


JOHN T. VOIGHT'S FAMILY OF ORIGIN

Our Voights have no connection to the actor Jon Voight whose paternal grandfather was Slovak and whose real name was Voytka (also spelled as Voytko). Jon's father and uncle changed their last name to Voight before 1929. (From a Univ. of Pittsburgh website http://www.pitt.edu/~votruba/qsonhist/celebrities/voightjon.html)

The documents in the following pages support this ancestral tree for John T. Voight's family of origin:



Mining the data in the census records prior to 1850 is tedious work requiring concentration and devotion to detail because the earliest census records are just tallies, named only by head of household, counting the males and females, free and slave, in various age ranges. Not many folks have the interest and patience to sort out this kind of puzzle. The chapters on the Voight and Rogers families of origin will not interest everyone, but if it IS your cup of tea, then please enjoy this walk through the family history. Where there are transcriptions of the census data, my comments and interpretations are inserted in red italics.

This work was updated and revised for the second time in September, 2015, because of exciting, new discoveries about John T. Voight's mother's family. All these documents were found on Ancestry.com.


The documents in this chapter outline the story of our Voight family in Virginia from 1796 to 1870. The Rawls ancestors have been found, traced by others, as far back as the mid-1500s! You can examine that research on Ancestry.com

John William Voight's household was the only Voight family in the Gates County, NC, census of 1800, strongly suggesting that John William Voight was the father of John Voight, who in turn was the father of John T. Voight. Since we have three John Voights in a row, you'll see that I found it useful to consistently use their middle names and initials (or NMI for "no middle initial") to avoid confusion among the generations.

For a while the best available online evidence suggested that Barsheba Rawls' parents were Richard Rawls and Amelia Stallings. Richard and Amelia were married in Gates County, NC, in 1796, about six or seven years before Barsheba was born. Richard was the only Rawls I found in the 1800 census for Gates County and he was also there, with daughters, in the 1820 census. It seemed like a good fit.

Then the online discovery of more transcripts from the 1820 census for Nansemond County, Virginia, raised other possibilities for Amelia's parents, including one Andrew Rawls as her potential father. The work of Cousin Teresa Stawson, Portsmouth genealogist and descendent of John T. Voight's brother James, also felt that Andrew Rawls and his wife Abigail Porter were Barsheba's parents.


A few months after updating this chapter with an addendum about the questions surrounding Barsheba's own family of origin, DNA evidence confirmed Andrew Rawls and Abigail Porter were her parents. We'll take a look here at the few documents available concerning John T. Voight's paternal line



(all those John Voights!) Then we will examine the latest discoveries about our Rawls line of ancestors.

Left: This October 17, 1796, marriage record suggests that our John W. Voight married Cealah Speight and that his middle initial stands for "William."

A search of the online transcription of the 1786 census in Gates County does not turn up any Voights but there are several Speights. The names of Kedar Hinton, the bondsman in this marriage record, and Law Baker, the witness, do show up in the 1786 Gates County census. That leaves one to wonder where John William Voight was living before his marriage - perhaps in someone else's household or nearby in Nansemond County, Virginia. Law Baker, by the way, signed off on the 1786 census report with the initials "G.C." after his name – probably standing for some sort of official title.



Here's the oldest online document found for our ancestors named Voight, the **1800 census from Gates County, North Carolina**. Finding only one Voight (out of only 21 pages and fewer than 600 somewhat alphabetical names for the whole county) strongly suggests that this man is the patriarch of the Voights in Gates Co., NC and neighboring Nansemond County, VA.

The only Voight household listed in Gates County in 1800 is that of **JOHN W. VOIGHT**, enumerated as follows:

Free white males:

Four under age 10 John (NMI)*
Voight, the father of John T. Voight, is likely to be one of these four boys under age 10 who were all born between 1790 and 1800.

One age 10 – 15

One age 26 – 44 This entry tells us that the father of this family, John W. Voight, was born between 1756 & 1774, i.e. before the Revolution.

