in Body, but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given to God; calling unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all mankind once to die do make and ordain this my last will and Testament. That is to say principally, and first of all I give and recommei - - my Soul into the hand of Almighty God who gave it, and my body I recommend to the Earth, to be buried in decent Christian Burial at the discretion of my Executors. Nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall recieve the same again, by the mighty Power of God. -- and as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this Life, I give, devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form first and for the whole I give and bequeath to **Samuel Scott Scruggs** my grandson my two feather Beds with their furniture & every thing else that I [unreadable word] of worldly goods, Effects or Estate whatsoever, whom I likewise constitute make and ordain the sole Executor of this my last will and Testament and I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disaunul all and every other former Testaments wills, Legacies, Bequests and Executors by me in anywise before named, willed and Bequested; Ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this sixth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight.

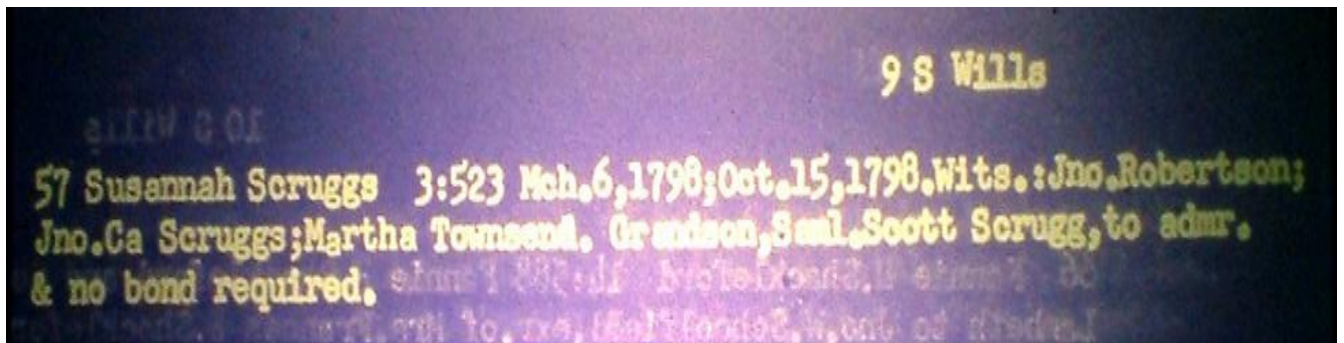