Free white females:

One age 26 – 44 So we know that the probable wife of John W. Voight was also born between 1756 and 1774.

Slaves: one

Number of household members under age 16: 5


Number of household members over age 25: 2

Number of household members: 8

^{*} I use "NMI" or "no middle initial" to distinguish this John Voight from his father John W. Voight and from his son John T. Voight.

I have not found our Voights in the 1810 or 1820 census records.


By 1830 John W. Voight is probably deceased. Celia Voight has her own listing in the census for Gates County, N.C., so she is probably a widow.

Celia must be the female between 50 and 59. The others in the household could well be Celia's grown children, unnamed siblings of John (NMI) Voight: a boy between 10 – 14, and two girls in their twenties. This is the last record we have for Celia Speight Voight.

JOHN (No Middle Initial) VOIGHT HOUSEHOLD, GATES CO, NC, 1830 census.



John No-Middle-Initial Voight married Barsheba Rawls before 1830; we know, because he is the head of a family house-hold in the census and he has three children already in 1830.

This is the first & last online record of John "NMI " Voight found under his own name.

Free white males:

Two under age 5 "NMI" John's first two sons, James and Patrick, would be under 5 in 1830. (Sons Andrew and John T. Voight are not born until after the 1830 census.)

One age 30 – 39 If John (NMI) Voight was 30 -39 in 1830, then he was born between 1791 & 1800 and this is consistent with his being one of the sons of John W. Voight from the 1800 census record. Free white females:

One under age 5 If daughter Nancy Ann Voight is under 5 in 1830 then she was NOT born in 1823 as her cemetery record suggests, but perhaps around 1825. These dates are very close for such old records. Either record could easily be off by a couple years; cemetery dates of birth were often wrong. One age 20 – 29 If Barsheba Rawls is 20 – 29 in 1830, then her year of birth is 1801 – 1810. This is consistent with her being the daughter of Andrew Rawls in other census records, as we shall see.





Here's Barsheba Rawls' pedigree chart based on DNA matches with other descendents from her family,




Barsheba's great-grandfather Solomon King was a bona-fide Revolutionary War patriot. Born between 1710 and 1720, he was too old to fight, but he provided supplies and provisions to the Continental Army. His D.A.R. certification is copied below (if you ignore the comma, it looks like our ancestor was King Solomon ©).



Here are copies of three separate DNA matches with this branch of our ancestors. Notice that I match with the Lee, Porter, King and Curle families on Barsheba Rawls' mother's side.






Solomon King's family lineage has been "proved" to the D.A.R. for his daughter Barsheba King Porter and his granddaughter Abigail Porter Rawls. If we want to claim Solomon for our ancestor with the D.A.R., we only need to document our lineage from Abigail Porter and Andrew Rawls. Unfortunately there is no "paper trail" yet to prove Barsheba Rawls is their daughter. The courthouse in Suffolk burned down three times, most recently in 1866, and all the oldest records were lost - the birth and marriage records, wills, land plats and more... all gone forever. Neither have any Bible, church or cemetery records been found yet to confirm Barsheba as the daughter of Andrew and Abigail Porter Rawls. The DNA matches are our strongest evidence to support family tradition for this relationship, along with the 18th and 19th century naming conventions that can be used to argue for our Barsheba in this family.

Documentation of Barsheba Rawls as the wife of John NMI Voight and the mother of John T. Voight is easier to find, because in 1850 the census records started to name all the members of a household. The subsequent generations of John T. Voight and all his descendents are very well-documented, including our own Joseph Voight, the father of Jessie Voight Lassiter and Lillian Voight Rickabaugh.


The following records for his grandfather Andrew Rawls and his mother Barsheba Rawls complete John T. Voight's family of origin, ending with a few words about his siblings.

While previous records for the Voights were documented in Gates County, NC, the remaining records for John T. Voight's family of origin are found just across the state line in Nansemond County, VA

Beginning in 1820 the household of Andrew Rawls is found in the census for Nansemond County, VA.



John Voight

Birth 1791-1800 in <u>Gates County, North Carolina</u>
Death after 1830 in Gates County, North Carolina

Five children of Barsheba Rawls and John (NMI) Voight have been documented, 1 daughter and 4 sons: Nancy Ann, James, Patrick, Andrew and John T. Voight. Our ancestor John T. Voight was the youngest child of Barsheba Rawls and John (NMI) Voight.



The son Patrick Voight married Nancy Clayton. There are no known children from their union and his death is not documented.



Nancy Ann Voight

Birth **1823-1830** in <u>Virginia</u> Death **about 1890** in <u>Nansemond, Virginia,</u>

Nancy Ann is John T. Voight's only sister. In 1840 she married Quinton Baines. Nancy and Quinton had at least these eleven documented children. One may wonder about the daughter with the name "Garaphelia." But it's a real name! (I Googled it.) The 1850, 1860 and 1880 census records for this family are available for viewing in Nancy Ann's folder within the John T. Voight Family of Origin folder on the Voight Family Roots CD. (We already saw the 1870 census record because Nancy Ann's mother Barsheba Rawls was living in the Baines household in 1870.)

In the 1880 census Nancy Ann and Quinton Baines lived next door to Nancy's brother James Voight and his wife Texanna. Nancy Ann is buried in the Eason-

There are several James Voights in the extended family during this period. In this family we find a father and two possible sons named James. Virginia death

records show the first James "junior" died in April 1800 at age three years. Meanwhile Suffolk, VA birth records also show another baby, James S., born to James and Texanna in May 1879.

Brother John T. Voight also might have had 2 sons named James: James M. Voight who was born about 1861 is found at age 9 in the 1870 census; he died in 1880. According to Suffolk VA birth records another son, James T. Voight, was born in May, 1873. He's not listed in the 1880 census, so he might have died in early childhood.


Brother Andrew also had a son called James S. Voight who was born about 1852.

That makes a list of six James Voights who were born in 1829, 1852, 1861, 1873, 1877 and 1879. There were also a James Voight with no middle initial and a James T. Voight listed as a slave owners in 1860. Who's who? It's certainly hard to keep them all straight.

Texanna V. Savage

This James Voight born in 1829 was a sergeant in the 41st Virginia Infantry during the Civil War.
When he married Texanna in 1863 she was already the widow of another Civil War soldier,
Jackson Wilkins, and she'd already had 3 children by Wilkins.

Incidentally, Texanna's cousin Almira Savage was married to Richard T Rogers, who was the brother of Nancy Jane Rogers - who married John T. Voight, the brother of this James Voight! See the document called Kissin' Cousins in the Misc. folder on the CD to see how these 3 families were interconnected in this generation.

Andrew Voight

Birth 1831 in <u>Gates County, North Carolina</u> Death 1870

The last of John T. Voight's brothers is Andrew who married Sarah Steadman. They had 7 known children including the very successful entrepreneur, wholesale grocer and banker, Robert Palmer ("R.P.") Voight.

R.P. Voight was listed as a 22 year old "clerk" boarding in Norfolk as early as the 1880 census. In the 1882 city directory he is no longer a clerk but a wholesale grocer. By 1898 R.P. Voight was president of the Wholesale

Grocers Association. Before he died in 1903, he was also a vice-president of the National Bank of Commerce. His wife and daughters were often in the social pages of the newspapers. The R.P. Voight Wholesale Grocery Co., Inc. continued in business for years after Robert's death. One of the most interesting online documents from his life is this clipping from the August 3, 1900, *Virginian-Pilot*. It is

Mr. R. P. Voight, president of the Wholesale Grocers' Association, said that he is opposed to the Norfolk and Western Railway Company, or other corporation, building piers that would obstruct the channel. It's interesting that he speaks about his childhood growing up near the banks of the Great Dismal Swamp canal.

In the 1925 Norfolk city directory Robert's son Ricks Stedman Voight was a bond salesman and by 1928 he was a "Asst Sec" for the Guaranty Title and Trust Co.

Mr. R. P. Voight Died Yesterday

Mr. R. P. Voight died at his residence, Bute Street, yesterday morning. The deceased had been in feeble health for the past twelve months and spent last summer at the Rawley Springs with the hope of recuperating his shattered health, and returned home about three weeks ago. He was about 47 years of age, and was one of Norfolk's best known citizens and business men.

He conducted the wholesale grocery business most successfully in Norfolk for quite a number of years, and at the time of his demise was president of the Robert P. Voight Company. He was active in all the business pursuits of life, and his death will be deeply felt in the commercial circles of Norfolk. For fifteen years he was a director in the Bank of Commerce, and for the past three years was vice president of that institution.

The Wholesale Grocers' and Merchandise Brokers' associations held meetings yesterday and passed suitable resolutions on his death. They will attend his funeral in a body, which takes place from his residence, on Bute Street, at 4 o'clock Wednesday afternoon.

Mr. R. P. Voight Laid To Rest

The funeral of Mr. Robert P. Voight was solemnized at his late residence, No. 222 Bute Street, at 4 o'clock yesterday afternoon, and was largely attended. The service was conducted by Rev. W. A. Barr, rector of St. Luke's Episcopal Church, assisted by Rev. Dr. C. E. Grammer, of Christ Episcopal Church. There was a magnificent display of floral tributes, including numerous beautiful designs from individual friends. An exceedingly handsome standing cross five feet in height, wrought of lilies of the valley, roses, carnations, violets and maidenhair fern, sent by the National Bank of Commerce, of which the deceased was vice president. The remains were laid to rest in Elmwood Cemetery. Following were the pallbearers; Honorary – C. Billups, Joseph S. Culpepper, Major A. Myers, H. L. Smith, John G. Wallace, M. L. T. Davis, C. Brooks Johnston and Judge James E. Heath. Active - Judge Thomas H. Willcox, Colonel Washington Taylor, H. M. Kerr, Floyd Hughes, J. W. DeJarnette, Paul Blencoe, R. H. Baker, Jr., and H. R. Goodridge.



There were Voights in the milling business in the Norfolk area as this 1899 ad reveals. The Voights sold three grades of flour: Royal Crown, Best Patent and "Above All," costing 60 cents, 55 cents and 50 cents per bag respectively.

Where did all the Voights come from originally?

The name certainly sounds Germanic in origin. William Henry Voight's granddaughter Georgie May Liles South heard that the Voights might have originally been Jewish though there is no known documentation to support that intriguing possibility.

"The family name Voigt (Vogt), signifying an official position, is of ancient Teutonic origin, and is numerously found in the various municipalities and provinces of the Kingdom of Saxony in Germany, in Prussia, and in Pomerania. Some of the variations include Voigt, Voit, Vogt, and Vod. In France, it is spelled Focht. All of these variations of spelling mean "Protector" (overseer, bailiff, or steward) by the Old Langeboard Law. Henry I, Holy Roman Emperor of Germany from 919-936 A.D., was called Vogt, and his descendants after him. Those who ruled Saxony were called Vogts as the title for Stewards or Governors of the Holy Roman Empire..."

Among the many Voights who immigrated to North America there were two John Voights, for example, on the ship "Harle" that arrived in Philadelphia in 1736, who are possible candidates to be our ancestors. [from http://www.olivetreegenealogy.com/ships/palship24.shtml]

"At the Courthouse of Philadelphia, September 1st, 1736. One hundred fifty one Foreigners from the Palatinate & other Places, who, with their Families, making in all three hundred eighty eight Persons, were imported here in the Ship Harle, of London, Ralph Harle, Master, from Rotterdam, but last from Cowes, as by Clearance thence, were this day qualified as usual...

Clearly there's more research that can be done into our Voight family's European roots by anyone so inclined.
